



NRA BASIC INSTRUCTOR TRAINING (BIT) & PISTOL INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

The NRA Pistol Instructor Training Course will certify a candidate (upon successful completion) as an NRA Pistol Instructor. Certification as an NRA Pistol Instructor will qualify an individual to help run BSA Pistol Ranges and serve as a Consultant for Venturing Pistol Shooting Activities

This course is two days in length. Attendance both days is mandatory.

Course Prerequisites: Candidates must be 21 years of age or older and be currently registered with the BSA. Candidates must either have completed an NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) Course within two years of the Pistol Instructor Course or take the BIT course offered in conjunction with this course.

Course Dates: August 23 & 24, 2014

Course Time: BIT course will be from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Saturday, August 23. Pistol Instructor course qualification begins at Noon, Course will follow until 5:00 PM Saturday, August 23 then resume from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Sunday, August 24.

Course Location: Camp Mack Training Center

Course Cost: \$180 for Pistol Instructor Course, \$50 for BIT Course, \$220 for Both

Registration Minimum & Limit: Minimum course size is 8 participants. Each course is limited to 16 participants. First Come, First Served
