

Setting bass mode

You can set up the playback of MP3's to stress bass tones.




While in MP3 mode

1. Press MENU from the JOG buttons for 3 seconds. REP will be displayed.



2. Press MENU from the JOG button twice. BAS ON or BAS OFF will be displayed.



3. Press the JOG button in the (up) direction to select a mode.

4. Press the JOG button. Setup is saved and the selected MP3 file is played automatically.

Installing the MMC (multimedia card)

A MMC can be used to increase the memory capacity of your unit.

You can purchase a MMC at any local computer/electronics retailer.



Open the MMC cover.

1. While pressing down , push the cover outward.
2. Insert the MMC into the card slot along with the mark until you hear a click, then close the cover.

Press the MMC down lightly with your nail or similar object to uninstall the card



When you insert a MMC in the voice recorder, shaped folder is added in the voice recorder, in which you can store recorded messages and MP3 files as well as standard computer files. The recording may not be completed if the MMC and/or battery are removed while recording to the MMC.

Setting the current time

The current time can only be set while in standby mode.

While in standby mode with voice recorder/MP3 modes turned off



1. Press MENU from the JOG buttons once. TIME will be displayed.

TIME



2. Press the JOG button. The Year will blink.

102008



3. Select the Year by pressing the JOG button in the (up) direction.



4. Press the JOG button. The Year stops blinking and the Month begins to blink.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to set the month, day, hour, and minutes. "seconds" will automatically set themselves to "00" when the minutes are set.



You are automatically switched to the ALSET (alarm) setup mode when the current date/time setup is completed.

To exit this automated step, press MENU from the JOG buttons.

Setting the alarm



1. Press MENU from the JOG button 3 times. AL ON or AL OFF will be displayed.

With voice recorder/MP3 modes turned off



2. Press the JOG button in the (up) direction to select ON or OFF.



3. Press MENU from the JOG buttons. The setup is saved.

AL off

alarm off

AL set

alarm on



After the TIME(time) setup, you are automatically switched to the ALSET (alarm) setup mode, and after ALSET, you are automatically switched to the AL ON/OFF mode.

To exit these automatic steps, press MENU from the JOG buttons.

Setting up the HOLD function

You can prevent operational errors by using the HOLD function. You can also prevent unnecessary battery waste with the HOLD function, as it prevents you from accidentally pressing function buttons in standby mode.



To activate the HOLD switch

Push the HOLD switch in the direction

will be displayed and you will be in HOLD mode.

"HOLD" will begin to blink if you press the JOG button while you are in this state. When you switch to HOLD mode while all operations are STOPPED, the unit

will automatically turn OFF after 3 seconds.



To deactivate the HOLD switch

Push the HOLD switch in the direction

will disappear when HOLD is released.



Viewing DISPLAY data

You can view recorded message data, remaining recording time, etc. While in voice recorder RECORD or RECORD PAUSE status



Press the display button.

The remaining recording time

will be displayed.

In voice recorder or MP3 PLAY

or PLAY PAUSED status

Press the display button.

The original date of the recording will be displayed

and when you press the button again, you can view

the recording duration.



If you upload a recording from a computer, the DISPLAY data of

that file is "REFRESHED" with the latest update.

In MP3 mode, the date and time when the file was downloaded

from a computer are displayed.

Connecting to the audio system

To record the content from an audio system on to your voice recorder

1. Connect the audio output terminal to the voice recorder input terminal.
2. Press the REC/STOP button and the audio system's PLAY button at the same time.

The content from the audio device will start recording to your voice recorder. Press the REC/STOP button again. Recording will STOP. To stop recording


To record from an audio system to your voice recorder

1. Connect the voice recorder output terminal to the audio input terminal.
2. Select the recorded message to be recorded to the audio system. Refer to page 10, item 1 & 2 for instructions on how to select the recorded message.
3. Simultaneously press the JOG (Play) button on the voice recorder and the record button on the audio device.

The voice recorder's contents are recorded to the audio device.

To stop recording

Press the JOG (Play) button on the voice recorder and the STOP button on the audio device.



Connecting to the external microphone to record

You can attach a microphone to your clothes and make voice recordings while moving around freely.

