• MP3 , WMA & ASF Playback

Support MP3, WMA and ASF format.

MP3 encoding function

Record directly into an MP3 file from audio device such as CDP, MD or Walkman through the cable.

High-Quality voice recording with MP3 format

Save a digital voice recording file as a high quality MP3 file.

Listening to/Recording of FM RADIO

Auto search and station memory function make it easy to listen to the FM radio. And you can also convert an FM radio program into an MP3 file in real time.

Easy Navigation

The simple navigation makes it easy to find and save any song.

Lyric display (Media Sync)

The words of a playback song or foreign language files will be displayed in LCD screen.

USB Storage Device

You can easily copy and paste PC files to the player using built-in USB connector and windows. It is immediately recognized as a removable storage device without Manager program (Windows ME or Higher).

Convenient firmware upgrade

Transfer the upgraded firmware file to the player and power off. When power on, the player will be automatically upgraded.

Support 7 color LED Backlight

You can select among 7 backlight colors.



You can connect another earphone to the Line In jack when Encoding function is not in use.



Inserting a Battery

Slide the cover to open. Insert a battery in the correct direction, then slide cover back on.



(Battery : AAA, LR03 or UM-4 or equivalent)

Power ON

Set HOLD switch to the OFF position and press the PLAY/STOP button for 2 seconds.

The player will then power on.

Power OFF

Press the PLAY/STOP button for 2 seconds, the player will power off. For managing your battery life time efficiently, the player will automatically power off if no buttons are pressed in STOP state.

HOLD Function

Under HOLD mode, buttons will not work. Slide the HOLD switch on the player in the direction of the arrow.


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Setting up MODE

Press MENU button for over 2 seconds during playback , and you can directly enter the MODE SELECT mode.


Press MENU button in STOP mode, and you can enter the 'MAIN MENU' mode.


FM MODE

Select Equalizer

While playing music files, Press REC/STOP button for over 2 seconds. EQ mode will be changed in below order. NORMAL -> ROCK -> JAZZ -> CLASSIC -> POP -> USER EQ You can also select the desired Equalizer in MENU mode.

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Change the Playback Speed

When playing music files, press MENU button. The playback speed is changed the selected speed.

And press MENU button one more time, playing at normal speed.

The playback speed can be selected in MENU mode.



Setting up Loop Repeating

- While playing music files, press REC/STOP button once to select the beginning point. A loon will be blinking.
- 2. Press REC/STOP button again to select the ending point.
 - A►B Icon appears in the display. The loop is played repeatedly.



3. Press REC/STOP button briefly to cancel the loop.


INTRO Playback

You can set the INTRO playback in MENU mode. Each file is played for 10 seconds. While INTRO playing, press PLAY/STOP button to cancel INTRO Playback.

Lyric Display (Media Sync)

To apply Lyric display function, press REC/STOP button in STOP state. To release, press REC/STOP button one more time in STOP state. You can also apply the Lyric display function in MENU mode.




Function & Structure of MENU

You can enter the MENU mode by pressing MENU button when STOP state

If you press MEMU button in each MENU mode, you can select SUB MENU section.

To Confirm the MENU setting, press MENU button once more.

MAIN MENU




MODE MENU: You can select MUSIC, FM RADIO, RECORD mode by using FF/REW and MENU button.

DISPLAY MENU: You can select LED COLOR, LCD CONTRAST, BACKLIGHT TIME, and SCROLL SPEED.


COLOR : Setting up LED Backlight COLOR

You can change the Backlight Color among the RED, GREEN, BLUE, CYAN, MAGENTA, YELLOW, and WHITE.




CONTRAST : Setting up LCD CONTRAST

Select the LCD Contrast by using FF/REW button. The setting range of the LCD Contrast adjusts from 1 to 10.



BACKLIGHT : Setting up LED BACKLIGHT TIME Select the Backlight Time by using FF/REW button.



SCROLL : Setting up SCROLL SPEED

Select the scroll speed of the file name.



SETTING MENU: You can select MEDIA SYNC function, REPEAT, Equalizer, and USER EQ setting.


MEDIA : Setting up MEDIA SYNC function

You can see the Lyric or Foreign Language TEXT on the LCD display.



REPEAT : Setting up Repeat Mode

You can select desired Repeat Mode.

EQUALIZER : Setting up EQUALIZE Mode You can select the Equalize Mode.




USER EQ: Setting up USER EQUALIZE

You can set the User Equalize.

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Select the Band you want to adjust by using FF/REW button. In the selected Band, the level can be adjusted by using VOL+/VOLbutton.



🔊 MP3 PLAYER

GENERAL: You can select INTRO PLAY, PLAYBACK SPEED, FORMAT, and POWER OFF TIME MENU.

