It features an intuitive operator control panel, plus remote Web management — you can perform setup and diagnostics, check status, monitor operations and logs, and upgrade firmware all from any standard Web browser.

Here's how it works: the libraries contain multiple slots for storing tape media, and use a robotic mechanism to move media automatically and operate independently — unattended.

To keep contents properly organized, a bar code reader inventories all tapes stored in the library and tracks them as they are imported and exported. The optical cartridge-location technology enables precision cartridge handling and inventory, helping to improve the overall reliability of backups.

LTO-4 backs up a staggering 432GB per hour per drive, while your staff is deployed on other work. But you stay in control, with an intuitive LCD interface plus Web-based remote monitoring and management.
