

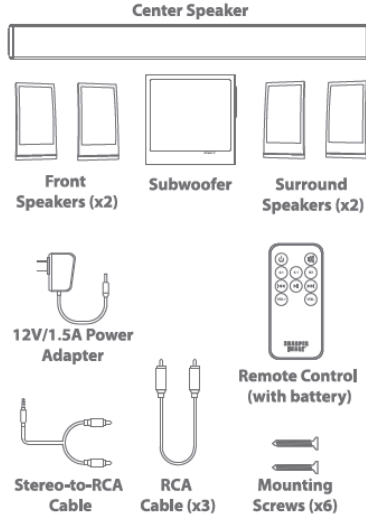

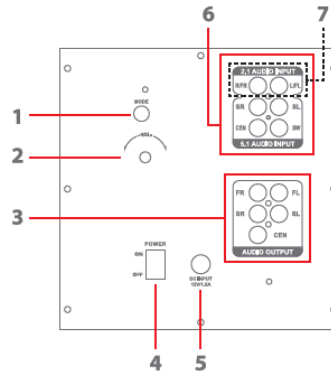

In the Box

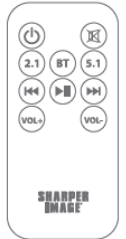


Location of Controls

- (Back of Subwoofer)
- [MODE] Button: Change input mode
 - [VOLUME] Knob: Adjust volume
 - Audio Outputs
 - [POWER] Switch: Turn system ON/OFF
 - 12V/1.5A DC Power Jack
 - 5.1 Audio Input (Red, solid outline, Includes the 2.1 Audio Input)
 - 2.1 Audio Input (Black, dotted outline)



- [] Button: Enter/leave standby mode
- [X] Button: Mute/Unmute volume
- [2.1] Button: Switch to 2.1 channel input
- [BT] Button: Enter Bluetooth pairing mode
- [5.1] Button: Switch to 5.1 channel input
- [▶] Button: Play/pause media playback
- [◀] / [▶] Buttons: Skip to previous and next tracks
- [VOL+] / [VOL-] Buttons: Adjust volume

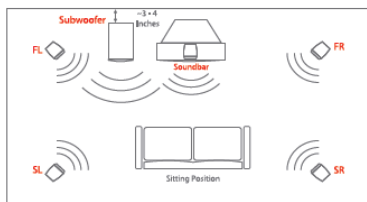


Installing/Replacing the Remote Control Batteries
To replace or install the remote control battery, push and slide the battery door out from the remote control. Replace the battery with a new CR2025 battery with the positive (+) polarity facing up.



NOTE: There is a protective plastic tab inserted into the battery door of the remote control. When using for the first time, gently pull the protection tab extending out of the remote control's battery door.

Setting Up the System



Placing the Speakers

Generally, speakers should be placed as indicated in the diagram above.

The **Front Left** (FL) and **Front Right** (FR) speakers should be at the front-left and -right of sitting position, with the **Surround Left** (SL) and **Surround Right** (SR) placed to the back-left and -right of sitting position.

The **Center Speaker** (or "Soundbar") should be placed directly in front of sitting position.

The **Subwoofer** is typically placed on the floor and in the corner of a room (or just close to a wall) to naturally amplify the bass from the speaker.

NOTE: A distance of ~3 - 4 inches between the subwoofer and the closest wall is recommended, as the sound from the subwoofer can easily become "muddy" and distorted to the ear.

Mounting the Speakers

NOTE: Mounting the speakers is not required to using the speaker system, the speakers can also be set on any flat, stable surface with enough area to place the speakers.

Remove the contents of the speaker system from its packaging and locate the **Front** and **Surround** Speakers.

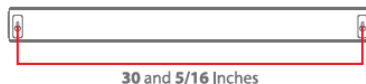
On the back of all of these speakers are mounting holes that allow you to hang the speaker on a wall.



NOTE: After selecting where you would like the speakers to be placed, check that the speaker cables will be long enough to reach the subwoofer.

