Program 20 - System Initialization

- In Edit $\Rightarrow$ Preferences $\leadsto$ General, set the following:
- Default Magnification = Fit Width
- Display Splash Screen at Startup = Disabled (box not checked)
- Display Open Dialog Box at Startup = Disabled (box not checked)
- For easiest reading on-screen, select View $\Rightarrow$ Fit Width (or Ctrl K). This option is automatically enabled if you set the Default Magnification in General Preferences as described above.
- To return to the opening screen at any time, press Home.

To scroll up or down on a page, press PageDown or PageUp.
To navigate between pages, press $\rightarrow>$ or <-.

- To increase the speed with which your Acrobat files load, try one of the following:
- In Windows 3.1, add ACROREAD.EXE to your Startup Group (with the Run Minimized box checked).
- In Windows 95, add ACROREAD.EXE to the Windows\Start MenulPrograms\StartUp folder (with Run Minimized selected).

You'll have to maximize the first Acrobat file you run.

## About the Program Record Form

The Program Record Form lets you record the way you configure a customer's DIGITAL SYSTEM and shows you how to enter the configuration data into system memory. For each program in the system, there is a form (grid) for recording the program's configuration data codes. Next to each grid are instructions for entering the data codes into system memory from a system programming extension (e.g., a display phone connected to port 00, initially extension 300).

You'll find the configuration data codes in the DIGITAL SYSTEM Administrator's Programming Guide (P/N N1872ADG**). Simply turn to a program and look for the heading, Filling Out the Program Record Form. The data codes for each feature option are underneath.

## General Programming Tips

There are four basic steps to entering data codes into system memory. Once you become familiar with them, you will not need to continually refer to the specific entry instructions with each program.

To enter data codes into memory:

1. Enter the program mode from the port 00 phone (initially extension 300) or from another system programming extension (see Program 15).
2. Enter a program.
3. Enter data using the dialpad, erase mistakes, and move through the program's feature options.
4. Save and Exit.

Note: When you program the system for the first time, run Program 20 before any others to ensure that the factory set values are in place.

## Entering the Program Mode

To enter the program mode from the port 00 phone or another system programming extension (see Program 15):

1. Do not lift the handset.
2. Press \# key.
3. Dial SP.

$$
\text { The code SP stands for "System Program" and is } 77 \text { on the dialpad. }
$$

4. Dial 5312.

The code 5312 is the DIGITAL SYSTEM password.
5. Press \#.

If you leave the system in the program mode too long without pressing a key or dialing a code, you'll hear reorder (fast busy) tone, and the system automatically exits the program mode.

## Entering a Program

To enter a program after you enter the program mode:

1. Press the program's key.
-Keys 1-20 give you access to programs 1-20. Keys 1-5 are on the left, keys 6-10 are on the right, keys 11-16 are directly below the dial pad. The HOLD (Program 17), CONF (Program 18), MIC/DND (Program 19), and ICM (Program 20) keys are in the last row of keys. Note: Program numbers 9 and 13 are not used.

## Entering Data, Erasing Mistakes and Moving Through Options

To enter data after you enter a program:

1. Dial the data.
2. Press the \# key.

This step stores the data and moves you to the next feature option.

For example, to enter the data code $Y$ :

1. Dial $Y$, which is 9 on the dialpad.
2. Press \#.

When you dial data for the last feature option in a program and press \#, you exit the level you are working in and return to the previous level. In some cases, "returning to the previous level" means you exit the program and do not have to press SAVE to exit the program (see below).

To erase a mistake (in most cases):

1. Dial * after you dial the mistake but before you press \# to store it.

If you make an invalid entry and press \#, you will hear reorder (fast busy) tone.
You can dial * (in most cases) during the reorder tone and re-enter the data.
To accept the data on the display and move to the next feature option:

1. Press the \# key.

## Saving and Exiting

To save and exit after entering data:

1. Press the SAVE key.

Pressing SAVE moves you out of a program, one level at a time. You may have to press SAVE several times to exit all the way out.

