CHARGING THE SPEAKERS

The speakers come with a built-in rechargeable battery. Before using it for the first time, we recommend you charge the battery fully. Only use the supplied USB cable to charge the speakers.

Connect the LISB cable to a computer LISB port and the USB plug to the charging jack of the headset. The red LED light will illuminate while the speakers are charging.

A full charge of the battery takes around 2 hours. When the battery is fully charged, disconnect the speakers at this point, The speakers will then be ready for use.

If your speaker begins to make a busy signal noise while you are using it, this is to notify you that your battery is low. Please recharge your speaker at this point.

In order to save power, the speakers will automatically turn off if not paired with a device after 5 minutes.

PAIRING THE SPEAKERS

 Ensure the speakers are turned on. Press and hold the Multifunction button until the speakers turn on and the LED flashes blue. This will indicate your speakers are now in

- 3. Your device will start searching for Bluetooth devices.
 5. The speaker will appear as "CRA-LEDRP" in the list of available Bluetooth^a devices.
- 6. Select "CRA-LEDRE 7. Enter password "0000" (if required) to confirm pairing.

Note: If pairing is unsuccessful, turn off the speakers first and re-pair following the aforementioned steps. Once you have paired the speakers with a device, the speakers will remember this device and will pair automat ically when the device's Bluetooth® is activated and in range. You do not need to re-pair any previously connected devices

Once the speakers are paired to your device, you can stream music wirelessly to the speakers. Select the track vou wish to play on your device and listen to via speakers Should you encounter any problems while streaming, please refer to your device's user manual.

OPTIONAL AUX The speakers can also play music using the enclosed AUX

cable. Simply connect your audio device to the speaker

speaker using the AUX cable. You can control media and volume from your phone or tablet directly.

The LED lights on the speaker will change automatically to the beat of your music. To see the lights on the speaker change, select upbeat music, or ensure that the volume of your audio device is turned up sufficiently.

To skip to the previous/next track, press the correspond-ing media shortcut once. To increase/decrease volume, press and hold the corresponding media shortcut until you reach your desired volume
