

Before You Begin...

Barrette

Check your local zoning laws.

· Local zoning laws and Home Owners Associations may regulate the location, style and height of your fence or even require a permit signoff beforehand.

Contact your local utilities companies.

You must have the utility companies clearly mark your property • for electrical, gas or water lines to avoid puncturing any unseen underground utilities.

Pay to mark your property line.

· Being proactive will save you time and money from any disputes from neighbors.

Gate posts require an internal support system for weight-bearing purposes and therefore wooden inserts or a post stiffener is required.







NOTE: For Style A rails use a rail plug. For Style B rails use an internal post top.




Style B - Flat Top Rails




- Assemble the center portion by insetting 1.) the vertical boards into the bottom of the horizontal rail. For Style A gates, there are two 4-1/2 in. boards which should be placed on the outer edges of the gate. Add left and right Side Channels on either side. Snap the top horizontal rail on the vertical uprights.
- 2.) For Style A gates, snip off excess material on the upright (Figure 1). Install the assembled center portion into the gate uprights.
- Next, adhere the internal post top (Style B) or 3.) decorative rail plug (Style A) with glue. (Figure 2)
- Make sure the gate is square (Figure 3) and 4.) mark screw position in each of four corners. Make sure the screw placement allows for connection of the rail to the upright. (Figure 4)
- 5.) For Style A gates, secure the rails to the uprights using #2 square drive bit with #10 x 3/4 in. screws (40). For Style B gates, secure the rails to the uprights using #2 square drive bit with supplied screws (20). Repeat in each of the four corners on the front side of the gate and for Style A on the opposite side of the gate (eight corners).
- Mount the gate according to the hinge 6.) instructions.


NOTE: Not all fences, gates, or gate hardware are pool code approved.






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








Semi-Privacy Gates


- Assemble the bottom portion of the gate by inserting the boards into the bottom of the horizontal rail. Add left and right side channels on either side and insert the bottom rail into the gate uprights.
- 2.) For the lattice top, sandwich the mid rail, lattice, u-channel and top rail together. Insert into the uprights.
- 3.) For the open picket top, insert both mid and top rail into the gate uprights and insert pickets.
- 4.) For the closed picket top, add mid rail, insert pickets and add top rail into the gate uprights.
- 5.) Adhere the internal post top with glue.
- 6.) Make sure the gate is square and mark screw position, 2 screws on the top rail (left and right corners) and 4 screws in the mid rail and bottom rail (left and right sides) to the front side of the gate.
- 7.) Mount the gate according to the hinge instructions.




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




Transferable Limited Lifetime Warranty

What is covered: Barrette Outdoor Living warrants vinyl and aluminum products to include; vinyl and aluminum fence, vinyl and aluminum railing and plastic lattice against defects or workmanship for as long as you own your home. Barrette Outdoor Living will at its option replace the product in question with new product of the same or equivalent value at no charge. Barrette Outdoor Living warrants these products against peeling, flaking, splintering, corrosion, rusting or abnormal discoloration under normal use and service per ASTMD 2244. This warranty extends to the original purchaser or transferee as specified herein on the products noted above. Separate and distinct warranties for hardware and other products are not covered under this warranty.

What this warranty does not cover: This limited warranty does not cover damage resulting from accident, unreasonable use, neglect, alteration, improper service, improper installation, acts of God or any other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship. Additionally, this warranty does not cover costs of installation, removal, reinstallation or surface mold and mildew created by excessive environmental conditions. Any service or repair provided outside the scope of this limited warranty shall be at Barrette Outdoor Living's rate and terms then in effect.

What do we do to correct the problems? Should your Barrette Outdoor Living product prove defective under warranty, reference the website or call the phone number listed below. Your problem will be assigned a tracking number and an authorized Barrette Outdoor Living representative will contact you to arrange a convenient time to schedule an onsite inspection, or request pictures, if need be. If after inspection product is deemed to be manufacturer defect we will make arrangements to rectify the issue. You must have proof of your purchase in order for the problem to be corrected.

Transferee Coverage: Warranty coverage will be extended to one transferee on the above listed products with the following limitations. Transferee must obtain an original or copy of the initial sales receipt (with proof of date) from the previous owner(s). Additionally, if fence is purchased from a builder or installer, documentation must be supplied that names the product installed on property and date of transfer.
