This app is compatible with android devices running on Android Lollipop 5.1.1 or higher.

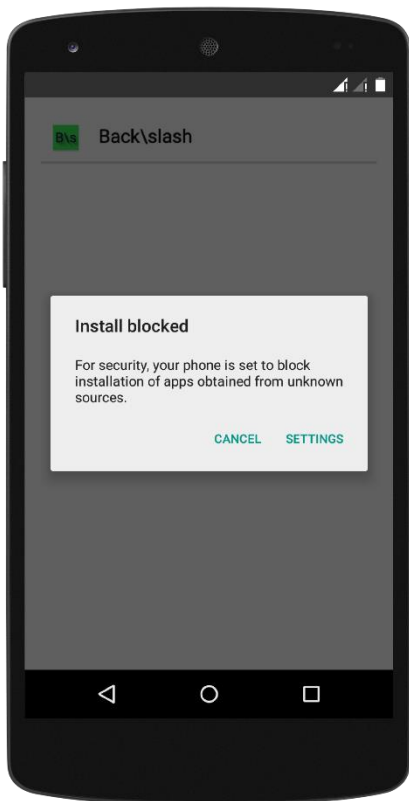

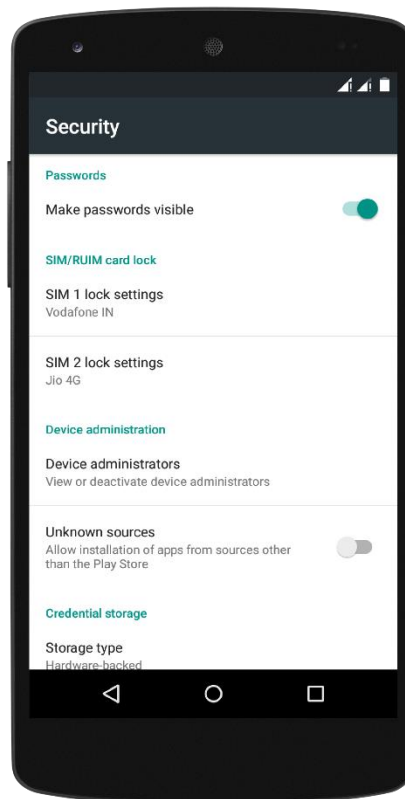

After downloading “backSlash.apk” open it up on your android device.



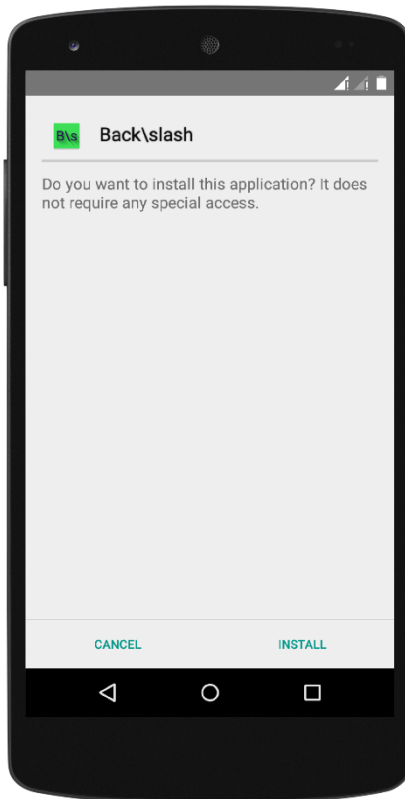
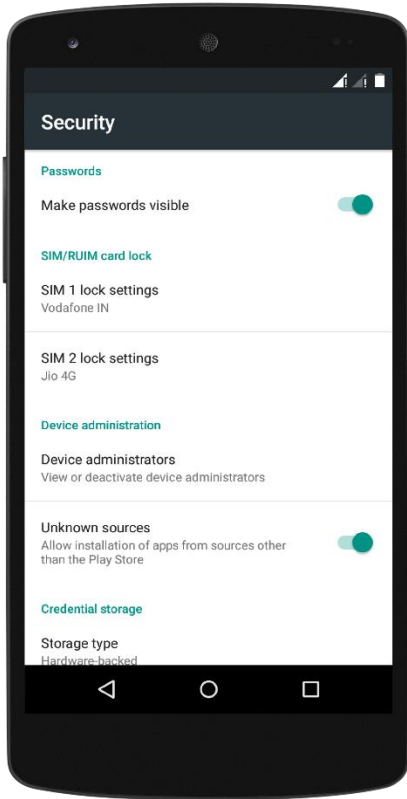
If such a thing appears on your screen saying “Install blocked” then click on settings.



