

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

BATTERY LOADING

Be sure replace batteries in power off state'

- 1. To open the battery cover, press and then slide it off. Insert two AAA(LR03)batterys
- according to the polarity indicated and then slide the cover back into

2. To check the remaining battery power, press the PLAY/STOP button or REC/PAUSE button in power off state.




- Voice recorder automatically turns off if no button is pushed within 1 minute in the Stop mode.
- * Press the mode button in the mode until "OFF" appears on LCD with a beep sound.



Operating voice recorder

SET MENU

- I. Put REC/CAMERA switch is REC location and HOLD switch is OFF.
- 2. Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE buttori, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- 3. If you press MODE button, the unit will be operated as follows.



- 4. Press MODE and FF/REW buttons, you will be selected folder, recording mode and VOR function.
- 5. Press MODE button 3 times, the unit will be displayed remain recording time.

Operating voice recorder

RECORDING

- 1. Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE button, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- 2. Let MIC toward sound source and press REC/PAUSE button.
- Recording file will be added and recording will be continued.





- 3. If you press REC/PAUSE button during recording, recording will be passed and if you press REC/PAUSE button once again, PAUSE will be released.
- 4. To stop recording, press PLAY/STOP button.
- . Please do test recording in advance to prevent from failing recording.
- * If MEMORY is enhausted or file number gets more than 99 messages in one folder, "FULL" will be displayed and recording won't be centimed.
- * VOLUME level will be controlled during recording.

Operating voice recorder

CONVENIENT RECORDING FUNCTION

Simple recording

- 1. Press REC/PAUSE button more than 3 seconds in power off state, recording will bestarted.. 2. If you press REC/PAUSE button during playback,
- recording will be started.

INDEX Addition

If you press FF button during recording mode, FILE number will be added and recording will be continued.

REC Moniter

During recording, you can monitor recording message by inserting earphone into earphone jack.

VOR On/Off Control

You can select VOR ON/OFF with MODE button even during recording mode.

Operating voice recorder

PLAYBACK

- Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE button, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- 2. Select FILE number FF/REW buttons.
- If you press PLAY/STOP button, playback will be continued to the final message in the folder.



- 4. Adjust volume level with volume UP/DOWN button.
- If you press PLAY/STOP button more than Isecond during playback, playback will be paused and if you press PLAY/STOP button one time, pause will be released.
- To stop playback, press PLAY/STOP button one more time.

Operating voice recorder

CONVENIENT PLAYBACK FUNITION

REVIEW & CUE

- If you press FF/REW buttons shortly at playback mode, the fare & hind recording files will be played.
- If you press FF/REW buttons for a long time,
 REW & FF will be proceeded during the button pressing.

SCAN PLAY

If you press PLAY/STOP button for more than 2 second, the force part of each file in current folder will be played for 5 seconds in order.

FILE REPEAT

If you press MODE button shortly twice during playback, current playing file will be repeated with "rP" displayed.

And then press MODE button, FILE REPEAT will be conceled.

A-B section REPEAT

If you press MODE button one time shortly during playback mode, point A will be selected.

And please press MODE button one more time, point B will be selected.

And then A-B section will be repeated.

And then press MODE button, A-B section REPEAT will be canceled

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Operating voice recorder

ERASE

(Erasing one FILE)

- If you select a file with FF/REW buttons at stop mode and press ERASE button shortly.
 (Selected file number will be blinking on LCD.
 For checking the message, the ensing file will be played).
- If you press ERASE button one more time, selected file will be erased and following file number will be changed as current file number.

(Erasing all data in FOLDER)

- If you press ERASE button for more than 3 seconds, current folder will be blinking on LCD.
- 2. Select a folder with FF/REW button.
- And then press ERASE button one more time, so that all data in the selected folder will be crased with beep sound.

(Erasing all FOLDERs)

- If you press ERASE button for more than 3 seconds, current folder will be blinking on LCD.
- 2. Select all folders with FF/REW button.
- And then press ERASE button one more time, so that all data in the all folders will be erased with beep sound.

CONNECTING WITH EXTERNAL APPLIANCE


Recording with external microphone

If you cannect external microphone into MIC JACK, built-in mic will be excluded and you can record with optional external microphone.



(You can elip external microphone onto your lapet, so that you cal take free action. Also, you can record with much better sound quality by approaching round source.)

In case of recording external appliance into voice recorder unit



(Recording will be proceeded with L-ch mono and you can check recording condition with earphone.)

Operating voice recorder

 CONNECTING WITH EXTERNAL APPLIANCE In case of recording from DVR unit into external appliance

Connect optional audio cable into both earphone jack of DVR unit and mic of external INPUT of external appliance and press both PLAY/STOP button of DVR unit and REC button of external appliance.


(Do test-recording in advance and you can't adjust volume level with VOLUME LIP/DOWN buttons of the DVR unit.)

