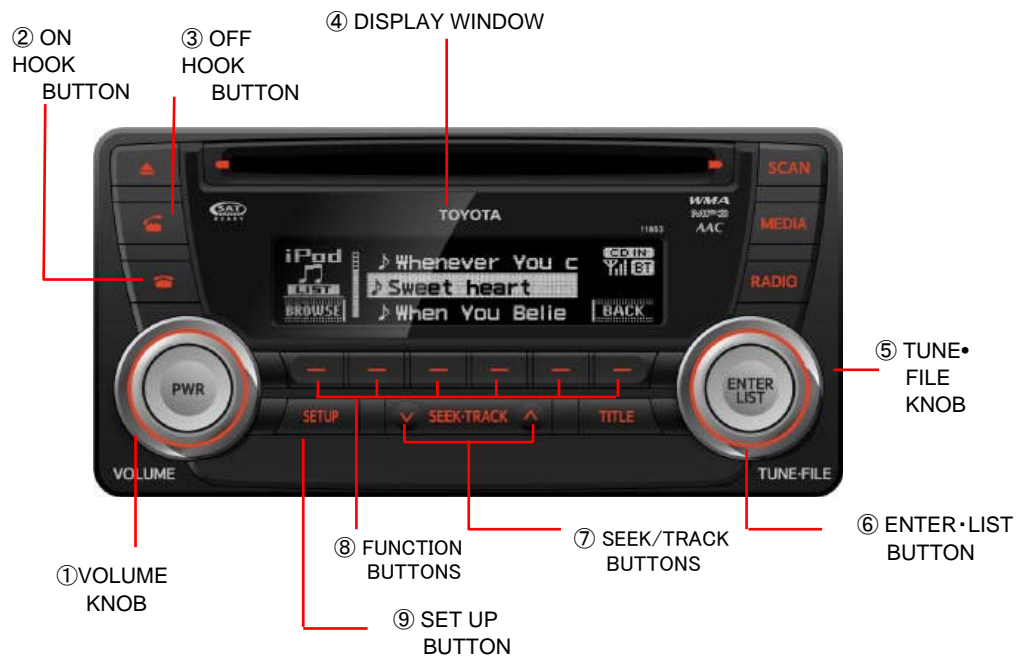


HANDS-FREE OPERATION



ATTENTION

- Do not leave your cellular phone in the car. The temperature inside may be high and damage the phone.
- When you dispose of your car, take care to delete all personal data that are registered in your TOYOTA AUDIO system. You should delete the following Hands-free data from the system;
 - Bluetooth phone data

NOTE

- In the following conditions, the system may not function.
- The cellular phone is turned off.
 - The current position is outside the communication area.
 - The cellular phone is not connected.
 - The cellular phone has a low battery.

HANDS-FREE SYSTEM

Hands-free system allows you to make or receive a call without taking your hands off the steering wheel by connecting your cellular phone. This system supports Bluetooth, a wireless radio data transferring system, by which you can make calls without your cellular phone being connected with a cable or placed on cable. If your cellular phone does not support Bluetooth, this system can not function.

CAUTION
While driving, do not use a cellular phone or connect a Bluetooth phone.

ABOUT THE DISPLAY

Reception Level Indication

The strength of the reception is indicated in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④

REGISTERING A BLUETOOTH CELLULAR PHONE

Registration is required in order to use a Bluetooth system..

For details of the operation to be performed at the cellular phone, refer to the instruction manual supplied with the phone.

REGISTERING BLUETOOTH CELLULAR PHONE FOR THE FIRST TIME (NO PHONES CURRENTLY REGISTERED)

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **Bluetooth** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **BT Pairing** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Bluetooth menu.
- (4) After "CAR AUDIO Passkey0000" is displayed, "SEARCHING" will be shown. Perform an initial registration on a Bluetooth supported cellular phone.

(Refer to the instruction manual supplied with the cellular phone.)

- The connection method from the telephone set to the unit varies according to the specification of your cellular phone. Refer to the instruction manual supplied with the phone.

- (5) When Antenna mark is displayed at the right top of the screen, the connection is completed.
- (6) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ twice to go back to the previous mode.

ATTENTION

You cannot register the Bluetooth cellular phone while driving. Park your vehicle in a secure location and select the cellular phone.

NOTE

If "Failed" is displayed in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④ after entering the pass key, repeat the registration operation.

CHANGING THE PASS KEY

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **Bluetooth** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **Set Passcode** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Bluetooth menu.
- (4) Change the pass key numbers digit by digit by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤. The Number can be comprised of from 4 to 8 digits. Press "ENTER" FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ to complete changing the pass key.
- (5) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ twice to go back to the previous mode.

ATTENTION

You cannot change the pass key while driving. Park your vehicle in a secure location and change the pass key.

