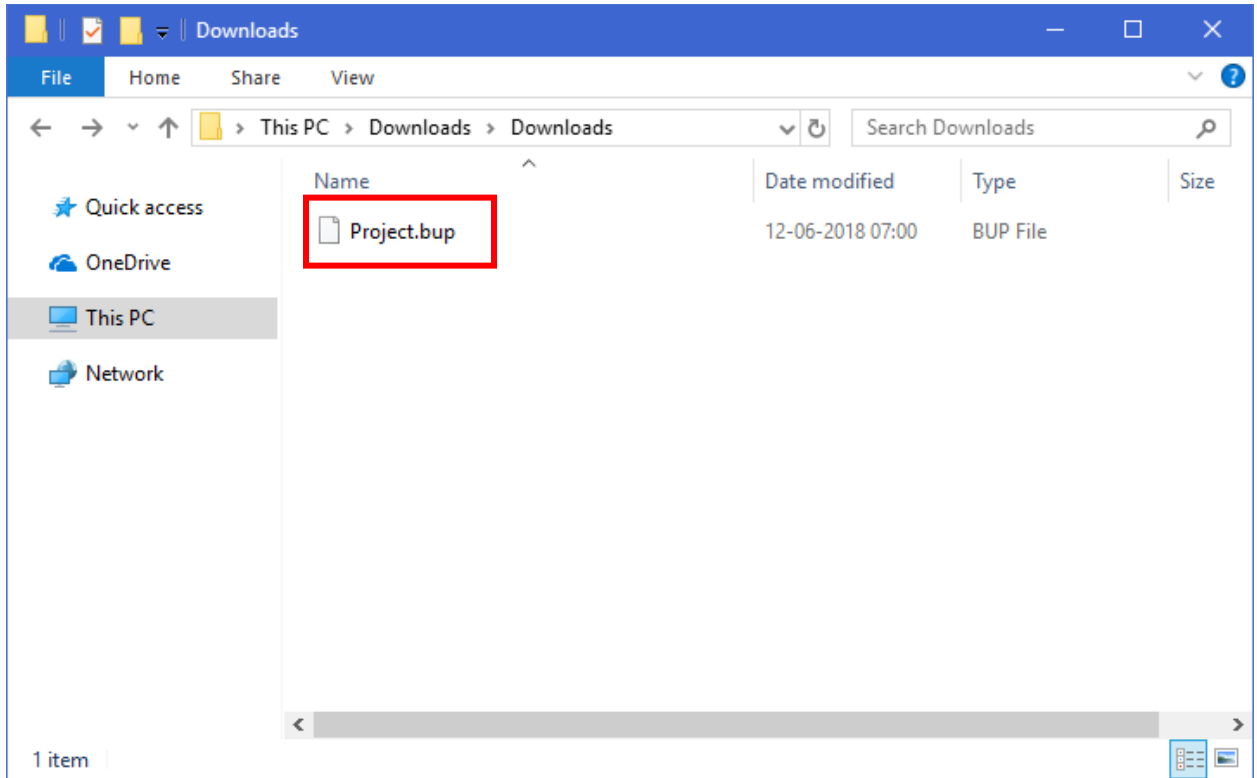

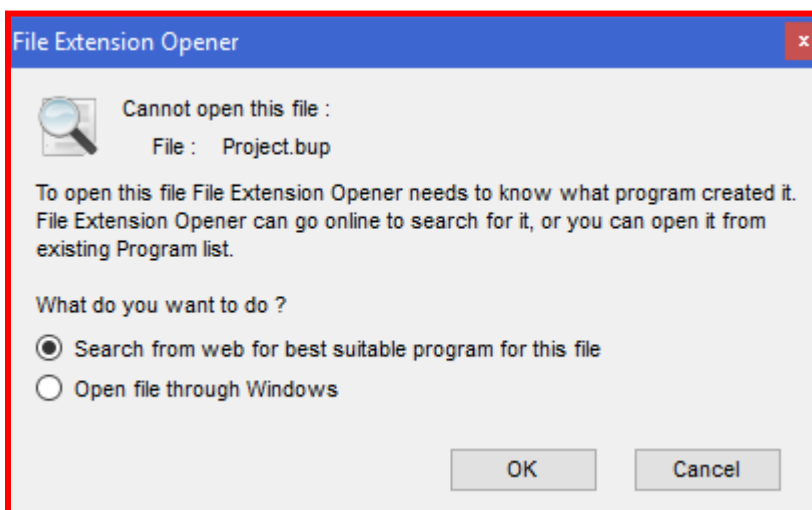
## Open Any Extension File

To open files of any unknown extension on your PC, follow the steps listed below:

