

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS Take out the fan body and the spare parts from the box. 2. Pass the power cord through the gap between two halves. 3. Connect the two halves of the base by aligning the plastic pegs of each half of the base. 4. Insert the anti-skid pegs into the 4 corners of the base as shown below. **IMPORTANT:** Make sure that the power cord passes through the cord guides on the rear half of the base. 5. Stand the fan upright.
