**WARNING RELATED TO SAFETY PRECAUTIONS :**

- WARNING When using the G-EYE 900 and during activities : always be aware of your surroundings to avoid injury to yourself and others.  
- WARNING Observe the following precautions :  
-Do not drop, disassemble, crush, bend, deform, incinerate or microwave the camera.  
-Do not insert foreign objects in the connectors of the camera.  
-Do not use the camera if it has been cracked, punctured or damaged by water.  
-Do not use the camera in water or in a humid area without the waterproof casing and its closed door.  
-Do not dry your camera with an external heat source : microwave or hair dryer for example.

-Failure to observe these precautions could result in fire or electric shock.  
- WARNING When camera is charging, do not handle the plug or charger with wet hands : failure to observe this precaution could result in electric shocks.  
- WARNING Only use chargers marked : «OUTPUT 5V 1A». If you don't know, use the included USB cable to charge with your computer.  
- WARNING If using your G-EYE camera with a helmet mount, always make sure that select helmet that meets the applicable safety standards. Select the right helmet for your sport and control that the size fit for you. Inspect your helmet to make sure that it is in good condition and always follow the helmet manufacturer's instructions. No helmets can avoid injuries in every accident.

- WARNING Your G-EYE is designed with glass (lens, screen). Should the glass break, care should be taken to avoid injuries.  
- WARNING During use or charge, your G-EYE may become hot. Simply let it sit and cool before attempting to use it again.  
- WARNING This equipment must be installed and operated in accordance with provided instructions and the antenna(s) used for this transmitter must be installed to provide a separation distance of at least 20 cm from all persons and must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter.

**WARNING RELATED TO STORAGE:**

- WARNING Before cleaning your G-EYE, take care to unplug your device

from an electricity power source (charger, PC...).  
- NOTICE After using, rinse the waterproof case under pure water then wipe it with a clean tissue.

- NOTICE Store your camera within its waterproof case in a dry and temperate condition.

- NOTICE Before storage, recharge your G-EYE and then unplug it from an electricity power source (charger, PC...)

- This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
