


Location of controls

Top panel




- 1. Pairing indicator light

Back panel




8. RCA audio inputs 9. Speaker connections

Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device

- 1. Power on the unit by pressing the Power button.
- 2. The Indicator light will turn BLUE and flash quickly.
- 3. Press the Pair button.
- 4. Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- 5. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.




On an iPhone • Go to SETTINGS > GENERAL > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On a Blackberry



6. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker,

- 7. If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes
- 8. After a successful pairing, the Indicator light will become solid BLUE

select "SBT2002" from the list of found devices.


The unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps or press the Pair button to start the pairing process pairing again.

Note: If the speaker has already been connected to the Bluetooth device/phone, the speaker will reconnect with the Bluetooth device/phone automatically.

Using your Bluetooth Speaker

Connecting the Speakers


Connect the included speakers to the corresponding speaker connections on the back of the speaker system.



Using the RCA Audio Inputs

Requires a 3.5mm to RCA audio cable (included).

- 1. Plug the RCA audio cable into the RCA audio inputs on the speaker system and into a 3.5mm audio output on an audio source.
- 2. Use the controls on the connected audio source to play, pause, and control audio.



To make a call

Dial the number and press the send button on your mobile phone. The call is automatically transferred to the speaker.

Answering / Ending a call

Use the controls on your mobile phone to answer and end a call.

Playing Music

To enjoy wireless music on your Bluetooth Speaker System, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth enabled device. Once connected, use the controls on the Bluetooth device to select, play, or pause a track.

Once playback has begun, you can control the music or answer phone calls with devices that have the AVRCP Bluetooth profile.



Adjusting the volume

Turn the Volume knob on the side panel to adjust the volume to the desired level.



Troubleshooting tips



- 1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
- 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
- 3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your

- 2. Press the Pair button and wait for the Indicator light to flash BLUE.
- 3. The speaker is now in pairing mode.
