ASM is an assembler for the 8080, using Intel mnemonics. It is generally similar to ZASM. ED is a simple character oriented editor, useful only to those who wish to edit with a VDU. The DDT Manual gives details of some additional DDT commands, mainly associated with the 8080. The Interface Guide is essential if you wish to write assembly language programs using CP/M input/output. The Introduction to CP/M is the same as that included with the 380Z Manual. The System Alteration Guide is only useful if you wish to modify CP/M I/O.