1. Connect the voice recorder input terminal to the external microphone.
2. Press the REC/STOP button. Recording will begin. Press the REC/STOP button again. Recording will STOP. To stop recording




Connecting to the telephone to record

You can record a telephone conversation on your voice recorder. However, a digital telephone cannot be connected to the voice recorder.

external microphone

1. Use a telephone-recording adapter to connect the telephone to the voice recorder's input terminal.

2. Press the REC/STOP button while talking on the telephone. The telephone conversation begins recording. Press the REC/STOP button again. Recording will STOP. To stop recording



Connecting to a Computer

You can send voice recordings to your computer or vice versa.

You can also transfer e-mail with play, edit, and voice attachments.

Refer to the help message in "Voice Manager Pro" for further details.

To install Voice Wizard Gold Ver1.0

You need to first install the "Voice Wizard Gold" onto your computer to connect the voice recorder to your computer and utilize the related functions.

System requirements

Computer : Pentium or IBM compatible system with USB support.

Memory : 64MB or higher

OS : Windows 98SE/ME/2000/XP

Hard Disk : At least 100M of free disk space

Playback : Soundcard, speaker


Recording : Soundcard, microphone

Insert the Voice Manager Pro CD into your computer's CD-ROM drive and the installation window will be displayed.

If the installation window does not appear, double click on MY COMPUTER —> CD-ROM —> SETUP.EXE

The installation window should then appear.

appears on the back screen.



Connecting the voice recorder to your Computer


Use Voice Wizard Gold to connect the voice recorder to your computer.
This will allow you to properly utilize recorded messages using the full range of functions.




"Connect" will appear on the window if you connect the recorder to PC.

Drive Installation


If PC doesn't recognize Voice Recorder after Voice Wizard Gold is installed. Add New Hardware Wizard window appears. In that case, please follow the steps.




File Copy

You can Up and Down-load the MP3 or recorded message file from / to PC using an each button on main screen of Voice Wizard Gold Ver1.0

Also you can copy the file that you want by mouse Drag & Drop on screen
(It maybe illegal that down load the MP3 file to your Voice Recorder from on-line link site)

Store recorded voice file to PC



- Select file and drag & drop to upper window
- Also you can up & down load the file using this icon
- Copying(store) selected file to PC



- Stored to PC under directory C:\Program\Voice Wizard Gold\Voice
- You can change the stored directory that you want.

Checking the files in folder



- Only MP3 files are stored to music folder Recorded voice file are stored to file folders(A/B/C/D) automatically.

- Others files (no MP3 & voice files) are stored to Files.

File erase



- Select file
- Push the right button or mouse and click the Delete

Playback the recorded voice file on PC




- Select file

- POS : Display the play position
- VOL : Display the voice volume



- You can select Extended memory or Internal memory mode by these icon.

Memory format on PC



1. Select memory (external / internal)
2. Select Tool(T) and click memory format(F)



3. Select 'yes'



4. All of files are deleted on Voice recorder when you execute format action.

Edit file



- Click Edit icon



- Loading the converted file. Wait for a moment.




- Open a recorded file that you want



- Loading wav file



- Selected file will be converted to .wav file automatically.
(Only .wav file can be edited)



- Click the left or right mouse button on edit window, vertical line position show the start or end position for file edit.
- You can copy / cut or delete what you selected portion of file using tool bar icon.

Troubleshooting

If there is a problem, please check these points first.

When using the voice recorder :

Q : LCD window does not work.

A : Isn't the battery exhausted ?

Replace with new battery.

A : Is the battery correctly installed ?

Correctly insert the battery by matching polarity on the battery to the unit.

Q : Recording does not work..

A : Isn't HOLD button switch set ?

Release the HOLD button.

A : Is there no space for recording ?

Erase the unnecessary contents.

A : Isn't the battery exhausted ?

Replace with new battery.

Q : Playing does not work..

A : Isn't HOLD button switch set ?

Release the HOLD button.

A : No messages recorded in the unit ?

Check for the recording number.

A : Isn't the battery exhausted ?

Replace with new battery.

Precautions

Precautions These are for your own safety.
