Operator Comfort and Support

Laser Level

Hyster reach trucks offer an optional laser level which provides a laser line at the fork tips to indicate fork position and an optional fork camera which provides a fork eye view of the pallet entry at elevated heights, enhancing retrieval and put away capabilities. A shelf height selector system and a load weight display are also available.




Rear Drive Handle on Fore/Aft Stance Reach Trucks with Fore/Aft Automotive Steering

Power Assist Steering

The Power Assist Steer option helps operators move heavy loads through tight turns and crowded loading areas with ease. It requires less effort from the opertor, reducing fatigue and enhancing truck maneuverability. Four operator selectable, programmable performance modes allow operators to tailor the truck to meet their preferred working style or to meet application requirements.



Coast Control

Hyster Company has shortened the fork tip length of the W40Z by two inches and redesigned the bumper to provide a tighter right angle turn for easier right angle stacking and equal aisle placement. The fully boxed fork tips improve angled pallet entry, allowing the forks to straddle the centerboard when pin-wheeling and entering the pallet at a right angle. The combination of shorter fork tips and unique bumper profile allows operators to load two additional pallets per trailer, boosting their productivity and your throughput.



Hyster offers an optional Extreme Corrosion/Wash Down Package* that provides extra protection for applications that require frequent wash downs, or that expose the pallet truck to potentially corrosive agents. The galvanized frame, lift linkage, battery well, and fork weldment are designed for use in highly corrosive environments like food processing, pickling, tannery, chemical, salt and brine industries.
