NOTE

There are events all weekend, but you don't have to come to all (or any) of them. Except for the ceremony - you should come to that If you already have a jam-packed Paris itinerary, please don't feel the need to change anything!



FRIDAY, JULY 27

- Directions: Descend from the bridge on the north side and head west along the water toward Pont Louis Phillipe.

4:30pm: Wedding Ceremony & Reception



CEREMONY & RECEPTION

- Address: 12 rue Chanoinesse
- Metro: Cité Line 4, Chatelet Lines 1, 7, 11, 14
- Arrive between 4:30 and 5:15pm
- Ceremony begins at 5:30pm
- Semi-formal attire

Weather permitting, the ceremony will take place outdoors. The reception will expand to include an indoor area.

The dinner format is *cocktail dînatoire*. Servers will walk around with an assortment of cuisine from 6-9pm and there'll be two *culinary animations* where the chef prepares food as you watch.




Dancing will begin around 9pm and continue until midnight. The music selection will include both American and French hits as well as some of our favorite dance-friendly beats.

The Paris Metro is a fast and cheap way to get around. Trains run every 2-5 minutes—you don't need to plan trips in advance. Ticket machines work in English and are located at every stop.

Google Maps will give you metro directions for any itinerary if you click on the public transportation tab.


