Subject	Extension of Temporary Approval Provisions for the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) Condominium Project Approval Process		
Purpose	This Notice announces extension of the temporary condominium project approval guidelines issued in Mortgagee Letter 2012-18 to allow time for completion of the condominium rulemaking process.		
Background	On September 13, 2013, FHA announced temporary condominium project approval guideline changes to some of the current FHA condominium approval policy provisions. These changes replaced certain approval requirements specifically identified in the ML that were established in ML 11-22 and the attached Condominium Project Approval and Processing Guide (Guide). It was determined that certain policy adjustments were needed to address current housing market conditions.
