Log in to the Cluster



1) Try logging in to the Cluster (Mac/Linux)

Open the program 'Terminal'

```
Type 'ssh username@cluster.tacc.utexas.edu'
>replace 'username' with the username you use to login to the TACC Portal
>replace 'cluster' with the appropriate cluster ('stampede' or 'lonestar')
```

Type your password, hit 'return' >same password as the TACC Portal

2) Try logging in to the Cluster (Windows)

Download and install the program 'PuTTY' >http://www.chiark.greenend.org.uk/~sgtatham/putty/download.html

Enter the hostname: '*cluster*.tacc.utexas.edu', click 'Open' >replace '*cluster*' with the appropriate cluster ('stampede' or 'lonestar')

Enter your TACC username and password, hitting 'return' after each >same username and password as the TACC portal



3) Troubleshooting

• If your username and password are not accepted, first make sure that they work in the TACC User Portal:
