

Operating Instructions

Charging

The AC/DC Adaptor and 12VDC Cigarette Lighter Adaptor are only intended for recharging the battery—they cannot be used to directly power the Spotlight. Do not turn the Spotlight on while charging or damage to the unit will result.

- Insert the end of the Adaptor cord into the Charging Jack, located at the bottom of the Pistol Grip.
- Plug the AC/DC Adaptor into a 120VAC outlet or plug the Cigarette Lighter Adaptor into any 12VDC outlet in an automobile, boat or RV.
- The Charge Light Indicator will light up Red during charging. After approximately 4–6 hours the Charge Light Indicator turns Green, indicating the Spotlight is fully charged and ready for use. Unplug the Adaptor.

NOTICE: Do not leave the Battery in a discharged state. Charge the Battery every 3 months if the Spotlight is not in use. This will keep the Battery from wearing down and add to its life. Do not charge the Spotlight for an extended period of time. Overcharging will cause overheating and shorten battery life or damage the unit. Do not charge the Spotlight at temperatures below 40° F.

General Operating Instructions

Note: Before using Spotlight for the first time, fully charge the Battery.

- 1. Hold the Spotlight using the Pistol Grip.
- Squeeze the Trigger. To lock the Spotlight on, slide the Lock Switch down while squeezing the Trigger, then release the Trigger and the Spotlight will stay on.
- When finished using the Spotlight, release the Trigger or push the Lock Switch upward to turn the Spotlight off.
- Store the Spotlight indoors away from children when not in use.
