

## Other Functions

Preventing Accidental Operation

#### HOLD Function

Slide the HOLD switch in the direction of the arrow. "HOLD" will flash three times, indication that all the functions of the buttons are locked.

To eancel the HOLD function, simply slide the HOLD switch in the opposite direction.

### FOLDER OF ERASE LOCK

Press FOLDER/ENTER button to select a folder in which you want to lock and press REC/PAUSE button. And then "FOLDER LOCK" will be displayed on display window and set the erase lock.

If you setting the lock of a folder that will not erase.

In case of erasing all dlers, you can erase, the lock of a folder.

To cancel the folder lock setting, select the locking folder and press REC/PAUSE button.

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### Other Functions

#### Selecting the Display Mode

You can select the display mode for the stop, recording and playback modes. (If the unit is left unoperated for mode than 3 seconds in the stop mode, the display will show the current time, regardless of the display mode setting.)

- Each time you press DISPLAY, the display mode will change as shown below:
- 1. Remaining recording time : The remaining recording time is displayed during recording or in stop mode playback mode.
- 2. Recorded date : The date the current message was recorded. (If the clock has not been set, , "--" will be displayed.)
- 3. Recorded time : The date and time the current message was recorded. (If the clock has been set, "--:--" will be displayed.)
- Selecting the Beep Sound
- 1. Press MENU button 5 times, "BEEP" will be displayed. 2. Press FF/REW button to select you want to mode and press


