Seabase is not risk free and you should be prepared to listen to safety instructions carefully, follow directions and take appropriate steps to safeguard yourself and others. Scouts must be at least First Class before attending and age 14 by January 1, 2018. **The High Adventure Committee selects adult participants based upon adult to youth participation ratio, Scouting Background and BSA Policy**. All participants must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America. The approximate *all inclusive* cost including airfare, transportation, meals and the Florida Keys experience of a lifetime is \$1850.00 per person.
