

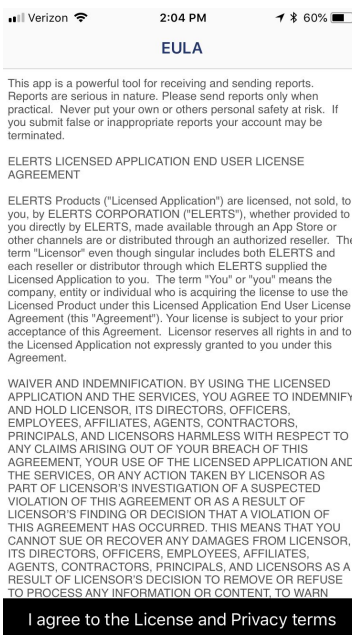
Install & Setup - Metra COPS

After downloading Metra COPS, open the app and you will be navigated through the following setup screen.

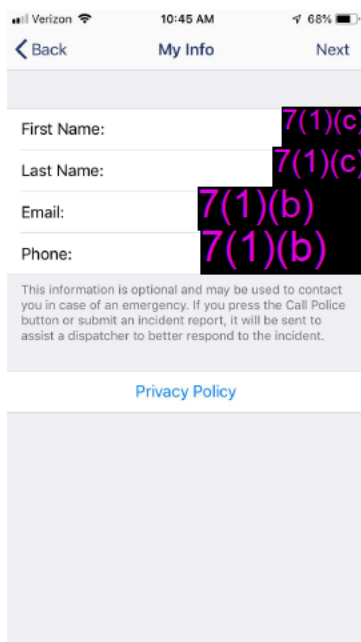

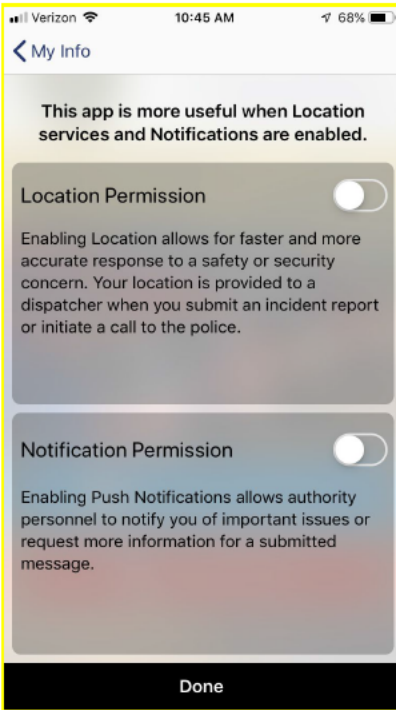
Start Screen - Click Start Using



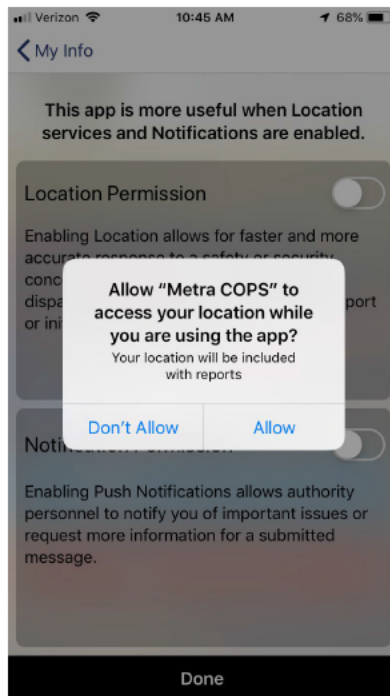

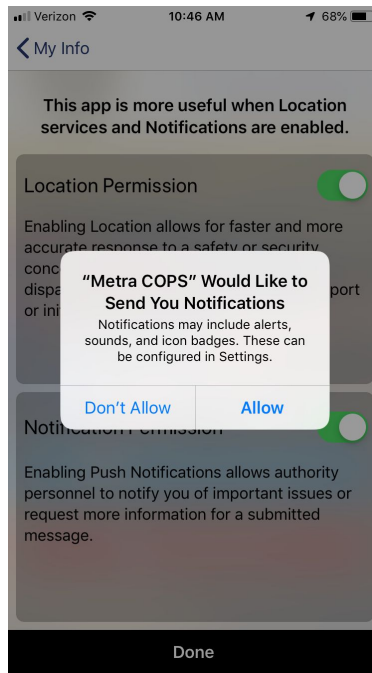

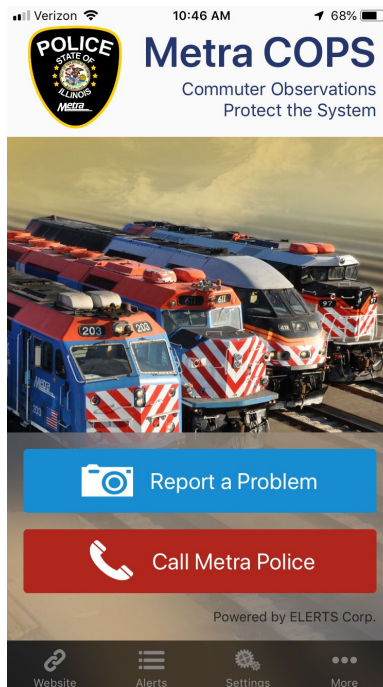




Home Screen > To report an incident, Click the Report a Problem Button




Report a Problem Screen > Enter details

- Verify no spelling errors
- Verify Privacy Link navigates to ELERTS Privacy page

Website Button

Verify Website link navigates to Metra website

More Button

Verify Metra Maps

Verify FAQ & Help (FYI - Waiting for Metra FAQ link which should be posted on Metra website before public launch)

Verify Powered by ELERTS Corp link navigates to ELERTS website

Verify Share Metra COPS (FYI - This share feature will not work until app is in app stores)

Verify Terms of Use navigates to Legal Agreement

Verify Privacy Policy navigates to ELERTS private policy
