







Charging the Tailgate Speaker


- 1. Attach the AC charging cord to the socket on the back of the Tailgate Speaker.
- 2. Plug the AC charging cord into a wall socket.
- 3. Turn speaker ON by pressing the Main Power switch. 4. The LED charging indicator light will illuminate blue while charging. It will shut off when the speaker has
- completed charging.

Using a DC car charger (not included)

- that the *Main Power Switch is in the OFF position*. 2. Unscrew the RED and Black DC Wire Harness until the
- metal contact below is exposed.
- metal post and tightly fasten the harness.
- b. The solid BLACK wire is fastened to the BLACK post. 4. Connect the DC car charger to your vehicle's charging
- 5. Switch the Tailgate Speaker's Main Power Switch to the ON position.




Location of controls



Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth

- 1. Turn the Tailgate Speaker ON by pressing the Main Power switch on the back panel.
- 2. Press the [SELECT INPUT] button. The voice prompt "Bluetooth pairing" will be heard as the LED Bluetooth indicator light turns on and blinks BLUE.
- 3. Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing
- 4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.


On an iPhone

 Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On a Blackberry

- Go to SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH
- Enable BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)




On an Android Phone

5. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker, select "SBT1009" from the list of found

- 6. If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair the two units.
- 7. After a successful pairing, the voice prompt "Bluetooth is connected" will be heard and the LED Bluetooth Indicator light will be a solid BLUE.

NOTE: If you would like to connect the speaker to another device, you must disconnect the speaker from the currently paired device first. On your device's Bluetooth settings, select "SBT1009," then select "disconnect" or "unpair"; or long press the [►/II] button. When the speaker has been unpaired, repeat the pairing process.

Using the speaker

Powering ON/OFF

- Use the Main Power switch on the back of the speaker to turn ON and OFF if the speaker has been fully charged.
- Use the AC Power switch on the back of the speaker to turn ON and OFF when the AC charging adapter is plugged in.

Adjusting the volume

Turn the Volume knob on the side of the speaker to the left to decrease the volume. Turn it to the right to increase the volume.



Switching Modes

Press the [SELECT INPUT] button on the speaker repeatedly to switch between modes: AUX (line in)

Bluetooth

Disco Ball

Press to turn the disco ball light ON and OFF.

Plug the jack of any electric guitar into the Guitar input port to use as an amplifier.

Guitar Volume

Adjust the volume of the connected guitar.

Adjust the reverberation effect of the connected microphone.

Adjust the volume of a connected microphone.

Press to enable the karaoke function. Bluetooth or

AUX signal will automatically adjust to highlight vocals when a microphone is connected.

Plug the microphone jack into the MIC In port to enable micrphone use.

1. Attach your device to the speaker's USB port using your device's USB charging cord.

Playing Music

To enjoy wireless music on your Tailgate Speaker, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth enabled device. Once connected, you can control the music with the controls on your connected device and on the Tailgate Speaker.

Play/pause

Press the [| li] button to pause/resume play in Bluetooth mode.

Skipping tracks

- Press the [>>+] button to skip to the next track in Bluetooth mode
- Press the [

 | button to skip to the previous track in Bluetooth mode

Adjusting the volume

Turn the Volume knob on the side of the speaker to the left to decrease the volume. Turn it to the right to increase the volume.



Using as a wired speaker

- 1. Connect the white and red AUX cable plugs to the white (L) and red (R) jacks on the back of the speaker, and the green plug of the cable to the other end to an external device's headphone jack (smartphone, tablet, or MP3 player)
- 2. Open a media player on your device and click on PLAY to start playing your music.
- 3. Use the controls on your connected device to control music playback and volume.



Troubleshooting tips

- Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP
- 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device. 3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.
- 1. Press the [SELECT INPUT] button until the LED Bluetooth indicator lights up. The voice prompt "Bluetooth pairing" will be heard and the LED




