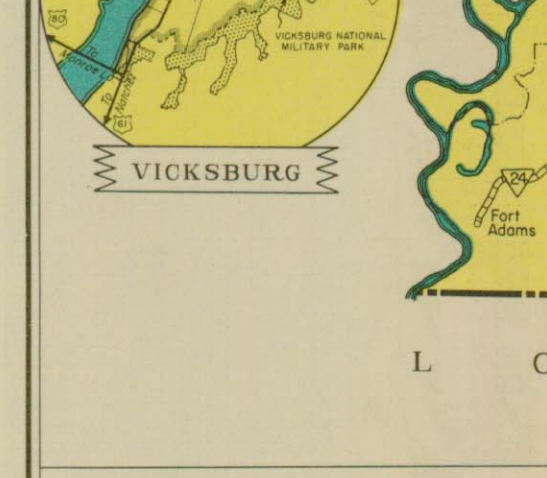
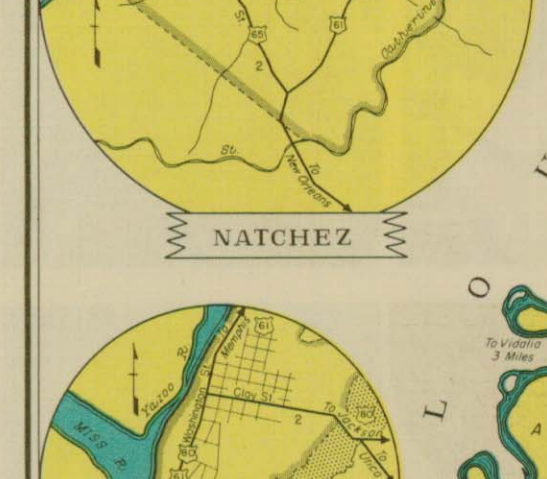
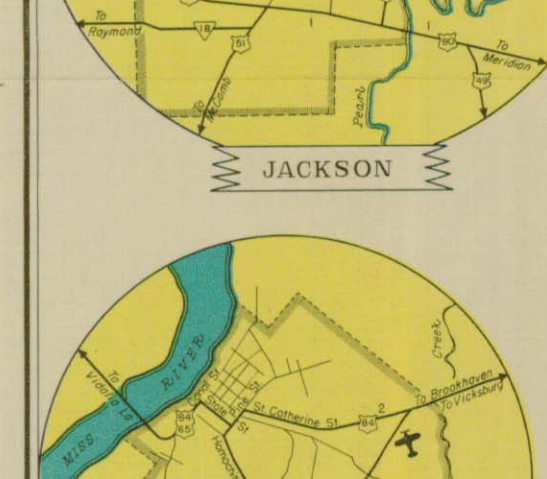
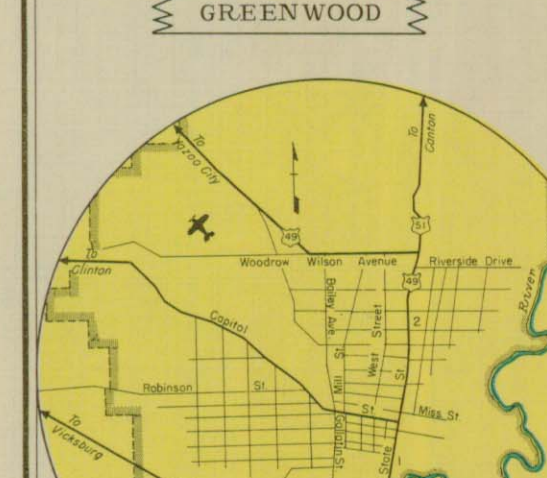
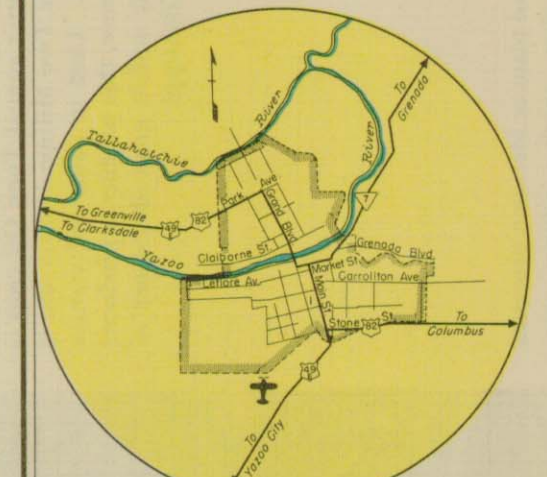
HAND SIGNALS

