### INTRODUCTION

ICON HD™ is a versatile headset that wirelessly connects to all your favorite Bluetooth devices: phones, tablets, game consoles, laptops, and THE NERD™ (your Wire-Free USB Audio adapter for use with any computer).

To begin using ICON HD with your computer, you must first pair it with THE NERD (see page 18).

After pairing your headset with THE NERD, it will automatically work with any computer when you plug in THE NERD. THE NERD is a Wire-Free USB Audio adapter that eliminates the need to fumble with your computer's Bluetooth settings.

To use ICON HD with other Bluetooth devices, simply pair it directly with each device you wish you use it with (see page 16).



### ICON HD ANATOMY





IF THE LED RING IS...

### THE NERD ANATOMY





### BUTTON

Press & hold for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode.

IF THE LED IS ...

- FLASHING RED+WHITE
  THE NERD™ is in pairing mode.
- FLASHING QUICKLY (3 BLINKS)

  THE NERD is trying to connect to your ICON HD".
- PULSING (FADE IN/OUT)
  THE NERD is connected to your ICON HD and waiting to stream audio.
- THE NERD is streaming audio to your ICON HD.

### POWER UP

To charge, plug your headset into the wall charger or USB port on your computer.



NOTE It takes 40 minutes to get your ICON HD 80% charged. A full charge takes 90 minutes. When fully charged, the LED RING on your ICON HD will turn white.

#### TO HEAR REMAINING BATTERY LIFE

Press the **TALK BUTTON** when not on a call.

#### WHEN BATTERY IS LOW

The **LED RING** on your ICON HD will flash **RED**.

#### PHONE®

Shows up automatically when connected.

### 1.1 FIND YOUR FIT



Mix and match earbuds with the optional earloop to find the most comfortable and secure fit option for you.



If you try a Spout earbud, tuck the tab behind this fold in your ear.

### 1.2 ENSURE BEST QUALITY

VOICE ACTIVITY SENSOR



For best performance, the rubber Voice Activity Sensor should touch your cheek and the headset should point towards your mouth.

# 2 GET CONNECTED

Before you can begin using your ICON HD\*, you must pair it with your phone and/or THE NERD\*.

### 2.1 PREPARE YOUR ICON HD



- 1 Press & hold the TALK BUTTON.
- 2 Slide the POWER SWITCH on.
- 3 Wait for the LED RING to flash red & white.
- 4 Release the TALK BUTTON.



### 2.2 PAIR ICON HD WITH YOUR PHONE

- Activate pairing mode on your ICON HD. See 2.1.
- 2 Turn on Bluetooth\*.

### ON AN IPHONE®

Go to **SETTINGS > GENERAL >** and enable **BLUETOOTH**.

### ON A BLACKBERRY\*

Go to **SETTINGS/OPTIONS** > **BLUETOOTH** and enable **BLUETOOTH**.

### ON AN ANDROID™ PHONE

Go to SETTINGS > WIRELESS
& NETWORK > BLUETOOTH SETTINGS
and enable BLUETOOTH.

#### OTHER CELL PHONES

Go to **JAWBONE.COM/PAIRING** or review the instruction manual that came with your phone.

3 Go to your phone's Bluetooth\* settings.

### ADD OR SEARCH FOR DEVICES

When "Jawbone ICON HD" appears, select it.

# IF ASKED FOR A PASSCODE Enter "0000".

This is a one-time event per phone. To pair your ICON HD to another phone, repeat 2.2.



### 3 PAIR ICON HD WITH THE NERD

- Activate pairing mode on your ICON HD. See 2 1
- 2 Plug THE NERD into your computer.
- 3 Press and hold THE NERD BUTTON for about three seconds until THE NERD LED flashes red & white. When pairing is complete. THE NERD LED and ICON HD LED will both turn white
- 4 Go to the sound settings on your computer and select "Jawbone NERD" as the output/input device (Mac) or playback/recording device (PC).

NOTE Do not adjust the Bluetooth settings on your computer.

Your ICON HD is now paired with THE NERD. To use ICON HD with any computer. just plug in THE NERD.

To pair THE NERD with other Jawbone devices, repeat step 2.3.

### GET TALKING & MORE

### 3.1 ANSWER/END A CALL (PHONE ONLY)

Press the **TALK BUTTON** on your ICON HD to both answer and end a call.

### DECLINE AN INCOMING CALL

Hold the **TALK BUTTON** for 2 seconds.

### 3.2 MAKE A CALL

Use your phone or computer to dial as usual. Listen and talk through your ICON HD.

ACTIVATE DIALAPP (PHONE ONLY)
Hold the TALK BUTTON until you hear
a beep, then release and follow the voice
prompts. VoiceDial is pre-loaded.

## REDIAL LAST NUMBER (PHONE ONLY)

Press the TALK BUTTON twice.

### 3.3 SIMULTANEOUS CALLS (PHONE ONLY)

To switch between calls, press the **TALK BUTTON.** To end one call and switch to the other, press the **TALK BUTTON** twice.

### 3.4 ADJUST THE VOLUME

Use the volume control on your phone or computer. Or, while on a call or listening to music, PRESS + HOLD the TALK BUTTON. The volume level will cycle up and down. Release the button to set your volume.

### 3.5 CONTROL MEDIA (PHONE ONLY)

To pause streaming audio playing from your mobile device, press the **TALK BUTTON** once. To play, press three times.