INTRO PLAY : Setting up INTRO PLAY

Select "Yes" and press MENU button, and each file is played for 10

seconds.



PLAYBACK SPEED : Setting up Playback Speed You can select the playback speed.

'+' means the fast playback and '-' means the slow playback.



FORMAT : Initialize the built-in Memory Select 'YES', the built-in memory is formatting.



[NOTE]

It takes a few minutes to format the memory. All files will be deleted after the memory is formatted. After format, you should download the font.

POWER OFF TIME : Setting up Automatic Power Off Time

You can select the automatic power off time.

Automatically turns itself off if no buttons are pressed for

the selected power off time in STOP state.



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NAVIGATION MODE

Press the MENU button for over 2 seconds in STOP state, and enter the NATIGATION mode.




Select Folder or File

Select using VOL+/VOL- button. A selected file displayed by black icon.



Move to Upper/Lower Folder


1. Select desired folder by using VOL+/VOL- button.


4. Font setting is completed. And the player is automatically powered off.




🛗 FM RADIO

Listening FM (87.0MHz~108.0MHz)

Change the MUSIC or RECORD mode by pressing MENU button for over 2 seconds.



Press briefly FF/REW button, and the frequency changes by 0.1MHz.




- AUTO SCAN Function: Press FF/REW button for over 2 seconds, and channel is selected automatically.
- You can select the STEREO/MONO by using PLAY/STOP button.

[NOTE] AUTO SCAN may not work within weak transmission area.

PRESET function (Listening saved channel)


Press MENU button once.



🛗 FM RADIO


MEMORY Function (Save channels)

Select channel to be saved by using FF/REW button .




AUTO MEMORY Function (Save channels Automatically)

Automatically select channels and save them in sequential order by using FF/REW button.




[NOTE] If you use AUTO MEMORY function, All saved channels will be deleted.

[NOTE] AUTO MEMORY may not work within weak transmission area.


m FM RADIO

MEMORY Delete Function (Delete saved channel) Select channel to be deleted by using FF/REW button at PRESET mode.



To record FM

Press the REC/STOP button during FM mode. To stop recording, press the REC/STOP button again. The recorded file is saved as FMR001.MP3.



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[NOTE] The recorded file is saved in the RECORD folder.

RECORDER

Change the MUSIC or FM MODE by pressing MENU button for over 2 seconds.

Setting the Recording Mode

By pressing MENU button, you can enter the Record setting mode. By pressing VOL+/VOL- button can move each setting mode. Press MENU button again, Record setting is completed.

Selecting the MP3 ENCODING/VOICE RECORDING MODE

Select MP3 ENCODING or VOICE RECORDING by using FF/REW button.



Setting the CD SYNC : You can use setting at ONLY MP3 ENCODING mode.

Select CD SYNC ON/OFF by using FF/REW button.



RECORDER

Select the Sound Quality.

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Select the sampling frequency and Bit rate by using FF/REW button.



Support sampling frequency and Bit rate is shown as below.

VOICE RECORDING

 Press REC/STOP button, and Voice recording starts. If recording is started, the recording time is displayed in upper line, the file name and the remain time are displayed in lower line.



2. To pause Recording, press PLAY/STOP button. And press REC/STOP button to resume Recording.



3. Press REC/STOP button, and Recording is completed.



MP3 ENCODING

- 1. Connect the Headphone jack of the external equipment to the LINE IN jack of the player.
 - * Refer to "Setting the Recording Mode"
- 2. Set the Bit Rate and CD SYNC in the MENU.
- 3. Press the REC button.



- 4. Press PLAY/STOP button to pause Encoding.
- 5. And press REC/STOP button to resume Encoding.
- 6. Press REC/STOP button, and Encoding is completed.

Test the quality of recording, CD SYNC and audio volume of external equipment before the Encoding.

Encoding can be failed if the sound is weak on the external audio volume. When MP3 Encoding, be sure to connect the cable in the LINE-IN Jack.

DOWNLOAD from the PC and UPLOAD to the PC

Downloading and Uploading file is not necessary to use special management program.

Because Windows recognize the player as Removable Disk, you can use Windows Explorer.

Recorded file will be saved in the RECORD folder.

1. Connect the player to the PC with an USB cable or PC USB port, and "USB CONNECTED" is displayed in the LCD screen. When connected to the USB, the player is detected Removable Disk at the Windows Explorer.



- Select files to download from Windows Explorer and copy the desired files.
- 3. Paste on to the Removable Disk.



FIRMWARE UPGRADE

You can download the firmware file from our Homepage. You should turn off the player after copy the firmware file to it . The firmware upgrade is automatically started when the player is turned on again.