Telephone recording

Connect optional Tel-line adapter into Tel-line cord as

following picture and press REC/PAUSE button once telephone conversation is started.

(Not available for Digital Telephone and the telephone with different MODULAR JACK)



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Operating Digital Dual Camera

MODE DISPLAY

- Hr: When this mode is selected, you can select your DMR-1004C/1009C to the high-resolution mode by pressing the SNAPSHOT button once.
- Lr : When this mode is selected, you can select your DMR-1004C/1009C to the low-resolution mode by pressing the SNAPSHOT button once.
- Ct: When this mode is selected, you can take continuous shots by holding the SNAPSHOT button down.
- Timer: When this mode is selected, you will have a 10 seconds delay after pressing the SNAPSHOT button once.
- Erase: When this mode is selected, you can erase the entire images by pressing the SNAPSHOT button twice.
- UP: When this mode is selected, you can transfer the entire image on flash memory into VR once.
- Quiet: When this mode is selected, there is no been sound.

Operating Digital Dual Camera

SET MENU

- 1. Put REC/CAMERA switch is REC location and HOLD switch is OFF.
- 2. Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE button, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- 3. Put REC/CAMERA switch is CAMERA location, so that the unit will be operated Digital Dual Camera.
- 4. Press MODE button, operation mode will be changed as bellow.

- 5. Select a operation mode with MODE button, if you press-SNAPSHOT button, and then you wanted operation mode will be selected.
- · Please note that you can turn on the power in only voice recorder mode. Also, you can change the mode from the voice recorder to Camera in only Stand-By.
- · Battery consumption will increase when change to the camera mode.

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Operating Digital Dual Camera

USING THE PC CAMERA

- I. Put REC/CAMERA switch is REC location and HOLD switch is OFF.
- 2. Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE button, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- 3. Put REC/CAMERA switch is CAMERA location, so that the unit will be operated Digital Dual Carnera.
- 4. If you would like to operate the PC Camera, please connect the recorder to PC using USB cable and work the " MyCAM" program in install CD.
- · You can enjoy the internet visual chatting if you register internet visual chatting site.
- · You can use the internet phone at the same time seeing the pertner's face if you are member of the sites which can offer internet phone call service & visual chatting. service.

Operating Digital Dual Camera

IMAGE CAPTURE

- Put REC/CAMERA switch is REC location and HOLD switch is OFF.
- Press PLAY/STOP or REC/PAUSE button, so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- Put REC/CAMERA switch is CAMERA location, so that the unit will be operated Digital Dual Camera.
- Please select your favorite capture mode by press the MODE button and SNAPSHOT button.
- The image capture is taken to press the snapshot button after centering the subject within the view-finder.
 - Mease note that your fingers not to cover the lens of cornera.
 - Please note that you cannot take the capture when the red LED is blink.
- Please save the image file into the flash memory of recorder to select UP by MODE button after captured image because the image file is lost when the buttery is take out or change to recorder mode without saving into flash memory.
- The unit is offering you automatic power down function to save battery, that is to power down automatically if there is no button input more than 60 seconds.

Operating Digital Dual Camera

- In the still carners mode, the unit is powered only from bottery so you would better to power off when you don't use it for a long time.
- ➤ To take picture as you want

You can see the subject through the viewfinder. After centering the subject in the viewfinder, press SNAPSHOT button to take a picture.

SAVE

- Uploading starts when you press snapshot button in UP selected by pressing mode button 5 times.
- Uploading is finished after beep when you await for a second.
- You can take capture again when the mode is automatically switched to camera after uploading is completed.

ERASE

Erase one file

 If you select a file with FF/REW buttons at stop mode and press ERASE button shortly.

(Selected file number will be blinking on LCD.

For checking the message, the erasing file will be played.)

Check! Isn't the message number or file FULL?

— Erase unnecessary message.
Check2 Did you check the battery capacity?
Revoluce batteries. \rightarrow Replace batteries

In case of no playback

Check1 Isn't there any recorded message?

— Check the recording message.

Check2 Did you check the battery capacity?

— Replace batteries.

In case of no sound from speaker

Check! Isn't your volume at 0(zero) position? → Adjust the VOLUMF, button.

Check2 Isn't your earphone inserted in?

Take the Farphone Jack off.

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Troubleshooting

In case of no sound from earphone

Check1 Isn't your volume at 0(zero) position?

Adjust the VOLUME button. Check2 Is your earphone properly inserted in?

→ Insert the Earphone Jack completely

In case of no working in camera mode

Check Did you check the mal-operation?

- Take our batteries and insert again.

In case of no working snapshot

Check Did you check the battery capacity?

- Replace batteries

In case of S/W installation interruption

Check 1 Does your computer meet system requirement for this product's S/W?

Check the system requirement.

(After completing S/W installation, your PC's hard disk should have enough space)

· In case of low battery displaying, operating can't be proceeded properly
