Installation and Setup:

1. Ensure that the latest stable version of **node.js** is installed on the working machine (the current version is v9.2.0 at the time of writing).
 - a. Note: Older versions of node.js *may* work.
2. Retrieve the GitHub 'master' branch repository by either:
 - (1) Ensuring Git is installed on the working machine and cloning the 'master' branch repository using the following on a terminal or command prompt:
git clone https://github.com/tilevi/Rootify.git
 - (2) Downloading the 'master' branch repository directly on the GitHub repository site for Rootify
3. Change directory into the new 'Rootify' directory through a terminal window or command prompt
4. Type:
node app.js
5. Open your web browser (either Chrome or Firefox) and navigate to the following URL:
http://localhost:8888
