Function Introduction

Power on: Press and hold button 3 seconds under the device is off (the red and blue led light will flash, you will hear voice promote "power on and ready to pair," at the same time), enter to the pairing mode freely.

Pairing mode: Matching to the mobile phone and other device which have bluetooth function (pls refer to the pairing mode detail).

Play/pause: Press button to pause when it is playing, then press again to play.

Volume up: Press button for a while to turn up the volume.

Volume down: Press button for a while to turn down the volume.

Next: press hold button for next.

Previous: press hold button for playing back.

Answer calls: press button.

Ring off: press button.

Reject calls : Press button for two second quickly.

Power off: Press and hold button for 3 second under of stand by or working,(voice promote "power off" the LED light is on 2second)

Charging: Connect the charger to the multifunction jack, the indicate light will turn red, the light will turn off after fully charged.

Repeat the recently call: Press button two times under of stand by or playing music.

Remove all connections: Press and at the same time 3 seconds while is power on, it will force to disconnect all the devices on the headset.

Interchange in both Chinese & English prompt Tohes: Press button together in 1-2 second to change Chinese and English tone.

Matching with Mobile Phone

- Initiate Bluetooth function of phone and Turn on the headphone.
- Then search for Bluetooth device and the model number of headphone will be showed on your phone.
- Click the right model number, then system prompt the passkey of "0000".
- Confirm the passkey on phone, Then headphone and Mobile are connected by Bluetooth.

If there is connection history between headphone and phone, they will connect automatically in operating range.

Matching with Computer

Warm prompt :

Computer which is without bluetooth function can be equipped with bluetooth adapter and then activated.

- Initiate the software of Bluetooth Control , Such as IVT.
- Then search for Bluetooth device and the model number of headphone will be showed on computer.
- Click the right model number and then right click the option of "Matching the device" .Right click "Connect the audio device" in Pop-up window.
- Successful connect.

Charging the Headset

1. Connect the charger to the multifunction jack on the headset.
2. During charging the indicator light will turn red.
3. When the headset is fully charge, the red indicator light will turn off.
4. Use only Beevo-approved chargers. Unauthorised or Non-Beevo charger could cause damage to the headset or in extreme circumstances an explosion. And it will also invalidate any warranty on the headset.
5. Repeatedly charging and discharging of the headset over times will cause the battery performance diminishing. This is normal for all the rechargeable batteries.

Safety Precautions

1. This is not a toy, children should use under adult supervision.
2. Avoid exposing your device to extremely cold and hot temperatures (below 0 degree or above 45 degree).
3. Avoid using your device 's light close to the eyes of children or animal.
4. Do not use at high volume for long time to avoid hearing damage.
5. For travel safety, please pay attention to the traffic safety while you are driving and walking under using headset.
6. For your safety, please keep your headset away from your heart pacemaker (below 10cm).
7. Do not use the device under the thunder storm. The thunder storm will cause the device to malfunction and increase the rise of electric shock.
