Amount: \$2500

Deadline: November 12th, 2018

Description: One male, one female senior, \$2,500 each, good to any two-year, four-year college or university, in state or out

Non-renewable

Nominations of one male and/or one female student per public school district, selected by the school board.

Requirements:

High school senior intending on attending college, immediate family member has not earned a college degree, minimum ACT reading score of 20

Amount: \$2000

Deadline: November 2nd, 2018

Requirements: Must address prompt directly in 500 words or less--How do you think concrete could be used to solve an issue facing Kentuckians today?
