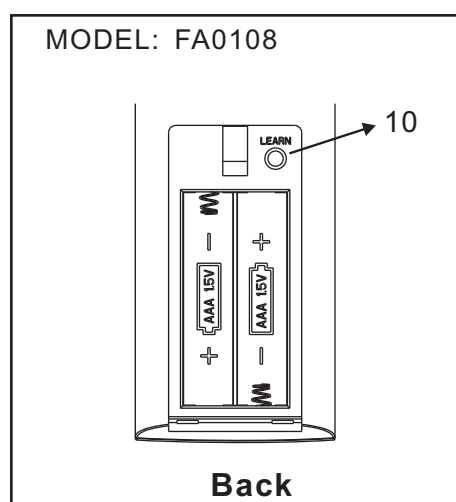
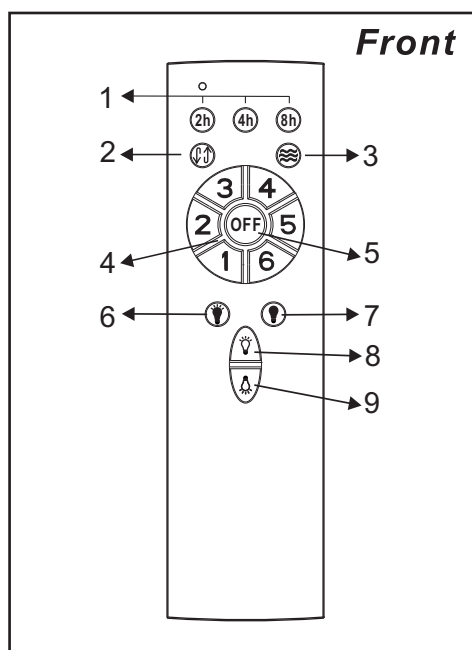

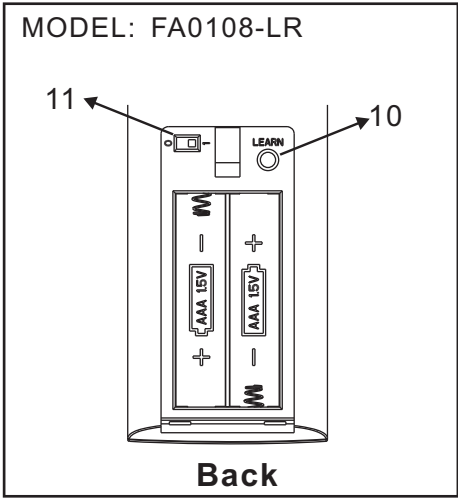


Remote Control Functions:

10. Extended Function Switch L.

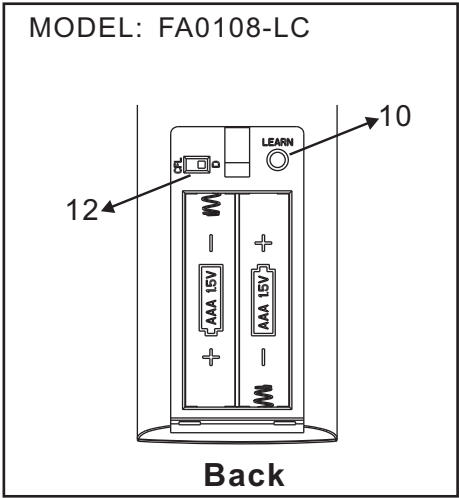
Note: Install 2 AAA 1.5V batteries to the remote control.

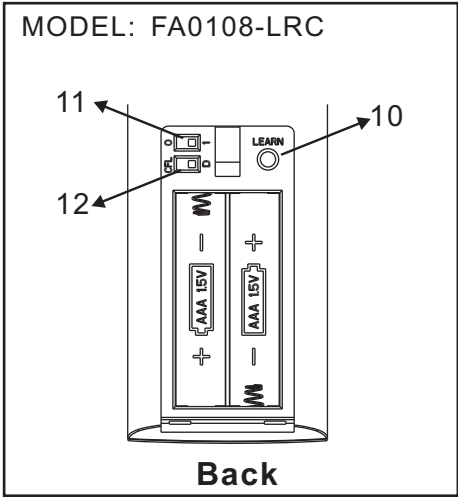

FCC STATEMENT