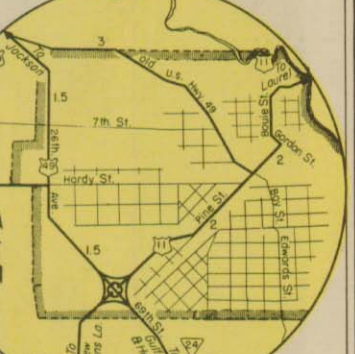
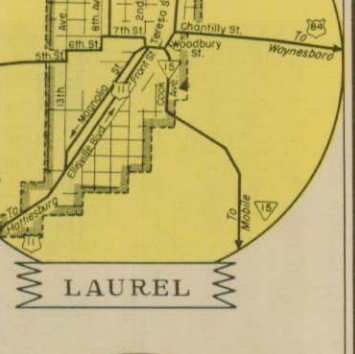
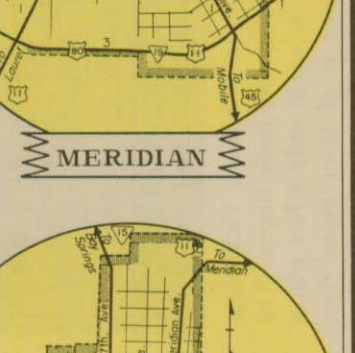
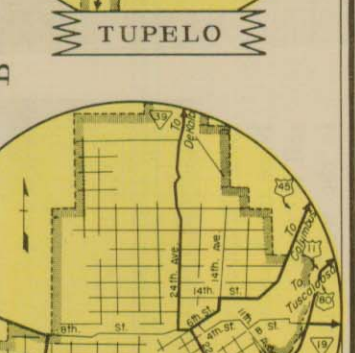
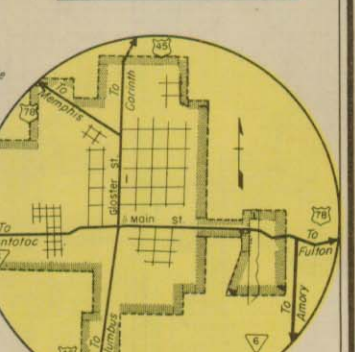
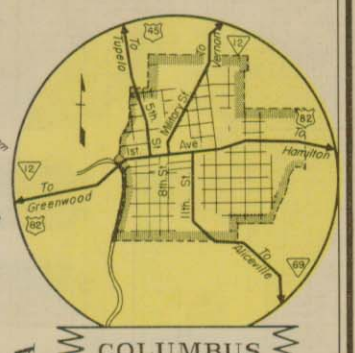
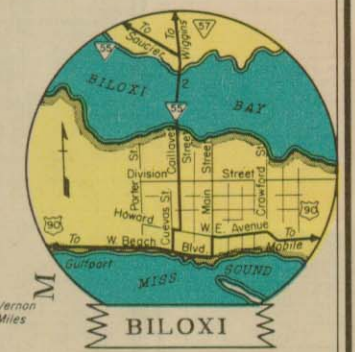
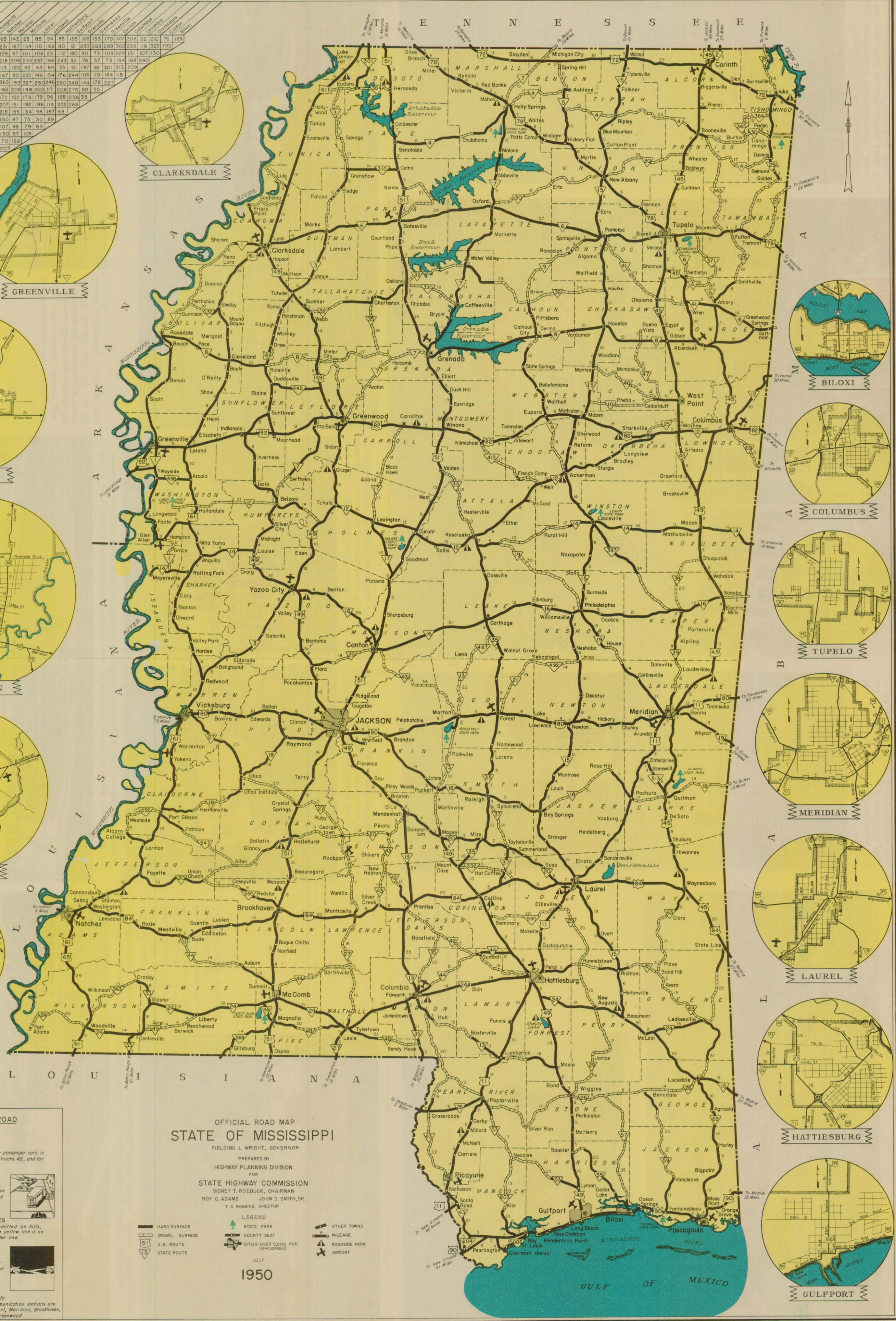
SPEED LIMITS
The speed limit for passenger cars is 60 miles per hour, for trucks 45, and for passenger buses 55.

SCHOOL BUSES
It is against the law to pass any school bus that has stopped to load or unload passengers.

HILLS AND CURVES
Passing is not permitted on hills, curves, or wherever a yellow line is on your side of the center line.

NIGHT DRIVING
Bright or glaring headlights must be dimmed for approaching traffic at night.

In case of accident or emergency, notify the Mississippi Highway Patrol. Radio communication stations are maintained at Jackson, Hattiesburg, Gulfport, Meridian, Brookhaven, Starkville, New Albany, Batesville, and Greenwood.
