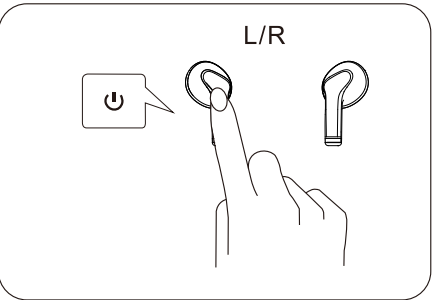
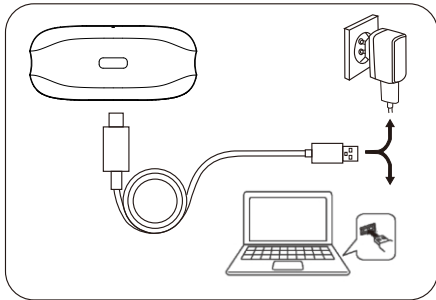

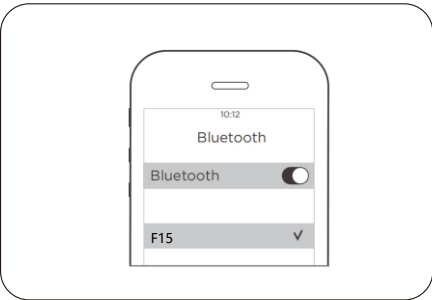


Power on

Power off

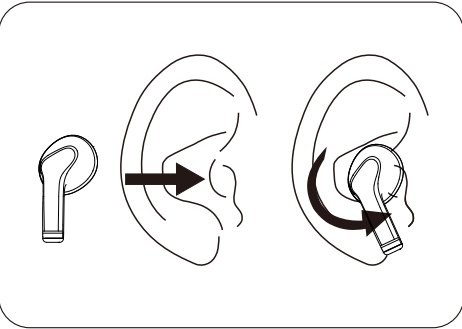
Put into charging case