Note: Some instructions in the Program Record Form are abbreviated.

If you finish and do not see, "SAVE TO EXIT": SAVE.

- To exit Program 4: SAVE.

## Program 6-Toll Restriction (cont'd)




## To enter Program 6 data:

1. Enter program mode.

$$
\#+\text { dial } 775312+\#
$$

2. Press key 6.
3. For first-time programming or to initialize (reset) toll levels: Dial I + Y. Otherwise, go to step 5.

To stop initialization after dialing I: Dial $N+$ go to step 5 .
4. To allow the system to accept the new NPA codes, at the prompt "NEW DIAL PLAN-N", dial Y.
5. Dial P to program toll levels.

Re-order tone means: Go to step 1 and initialize in step 3.
6. Dial toll level + \#.
7. To accept the displayed data: \#.

OR
To change the displayed data: Dial data + \#.

- To erase data before pressing \#: Press *.
- ADD-DELETE-LIST means you can enter Table data. Use a-c for Tables 1 through 3. Use the steps on the following page for Tables 4 through 13.
a. Dial A, D, or L. Or, to exit the table at this point: \# and go to beginning of step 7 .
b. To add/delete: Dial codes.

OR
To list more or exit list: \# + go to step 7 a.
c. To save and exit table: \# + go to beginning of step 7.

OR
To save and go to "ADD-DELETE-LIST:" SAVE + go to step $7 a$.
8. Repeat step 7 for all data.

If you finish and do not see, "TOLL LEVEL": Press \# until you see it.

To use the 6-Digit Analysis Tables (4-13) when you see ADD-DELETE- LIST on the display:

1. Dial A, D, or L.

Press \# to exit the table (and Program 6).
2. Dial the area code intended for 6-digit analysis.

If you selected "Listing" in step 1, the system lists the codes now, four at a time. To see more codes or exit at the end of the list, press \# and return to step 1. Steps 3-6 do not apply to listing.
3. Dial A for an Allow Table of NXX codes.

OR
Dial D for a Deny Table of NXX codes.
4. Dial codes to be added or deleted.
5. Select an option:

- To save and go to "ADD-DELETE-LIST" for another area code: SAVE + Go to step 1.
- To save and exit toll level: \# + Go to step 6 on the previous page.
- To save and exit Program 6: SAVE three times.
- To enter another program after exiting: Press its key.
- To SAVE and exit program mode: SAVE four times.

4. To accept the displayed data: \#.

OR
To change the displayed data: Dial data + \#.

- To erase data before pressing \#: Press *.
- To enter circuit type X: DIAL + dial X.
- To enter a name:
a. Press dialpad button for desired character. To enter a blank space, Q, or Z: Press 0.
b. To make a letter appear: Dial the number (1, 2, or 3) that corresponds to the letter's position on the button (e.g. dial 1 if you want the first letter).

OR

## To delete an ACD Supervisor

1. Enter program mode.
\# + dial 775312 + \#.
2. Press key 19 (MIC/DND).
3. Dial Hunt Type for Supervisor's group + \#.
4. Dial Master Extension for Supervisor's group + \#.
5. Press \# until you see Supervisor's Extension.
6. Press *.
7. Press SAVE.
8. Select an option:

- To delete more Supervisor Extensions: Go to step 3.
- To exit Program 19: SAVE.
- To enter another program after exiting: Press its key.
- To exit program mode: SAVE twice.

Note: To accept the displayed data in any step: \#.

## Program 20 - System Initialization

To use Program 20:

1. Enter program mode.
\# + dial 775312 + \#.
2. Press key 20 (ICM).
3. Dial Y to initialize and wait for the date and time to display. When you see the date and time, this means initialization is complete.

OR
Dial N to exit Program 20 without initialization.

- To enter another program: Press its key.
- To exit program mode: Press SAVE.