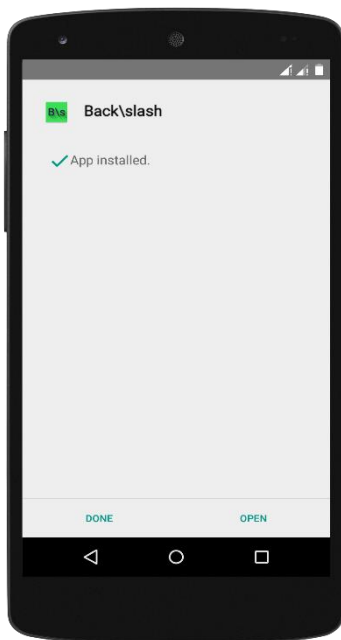
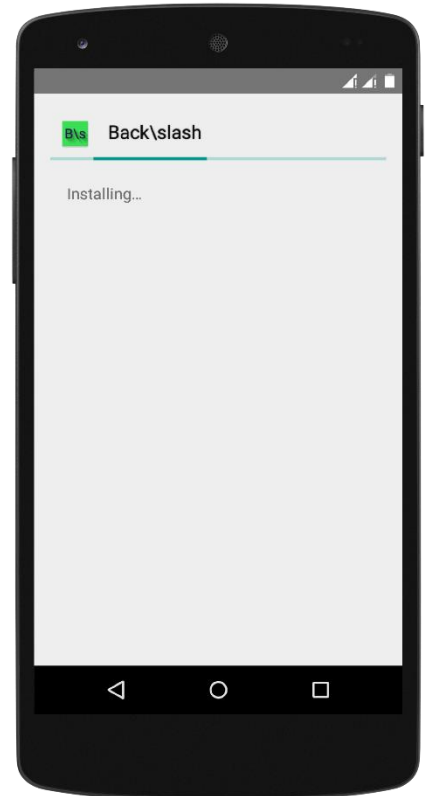
Then you will see that “Unknown sources” is disabled.

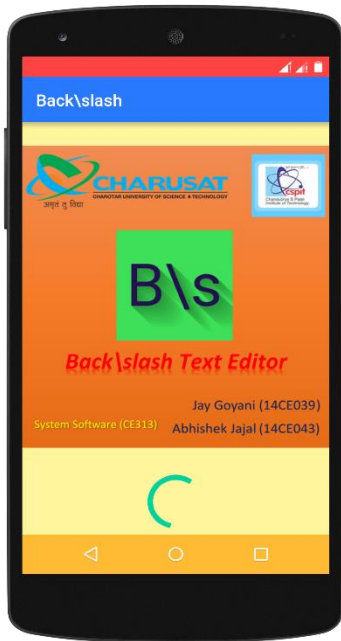
Now click on "Install".



Now click on "open".

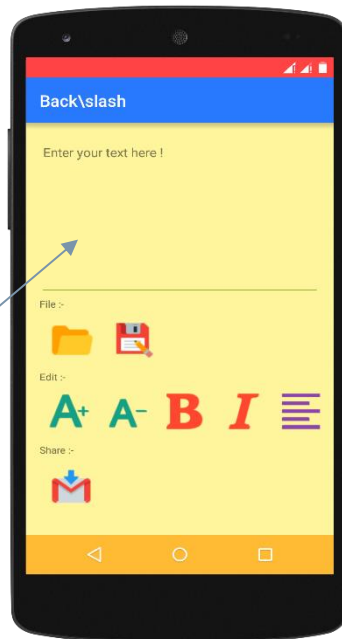
WELCOME SCREEN

- 3) Edit Menu
- 4) Share Button

Text Area

Text Area:-

It is the area where message or any text is typed or any message or text is displayed.

