

18. Locate the .exe file on your computer and then double-click the file to start the installation process.

You might be prompted to install supporting files or applications during the installation process, which could lengthen the installation time.

 2. From your desktop, double-click on the SAS Enterprise Guide icon.
 3. In the **User** field of the Credentials Required window, enter your SAS Server userid (see Step 10).
 4. In the **Password** field, enter your SAS Profile password.