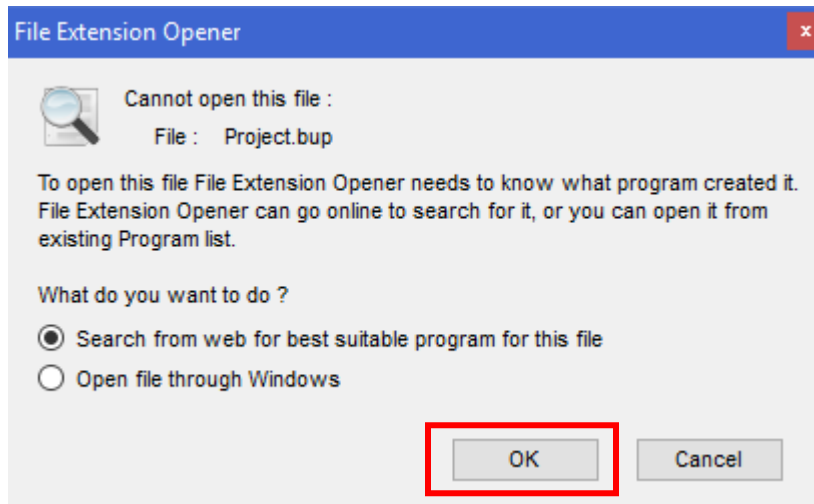
1. Double click on the **unknown extension file “.bup”**.



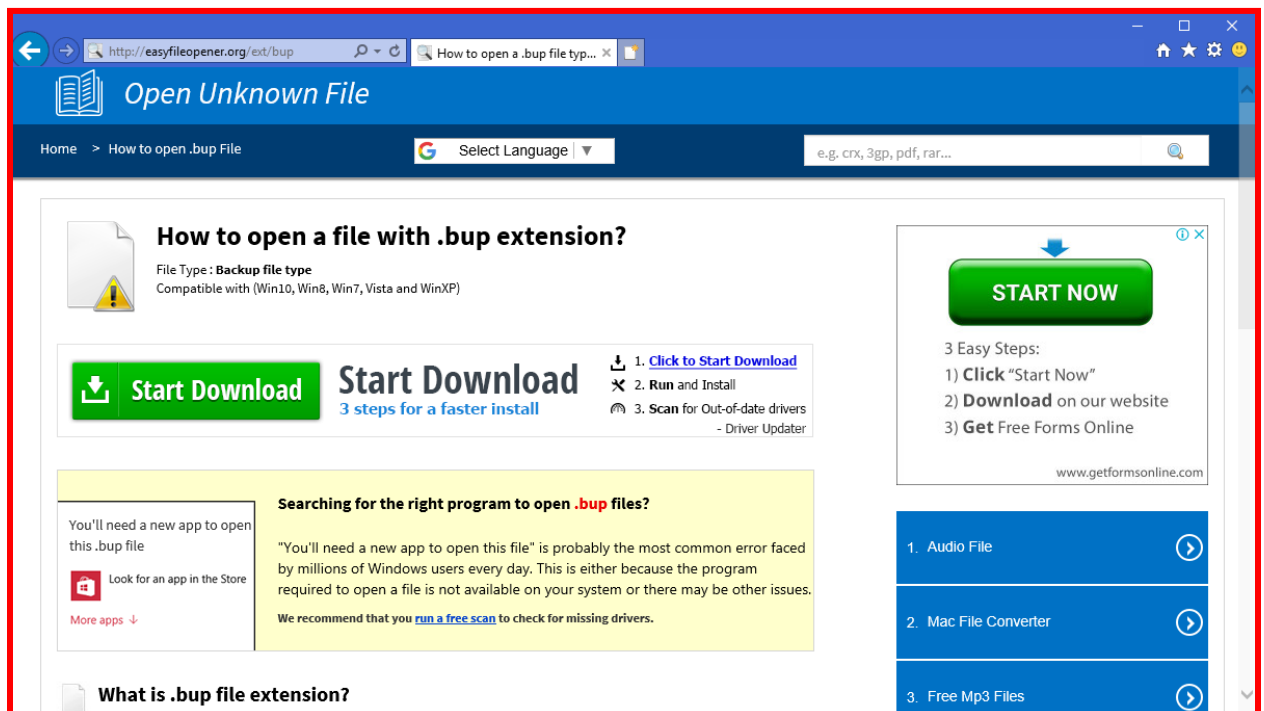
2. **File Extension Opener** application's window opens.



3. Click on 'OK' to search for suitable applications to open the file.



4. You'll be redirected to easyfileopener.org where you will find a list of suitable programs to open the file.



5. **Download** the program of your choice to open your unknown extension file.
