Here are somethings that might help answer questions you might have. If you have others please feel free to leave a comment below and we will try to answer your question quickly.

- They are for full day admission tickets for any single regular season day May 5th through September 24th.
- Tickets include the Preview Plan.
 - When you purchase a regular full-day admission ticket, you can enter the night before your big day for 2 1/2 hours prior to Park closing. Just show your ticket at the Front Gate and you can start enjoying the fun early!
- There are no blackout dates or ride restrictions.
- There is no limit to the number of tickets you can purchase.
- This is for a single day ticket only, does not apply to two-day tickets.
- You can purchase your tickets now to use later. Tickets purchased in April are still good in August.
- **Tickets on your smartphone** you can save your ticket on your smartphone and scan them at the gate.
- If you do not get your confirmation email for some reason after your ticket purchase, Hersheypark staff can look up your order by the credit/debit card number that was used to purchase the tickets and print them off for you at the park. Also you might want to check your email junk folder, a lot of the emails from Hersheypark end up in the junk.
- You are purchasing the tickets directly from Hersheypark, not from the Boy Scouts. You are just using Our link into the Hersheypark website and the special coupon code to get your discount. If you encounter problems with the ordering process, you must contact Hersheypark at 1-800-HERSHEY (800-437-7439). You can also email them at onlineticketshelp@hersheypa.com.
- You do not have to be a Boy Scout to use them even if they say something like "Boy Scout Council" on them, that just indicates who they were purchased through. The tickets are good for anyone who buys them.
- The \$3 support for Scouting is included in the discounted ticket price.
- You can order from your phone and then have tickets printed at Ticketing Services as you enter the park. They are located at the Tram Circle
- You do not have to be a Pennsylvania resident to get these tickets.

- You do not have to be a US resident to buy these tickets.
- You may be asked to enter a name to put on the ticket do not worry, that ticket can be used by anyone, they do not check IDs at the gate. You can buy tickets for others as well and they will be able to use them without any trouble.
