Unbranded cattle are an easy target for thieves

Paul Cornett, investigative services special agent for the Oklahoma State Department of Agriculture was the guest speaker at Lions on Thursday.

Cornett is responsible for investigating livestock and farm machinery thefts in Kingfisher, Logan, Oklahoma, Canadian, Blaine, Dewey, Custer, Ellis and Roger Mills counties. He is a staunch advocate of branding cattle and informed the group that altering a brand is a felony in the state of Oklahoma.

"Unbranded cattle thefts

are a difficult crime to solve. Most thieves are convicted felons who grew up in rural areas. Over 70 percent of the thieves want the money to buy methamphetamine," Cornett said.

In 2012, there were \$2.7 million worth of stolen cattle and farm machinery reported to their agency. Of that, \$1 million was recovered.

In other business, Lions will be smoking selected meats and sandwiches at United/Atwoods parking lot on Saturday, March 7.

Lion Mike Frey introduced Cornett.
