In any case, please follow the specifications of this "installation documentation" and the "operating and installation instructions" of the *Thermo Top Evo*.

The corresponding rules of technology and any information from the vehicle manufacturer should be observed during the installation work.

General Instructions

Installation should be carried out according to the general standard rules of technology. Unless specified otherwise, fasten hoses, lines and wiring harnesses to original vehicle lines and wiring harnesses using cable ties. Insulate and tie back loose wires.

Sharp edges should be fitted with rub protection (split-open fuel hose).

Spray unfinished body areas, e.g. drilled holes, with anti-corrosion wax (Tectyl 100K, Order No. 111329). When installing an IPCU, the corresponding settings must be checked or adjusted before installation.











Wiring harness routing diagram




Figure 13 (Y-adapter connector)





Figure 14a (Y-adapter coupling, wire-side view)




Figure 16b (Y-adapter connector)
