Enterprise customers who want to integrate freelance talent into their sourcing models.




Launching and executing an enterprise freelance program at scale can be complex and daunting. The Freelance Toolkit makes it streamlined and turnkey.




The future of work is now

According to Field Nation, 86% of freelancers intentionally choose freelancing.








Millennials are a driving force of the gig economy. Nearly half of them are already freelancing.

Usage of flexible talent has increased 24% in the last year.


















Enterprise companies have engaged freelancers for work within their organizations and integrated freelance capabilities into their own operations.



Employees need a place where they can learn how the program works, fulfill their training requirements, and review best practices for working with freelancers.








