

### Instructions

- 1. Mode button: Short press to change between BT, TF card and USB mode.
- 2. Previous song: Short press for previous song
- 3. Next song: Short press for next song
- 4. Play/Pause button: press once to play music, press once again to pause.
- Receive call button: Short press to answer the call. Press once again to hang up. Long press to reject. Double press to redial the last number.
- Turning on/off & Volume control: Rotate the Volume knob to the right until it is turned on; Rotate the Volume knob to the left until it is turned off; Rotate the Volume knob to the right to increase the volume; Rotate the Volume knob to the left to decrease the volume:
- 7. USB port: Can be connected with other device and play the music content from that device
- 8. TF card port: Compatible with TF cards and can play the music content from cards.
- 9. AUX port: Connect Φ3.5mm plug of the audio cable for audio signal
- Charging light indicator: When charging, the red indicator light will be turned on. After being fully charged, the light will turn off.
- 11.DC 5V: insert charge cable into power interface with electricity power to charge the machine.



### Troubleshoot

The volume is too low- Rotate the Volume knob to the right to increase the volume: Rotate the Volume knob to the left to decrease the volume:

How long should it be charged? For about 2.5hours. (Until indicator light dim out).

Songs are interrupted when playing - Not enough power, charge the product. Or the distance is too big. Avoid placing close to interference sources such as wireless routers.

Cannot connect successfully- 1. Make sure that speaker has enough power, 2. Open the BT on your phone and place close to the speaker. 3. Turn the speaker on, and search for A18 on your cellphone and connect.

It is connected though the cable/ TF card but does not play the music- Make sure that there is enough power. Make sure AUX cable is properly connected (usually green port). Rotate the Volume knob, change the mode between BT-cable-card
