2. Operation Flow (BT)

2 Getting Started

Refer to Connection Diagram for the Set-up. Supply is 14.0V DC.

Touch Power switch (a) to turn on the unit.



2 Bluetooth Pairing

To go to BT mode, long touch "**MEDIA**". Unless the BT icon can be seen, keep touching "**MEDIA**."

Touch "SETUP" to connect a device to the unit.





Under "SETUP", select Bluetooth.

NOTE:

- ※Touch the "^A" or "v"

 to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)" to select.
- %Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)" to return to the previous display.

Under Bluetooth, select Setup Bluetooth.



AS DISP

Under Select Bluetooth, select Pairing.



Connect the phone to the unit, My Car.



Once connected, a confirmation will appear on the screen. Also, a BT icon will display on the upper right corner of the screen.



Once connected, it will confirm if you want to automatically transfer your phonebook to the unit.



2 Bluetooth Handsfree - Incoming Call

The screen shown on the right will be displayed if there's an incoming call.

It displays the ff:

Incoming Call

Name

Number

The handsfree control of call is through the steering switch.





2.3.1 Answer

To take the call, **Off Hook** should be pressed.

There should be **Talking...** instead of **Incoming Call** to know that the call has been connected.

To end a call, **On Hook** should be pressed, and display would go back to the mode before the call.

2.3.2 Reject

To reject a call, press **On Hook** and it will go back to the mode before the call.



2 Bluetooth Handsfree - Outgoing Call

To make an outgoing call, press **Off Hook** from steering switch and the display on the right will appear.

NOTE:

- X Touch the "A" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)"
 to select.
- Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.

2.4.1 Phonebook

To call a number registered on the connected phone, select **Phonebook**.

NOTE:

- **Touch the "A" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)"
 to select.
- Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.

2.4.2 All Calls

To select from the pool of all recently associated numbers, select **All Calls**.

NOTE:

- XTouch the "A" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)"
 to select.
- **Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.

2.4.3 Missed Calls

To select from the calls missed, select **Missed Calls**.

NOTE:

- *Touch the "^" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)"
 to select.
- **Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.









2.4.4 Incoming Calls

To select from the calls received, select **Incoming Calls**.

NOTE:

- ※Touch the "^" or "v"

 to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)" to select.
- ※Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"

 to return to the previous display.

2.4.5 Outgoing Calls

To select from the calls made, select **Outgoing Calls**.

NOTE:

- *Touch the "^" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- **Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)" to select.
- XTouch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.





3 Bluetooth Audio

To play audio via BT, long touch "**MEDIA**" and then, keep touching until BT icon appears.



Indication will be written on the upper left of the display with a BT icon below it and on the upper right. Audio will automatically play.



To increase the volume, touch "+" or slide up.



To decrease the volume, touch "-" or slide down.



2.5.1 Repeat

To repeat a track, touch "SETUP."



By default, repeat mode is off, as shown.

To turn it on, touch "ENTER (DISP • 6 Area)"



To return to original display, touch "BACK (AS • 5 Area)"



An indication of being in the repeat mode is shown on the upper right part of the display beside the BT icon and above the time elapsed.



To turn it off, go back to "SETUP", and then select Repeat until as shown on the right.



2.5.2 **Random**

To put the songs on random mode, touch "SETUP", and then select Random.

NOTE:

- XTouch the "A" or "v" to navigate the selection.
- %Touch "ENTER (DISP 6 Area)" to select.
- **Touch "BACK (AS 5 Area)"
 to return to the previous display.

To randomize songs, touch "ENTER (DISP • 6 Area)" until Off becomes All.



To go back to the original display, touch "BACK (AS • 5 Area)"

An indication icon will be displayed beside the BT icon on the upper right corner and above the time elapsed, as shown on the right.



2.5.3 Seek Up/Seek Down

To play next track, touch "^"



To go back to previous track, touch "v"



Sliding up the **Tune Track** skips a few tracks up.



Sliding down the **Tune Track** skips a few tracks down.



2.5.4 Fast Forward/Rewind

To fast forward the track, long touch "^"



To rewind the track, long touch "v"
