

## PROJECT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- Project reports must be submitted in either of the following formats:
  - DOC
  - PDF
  - PPT
  - JPEG
- There are two methods to create and submit your project reports.

### Method 1: Copy code and screenshots in a document

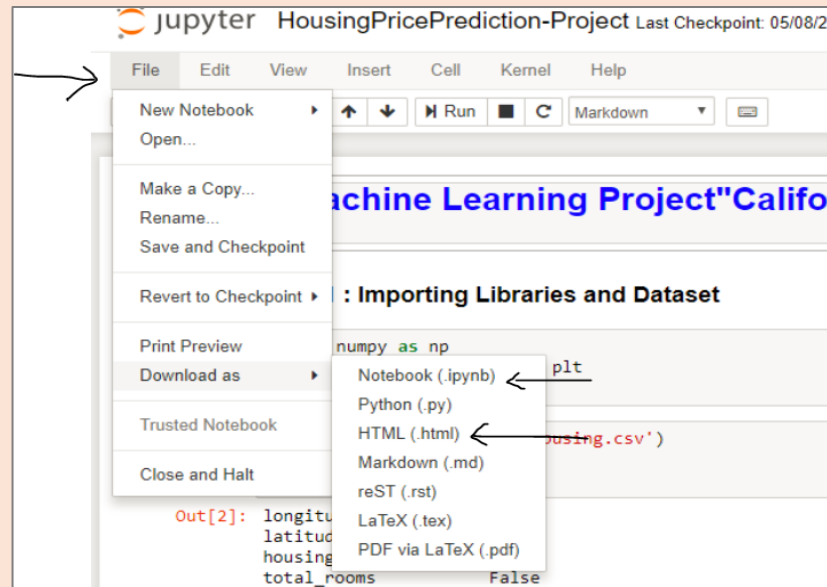
No.	Steps
1	Create a Microsoft Word document and save it as follows: "Project name_Your name"
2	Copy all your code in this document along with the question numbers.
3	Each code snippet must be followed a screenshot of the output. For example: Q1 -> Code -> Screenshot of the o/p Q2 -> Code -> Screenshot of the o/p and so on.
4	Convert this document to PDF (optional).
5	Submit the same document in all the three fields of the project submission form in project tab of LMS: Write-up, screenshots, and source code.

## Method 2: Attach Jupyter notebook to a document

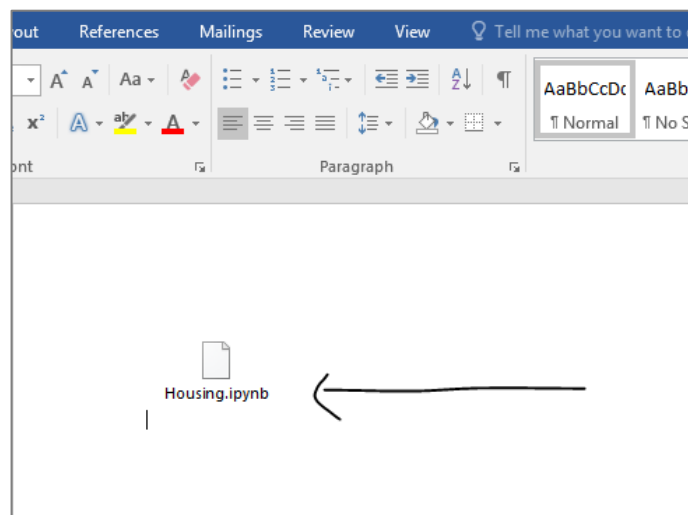
### No. Steps

- 1 Download your Jupyter notebook in **.ipynb** or **.html** format.



**Note:** If you download as html, proceed to step 4.

- 2 If you decide to download in .ipynb format, drag and drop the .ipynb notebook in a new Microsoft word document (.doc).



- 3 Save the .doc file as follows: "Project name\_Your name"

- 4 Submit your file (.doc or .html format) in all the three fields of the project submission form in project tab of LMS.
