 - High school or GED certificate
 - All college

What is the TEAS?

Entrance Test


Tests English, math, reading, and science skills
 No calculators
 Computerized

Results are good for 3 years at TCL

Cost is \$60
 Pay for test in Building 2, Cashier

Takes about 3¹/₂ hours to complete
 Computerized

Able to print results on completion



1. Apply to TCL