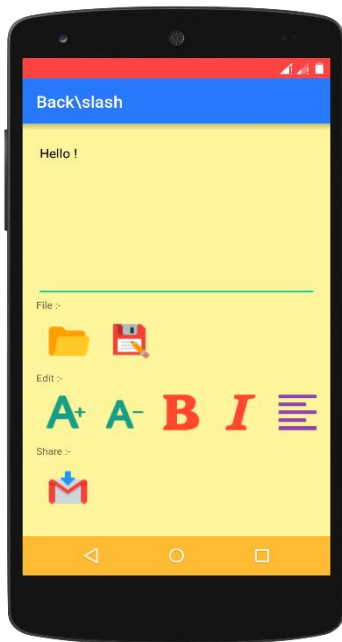
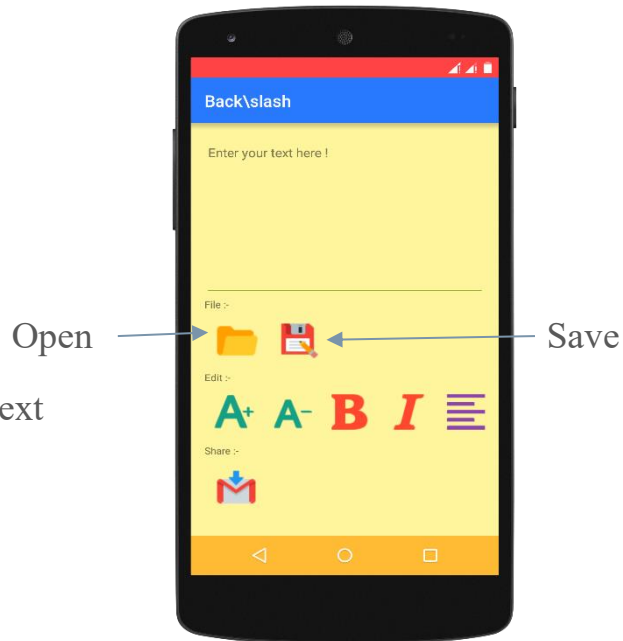
File Menu

1) Save 

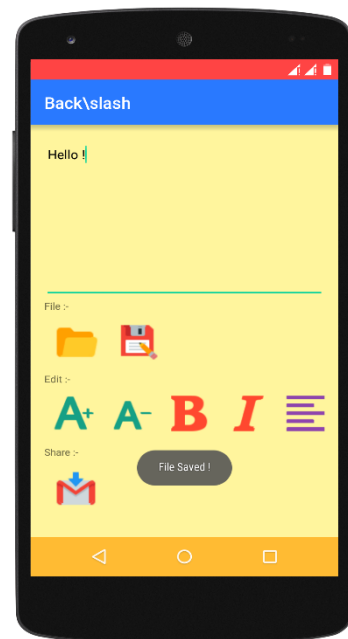
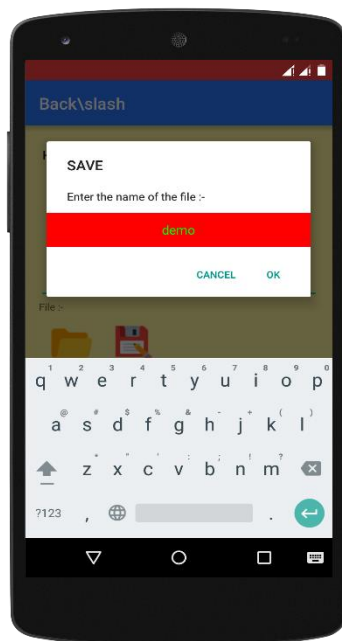
2) Open

Now click on “ok”.

