

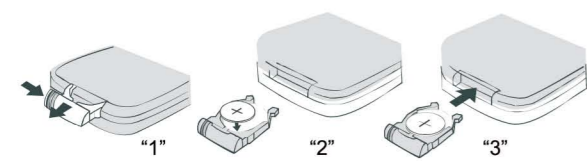

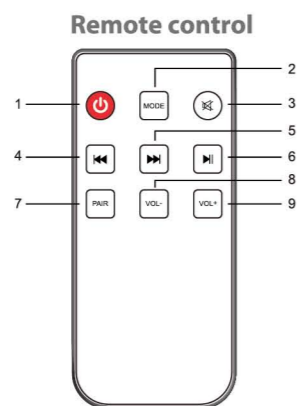
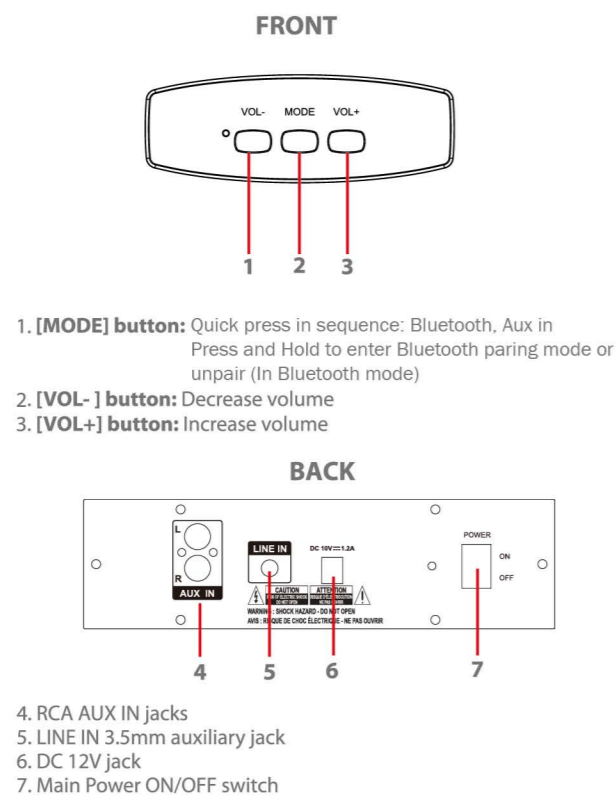
Installing the battery



NOTE: The battery for the remote control (1 CR2025 lithium battery) is included. To replace the battery, push and slide out the battery door in the remote control. Replace the battery with a new CR2025 battery with the polarity "+" facing up. Slide the door back.



Location of controls



- [] key: Standby Power ON/OFF
- [MODE] key: AUX IN, Bluetooth
- [] key: Mute volume
- [] key: Quick press to skip to previous track
• (In Bluetooth mode)
- [] key: Quick press to skip to next track
• (In Bluetooth mode)
- [] key: Play / pause (In Bluetooth mode)
- [PAIR] key: Press to enter Bluetooth pairing mode or unpair (In Bluetooth mode)
- [VOL-] key: Decrease volume
- [VOL+] key: Increase volume

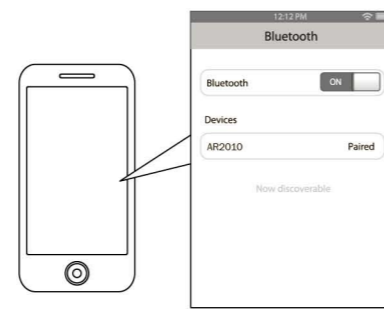
Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device

- Plug the speaker into a power source.
- Turn on the speaker by pressing the Main Power switch on the back of the speaker to the ON position.
- Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.



