Rules and regulations for Students

- The competition has 80 sums for Pre Level and level 1 and 70 sums for remaining levels of MA,TT & SM and ES will have 70 questions. A total time of 5 minutes will be given.
- Participant should wear Aloha T-Shirt and should bring admit card printout downloaded from www.alohaonline.in or www.alohaindia.in, while reporting for Competition. Admit card should be produced at any point of time during the Competition or Prize Distribution day.
- Question paper printed with Admit card number will be distributed by the invigilators. Participants will be given time to check the Admit card number and Question Paper number are matched.
- 4. Participants MUST NOT start writing on the question paper until the first bell rings.
- 5. Participant caught copying or speaking during the competition will be disqualified immediately.
- 6. Participant can do the Competition using the ABACUS, FINGER or MENTAL THEORY (visualizing the abacus).
- 7. The Competition must be done using a pencil. Use of eraser, overwriting and crossing the wrong answer is strictly prohibited; students must circle the wrong answer and must write the correct answer besides the wrong one.
- 8. For English Smart, you must underline/circle the correct answer out of 3 options. If any mistake is made on the answer sheet, cross (x) the wrong answer and underline/circle the correct answer.
- 9. Answer sheet attempted with less than 30 sums/questions will not be evaluated.
- 10. Participants should stop writing as soon as the 2nd bell rings and wait in their place until the Answer sheets are collected.

General Guidelines for Parents

All students are requested to report at the venue as per their scheduled reporting time mentioned in the Admit Card. Students are allowed only in their respective batch and late students were not be permitted into the Competition Hall.

- 1. Parents should hand over the children to the volunteer at Reporting Area / Students Entry Gate. Student should bring Water Bottle.
- 2. Parents are requested to advice their children not to call out the numbers (Question & Answer) loudly during competition. If they do so, they will be disqualified and will be handed over to the parents immediately.
- 3. Parents are strictly not allowed inside the Competition Hall and the Reporting area.