DELETING A REGISTERED CELLULAR PHONE

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **Bluetooth** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **List Phone** by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Bluetooth menu.
- (4) Select **CELL** to display the cellular phone information that is currently paired with the AUDIO unit by turning the TUNE•FILE KNOB ⑤. Select a desired cellular phone to be deleted.
- (5) Turn the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ and select **Delete** to delete the currently paired cellular phone.
- (6) **Delete a CELL ?** will appear in the DISLAY WINDOW ④ asking for confirmation, then press **YES** in the FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧.
- (7) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ③ three times to go back to the previous mode.

ATTENTION

You cannot delete the registered telephone set while driving. Park your vehicle in a secure location and delete the registered cellular phone.

MAKING A PHONE CALL

You can make a phone call using the phone book of the AUDIO unit, manually dialing from the AUDIO unit or direct from your cellular phone.

- (1) Press the OFF HOOK BUTTON ③ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ to display SETUP menu.

- (3) Select **Enter Phone number** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display PHONE menu.
- (4) Turn the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ and **ENTER** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ to enter the phone number digit by digit.
- (5) Press OFF HOOK BUTTON ③ to make a call.

MAKING A PHONE CALL FROM A REGISTERED NUMBER

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **PHONE book** and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ to display PHONE menu.
- (4) Turn the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ and select a phone number to call
- (5) Press OFF HOOK BUTTON ③ to make a call.

ATTENTION

Phone number is not displayed while driving. Only when the vehicle is stopped or parked, it is displayed.

ANSWERING A PHONE CALL

When your telephone set receives a call, the name or telephone number appears in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④

- If the incoming telephone number is not registered, the telephone number is displayed in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④.
If the incoming telephone name and number are registered, the name is displayed in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④.
If only the incoming telephone number is registered, the telephone number is displayed in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④.

- (1) Press the OFF HOOK BUTTON ③ to talk using the hands-free system.
- (2) Press ON HOOK BUTTON ② to hang up the phone.

REFUSING AN INCOMING CALL

- Press ON HOOK BUTTON ② while the phone is ringing.

REGISTERING INFORMATION IN THE PHONE BOOK

Telephone numbers and names can also be registered manually in the phone book. Up to 100 entries can be registered in the phone book of the main device.

REGISTERING THE PHONE BOOK DATA OF A MOBILE PHONE IN THE PHONE BOOK OF THE MAIN DEVICE

To register the phone book data of a mobile phone registered in the main device.

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **PHONE book** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display PHONE menu.

- (4) Select **Add contact** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display PHONE book menu
- (5) Select **Add one contact** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Add one contact menu.
- (6) **REST of memory is 1000, OK ?** will appear in the DISPLAY WINDOW ④ asking for confirmation, then press "YES" in the FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧.
- (7) Transfer a desired phone number to be added from a currently paired cellular phone to the AUDIO unit.
(By manipulating a cellular phone, select Bluetooth transmission > select the audio player > select OK .)
- (8) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ four times to go back to the previous mode.

ATTENTION

You cannot register any information in the phone book while driving.
Park your vehicle in secure location and then register the information.

DELETING THE DATA IN THE PHONE BOOK

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **PHONE book** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display PHONE menu.

- (4) Select **Delete history** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display PHONE book menu.
- (5) Select **All Calls** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Delete history menu.
- (6) Select a registered number to delete by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥.
- (7) **Delete from All Calls ?** will appear in the DISLAY WINDOW ④ asking for confirmation, then press **YES** in the FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧.
- (8) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ twice to go back to the previous mode.

ATTENTION

You cannot delete the phone book data while driving. Park your vehicle in a secure location and then delete the data.

SETTING THE VOLUME

SETTING THE SPEECH VOLUME

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **HF Soundsetting** and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, to display Bluetooth menu.
- (4) Select **all Volume** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display HF Soundsetting menu.
- (5) Turn the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ to change the volume.
- (6) Press **SAVE** in the FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ to complete the setting.
- (7) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ three times to go back to the previous mode.

SETTING THE VOLUME OF THE RING TONE

- (1) Press the SET UP BUTTON ⑨ to display the phone menu.
- (2) Select **PHONE** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display SETUP menu.
- (3) Select **HF Soundsetting** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display Bluetooth menu.
- (4) Select **Ringtone Volume** by turning the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤, and press ENTER•LIST BUTTON ⑥ to display HF Soundsetting menu.
- (5) Turn the TUNE•FILE BUTTON ⑤ to change the volume.
- (6) Press **SAVE** in the FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ to complete the setting.
- (7) Press the **BACK** FUNCTION BUTTON ⑧ three times to go back to the previous mode.

NOTE

The volume and microphone gain setting for each cellular phone is different according to its specification.

Please adjust the volume by turning the VOLUME KNOB ①.

CHANGING THE TRANSMITTING VOLUME

- During phone conversation press SEEK•TRACK BUTTON \wedge (UP) or \vee (DOWN) for volume adjustment.