On an iPhone

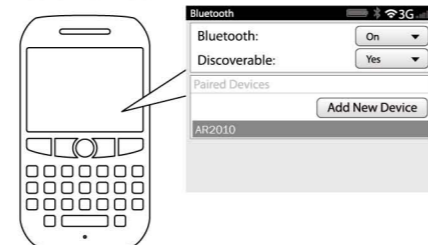
• Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On a Blackberry

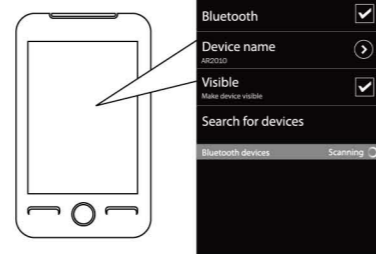
• Go to SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH

• Enable BLUETOOTH



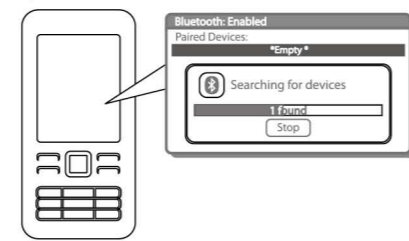
On an Android Phone

• Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU > Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On other Cell Phones/Devices

Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



- When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker, select "AR2010" from the list of found devices.
- If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair the two units.
- After a successful pairing, a voice prompt will be heard indicating that the device and speaker have been paired.

NOTE: If you would like to connect the speaker to another device, you must unpair the speaker from the currently paired device first. On your device's Bluetooth settings, select "AR2010", then select "unpair"; or press the [PAIR] key on the remote control. When the speaker has been unpaired, it automatically goes into pairing mode again.

i The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's interface and interaction with the speaker may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

Using your Bluetooth Speaker

- Powering ON/OFF**
- To Tune on, flip the Main Power switch on the back of the unit to the ON position.
 - To Turn OFF, flip the Main power switch on the back of the unit to the OFF position.

- Adjusting the volume**
- Quick press the [VOL+] button on the speaker or the remote control to gradually increase the volume; long press it to continually increase the volume to maximum level.
 - Quick press the [VOL-] button on the speaker or the remote control to gradually decrease the volume; long press it to continually decrease the volume to minimum level.
 - Press the [] key on the remote control to mute the sound. Press again to turn the sound back on.

i You can also adjust the volume from your connected device's volume control.

- Switching modes**
- Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or the remote control repeatedly to switch between modes:
- Bluetooth
 - AUX IN

Using as a wired speaker

- Using the 3.5mm auxiliary cable**
- Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or the remote control repeatedly until the speaker is in AUX line-in mode.
 - Plug one end of the included 3.5 mm auxiliary cord into the headphone jack on your device.
 - Plug the other end of the 3.5 mm auxiliary cord into the LINE IN jack on the back of the speaker.
 - Use your connected device's audio controls for music playback

RCA in operation

- Using the RCA cables**
- Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or the remote control repeatedly until the speaker is in AUX line-in mode.
 - Match up the white (L) and red (R) plugs of the included RCA cables to the AUX IN jacks on the back of the speaker.
 - Plug the other ends of the RCA cables into the audio jacks on your television.
 - Use your connected device's audio controls to control playback.

i When a device is plugged into the AUX IN or LINE IN jack, the speaker and remote control buttons have limited function. You must use your connected device to control playback.

Troubleshooting tips

? I can pair the Bluetooth Speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music?

- Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
- Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
- You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.

? I cannot get the Bluetooth Speaker into Pairing Mode.

- Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
- Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or the remote control until the speaker is in Bluetooth mode.
- The speaker is now in pairing mode.

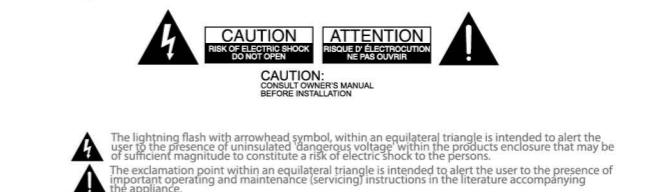
? My Bluetooth Device is not able to pair with the Bluetooth Speaker.

- Make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
- Keep your Bluetooth Speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Press the [MODE] button on the speaker or the remote control until the LCD display and voice prompt indicate that the speaker is in Bluetooth mode.
- Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
- Try repeating the pairing process, see "Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device".
