

1. INSTALLATION


Any device connected to a telephone line must conform to the country's regulations. The CT241-01 model meets the FCC68 standard for installation on the North-American network.

To install a telephone controller in another country, please contact our Customer Service Department for advice on the appropriate model.

ATTENTION: To cut off power in the device, unplug the electricity supply wire. You must never open the CT241, because there is a risk of electrical shock.

MATERIAL PROVIDED

- One CT241-01
- One 120 V power transformer
- One 5-meter telephone cable



1.1 Connection to an Automatic Device

- 1. Mount the CT241 on a wall close to a telephone outlet.
- 2. Insert one end of the telephone cable in the "Line" connector on the CT241 and the other end into a telephone outlet in your home.

The four outputs of the CT241 allow you, for example, to activate the entry lighting or the watering system, reactivate the water-heater, etc.

The capacity of the relay outputs is 250 V/10A. However, to avoid electrical shocks, the direct connection of a charge with a tension higher than 30 VAC is not permitted, unless the CT241 is installed inside an electrical box certified by the standard setting body of the country.


2. USING WITH A TELEPHONE

It is possible to change the status of the CT241 output relay, with the telephone keys.

By default, the CT241 is configured to answer after four telephone rings and to accept the access code "1234". These settings are programmable. You can modify them by referring to sections 2.4 and 2.5.

Note that the CT241 will automatically hang up if no keys are touched for 30 seconds.

2.1 Accessing the telephone controller with the access code




2.2 SELECTING AN OUTPUT




The CT241 indicates the status of the selected output.

2.3 Changing the output status (*)





* If you enter the wrong access code more than 3 times, the communication will stop and you will have to go back to step 3.

2.6 Logging Off (# 0)

When you have finished, press # ① to end the session with the CT241. You can also simply hang up the handset. The CT241 will then disconnect within 30 seconds.





3. CHANGING THE STATUS FROM THE CT241

You can switch the relay status by pressing on the CT241 corresponding buttons. This function is not accessible while the CT241 is answering a telephone communication.



4. RESETTING TO THE DEFAULT VALUES

It is possible to return to the default values by using a paper clip to press the Default button located to the left side of the telephone line outlet.

The indicator light located above the button will flash 3 times to signal that the remote control has been reset to the following values:

1) Number of rings: 42) Access code: 1234

3) Output status: • Thermostat mode = Comfort

• Relay contacts 1-2 opened

Relay contacts 2-3 closed

5. USING A TELEPHONE ANSWERING MACHINE

If you own a telephone answering machine as well as the telephone controller, follow this procedure to access the controller by telephone:

- 1- Place the switch, located on the back of the CT241, in the answering machine mode. When you change the switch position, you must unplug the CT241 so the change can be effective.
- 2- Make sure the answering machine answers after a certain number of rings. This number has to be higher than 4.
- 3- Call home, let the telephone ring once and hang up.
- 4- Wait 10 seconds and call back.
- 5- The CT241 will answer on the first ring. However, you must call back within 30 seconds.

Note that programming a certain number of rings before the CT241 is activated has no effect when it is used with an answering machine.

6. LIGHT INDICATORS

The CT241's light indicators allow you to diagnose your installation.


Power: Indicates that the circuit is under tension.

Hook: Indicates that the remote control has opened the line.

Ring: Flashes during ringing.

Default: Flashes 3 times to indicate that the reset has been accepted.

Output's light indicator: Activated output