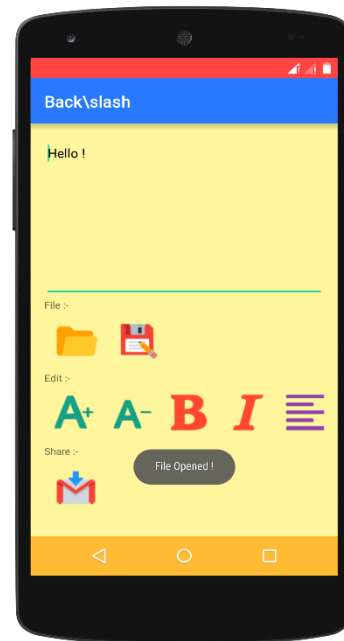
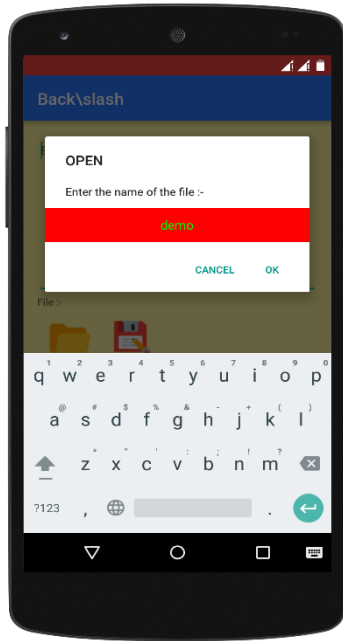
FILE MENU

Similarly, Open: - Display the contents of a given file in Text Area.

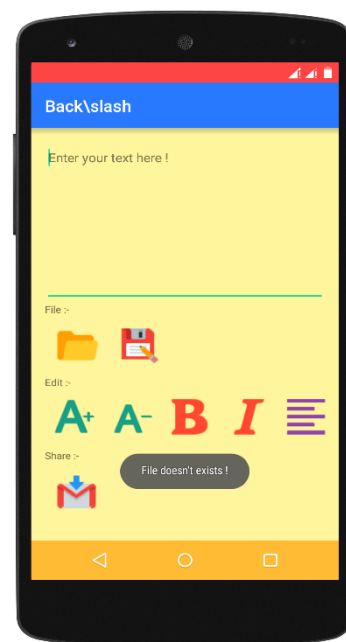
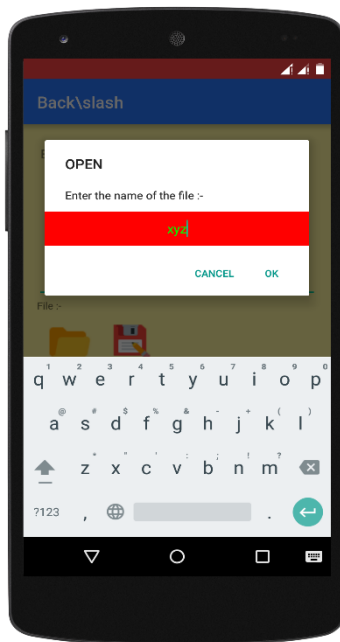
Click on Open button

EDIT MENU

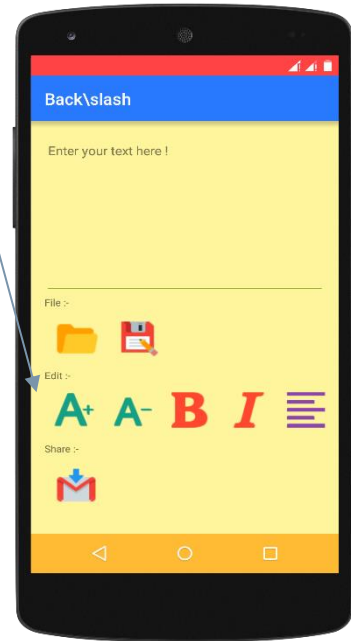
Edit Menu

decreases the size of the text written in the text area.

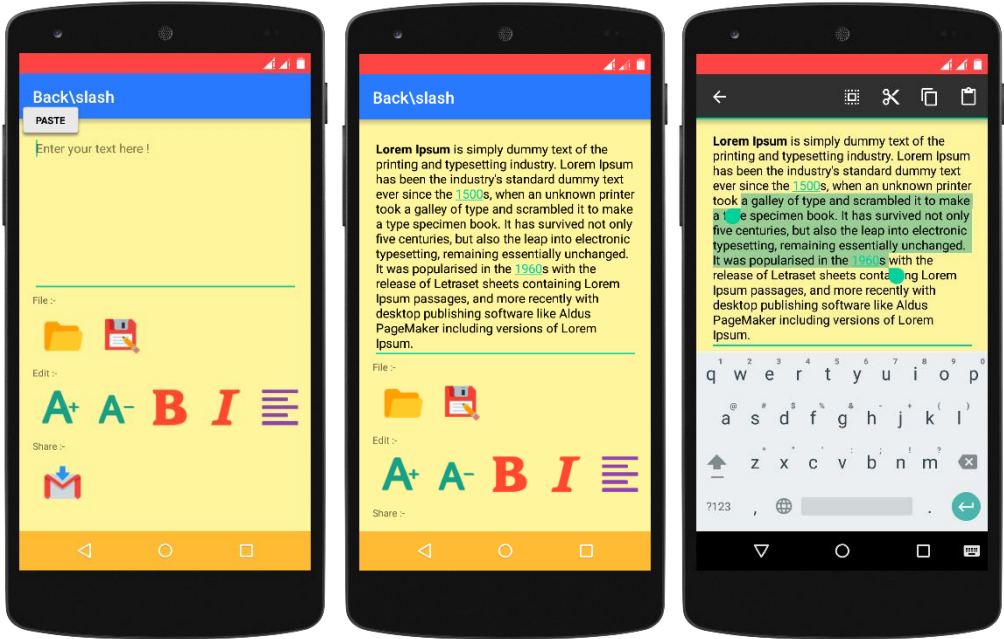

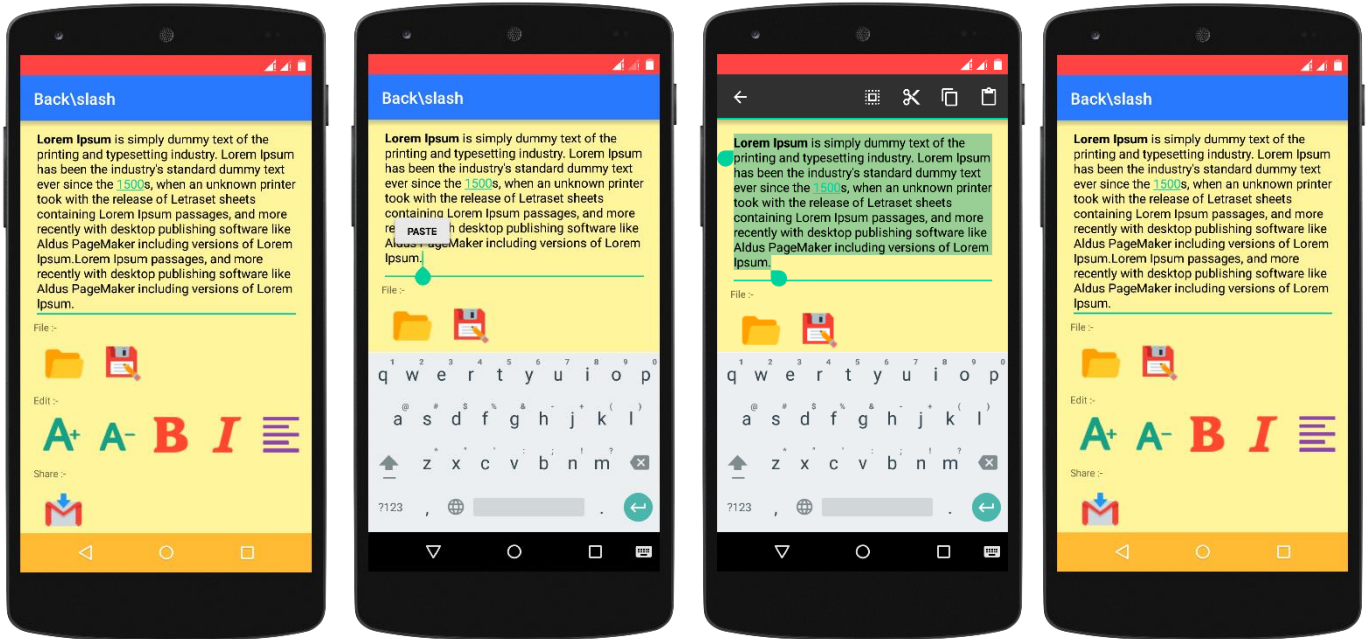


Cut, Copy, Paste:-

These 3 options can be accessed by long pressing the text area.

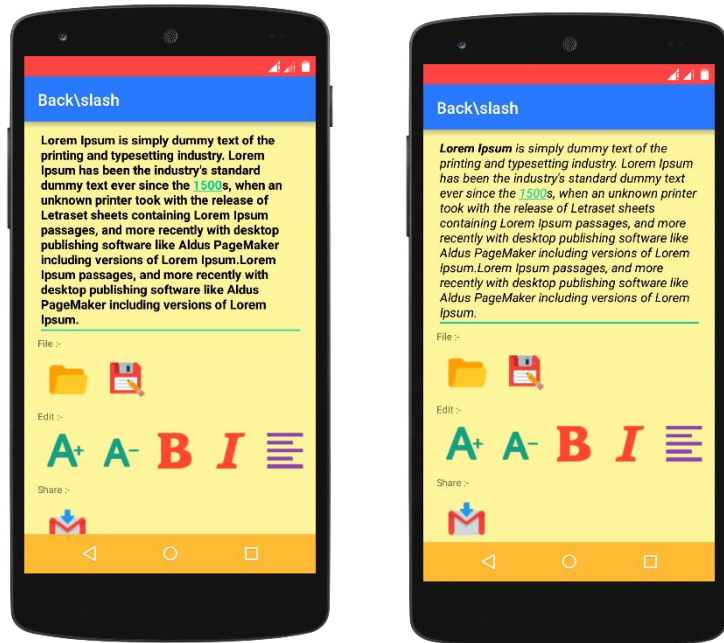

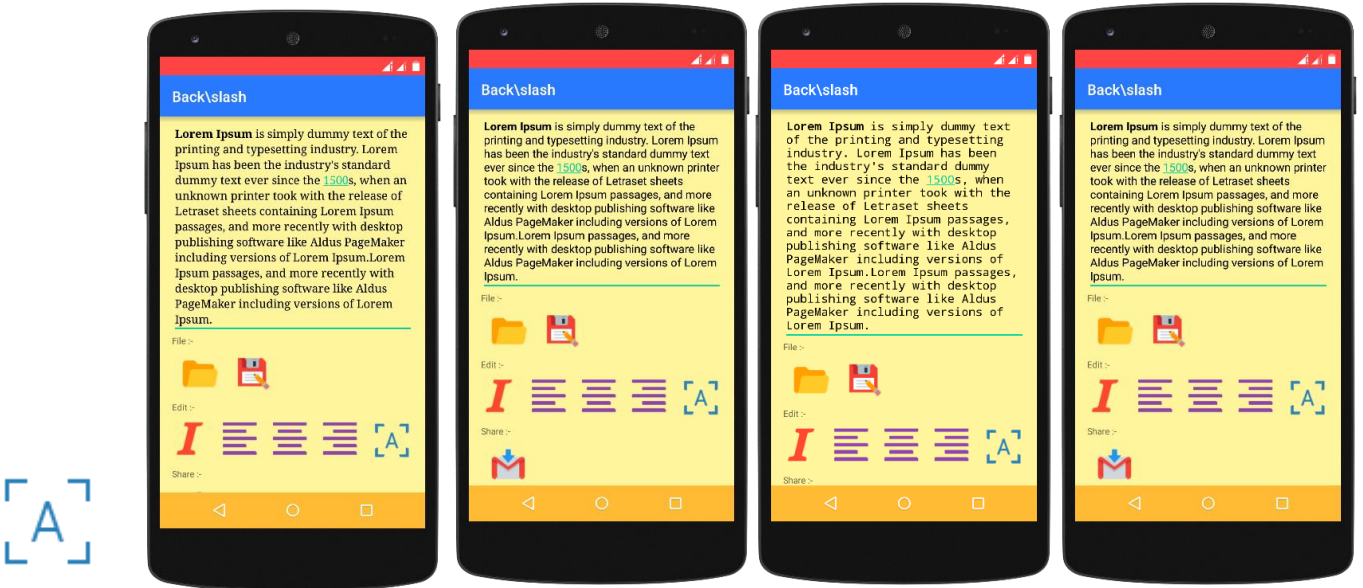
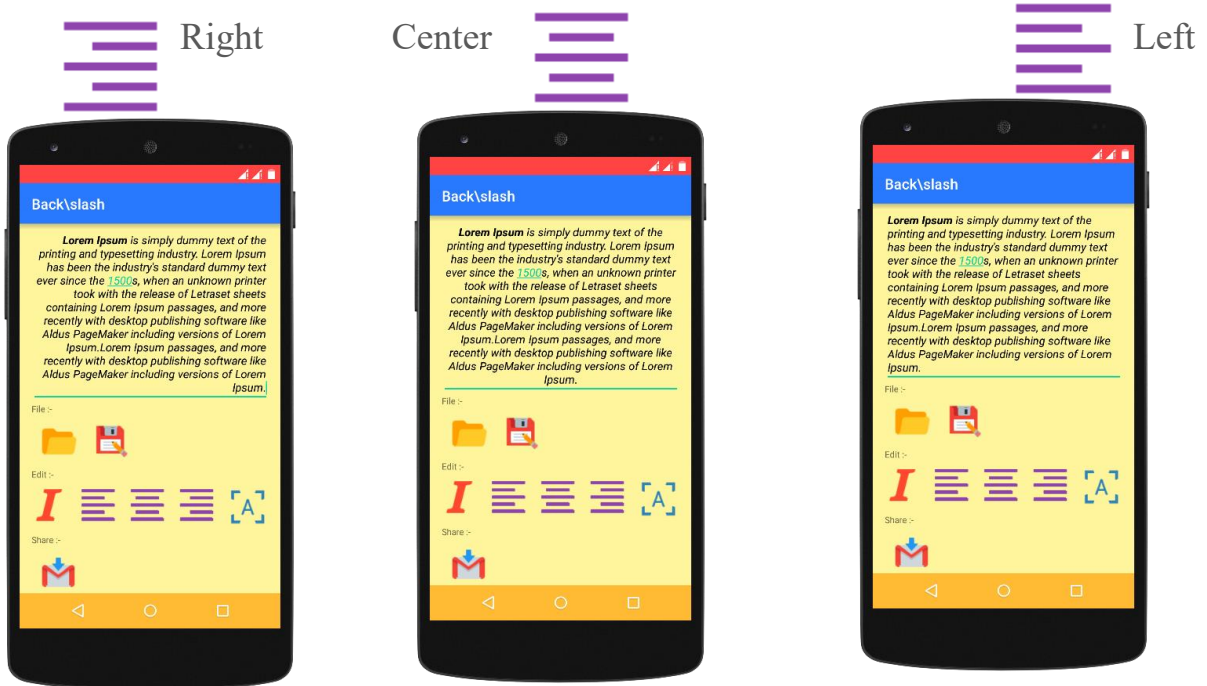
B It makes the text written / displayed in text area to be Bold.

If certain buttons of Edit Menu are not visible in your android device than try scrolling the Edit Menu from left to right.

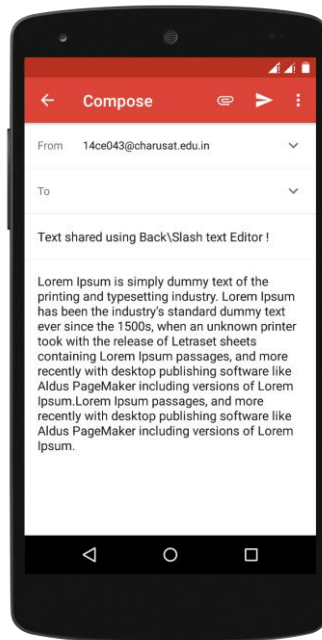


SHARE