Using a power drill (not included), drill the supplied mounting screws into the exact location on your wall that you would like the speakers to be placed, then hook the speaker onto the screw.

To mount the **Soundbar**, select the location you would like to place the speaker, mark the location of exactly where one screw will be, then measure a distance of **30 and 5/16 inches** which will be the location of the second screw.

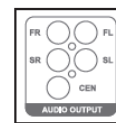


Audio Output Panel

Plugging In the Speakers

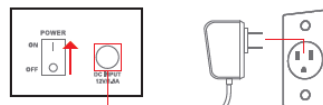
Once the speakers have been properly mounted or placed, you will need to plug them into the Audio Output panel on the back of the subwoofer. Plug the cables for each speaker into the corresponding Audio Output jack:

- FR - Front Right Speaker
- FL - Front Left Speaker
- SR - Surround Right Speaker
- SL - Surround Left Speaker
- CEN - Center Speaker



Powering the System

After the speakers have been plugged in, plug the pin of the supplied 12V/1.5A power adapter into the DC IN Jack on the back of the subwoofer. Plug the adapter into a working wall outlet.



Move the [POWER] switch to the ON position to power the system. While the switch is ON, the system will be in working mode, press the [] button on the remote control to put the system in standby.

The AUX/5.1CH LED indicator on the front of the subwoofer will turn RED when powered ON.

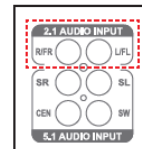
Audio Input Panel (AUX/5.1CH)

Once the system is set up and powered ON, media-playing devices can be connected via the Audio Input panel on the back of the subwoofer:

Using the AUX/2.1CH Input

In the diagram to the left, the area outlined in **dotted-red** indicates the 2.1 Audio Input, used for a simple left and right channel input.

Using the supplied Stereo-to-RCA cable, plug the red RCA connector into the R/R jack and the white RCA connector into the L/L jack.



Plug the 3.5mm connector into the headphone or AUX-OUT jack on your media-playing device.

Press the [MODE] button on the back of the subwoofer or the [2.1] button on the remote control to switch to the 2.1CH input. The AUX/5.1CH LED indicator will turn RED.

Using the 5.1CH Input

NOTE: Consult the user manual for your media-playing device, as it may have different names for the connectors or channels.

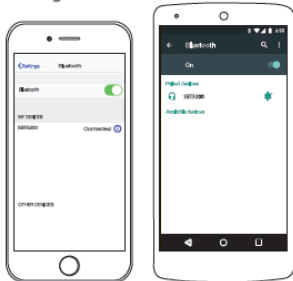
Using the 3 supplied RCA cables, connect each to all 6 ports on the Audio Input panel, then plug the other ends into the corresponding audio output jacks on your media-playing device.

Press the [MODE] button on the back of the subwoofer or the [5.1] button on the remote control to switch to the 5.1CH input. The AUX/5.1CH LED indicator will turn RED.

Pairing to the System (Bluetooth)

1. After setting up the speaker, press the [MODE] button on the back of the subwoofer or the [BT] button on the remote control to switch to Bluetooth mode. A voice will be heard indicating the mode and the Bluetooth LED indicator on the front of the subwoofer will **flash BLUE**.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When your mobile device finds the speaker, select **SBT5200** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will turn **solid BLUE**.

On an iOS or Android Device Go to Settings -> Bluetooth



Using the System

Powering the System ON/OFF

- Move the [POWER] switch to the ON/OFF position to power the speaker ON or OFF.
- Press the [⏻] button on the remote control to enter/leave standby mode. While in standby mode, the system will be on low power and will not be functional until you leave standby.

Unpair Bluetooth

- Long press the [≡] button on the remote control to unpair any device currently paired via Bluetooth to the speaker system.

Changing Input Mode

- Press the [MODE] button on the back of the subwoofer to cycle through Auxiliary/5.1CH input and Bluetooth input.
- Press the [2.1] [5.1] [BT] buttons on the remote control to switch to your desired input.
- The LED indicator on the front of the subwoofer will display what input mode the system is currently using.

Adjusting Volume

- The [VOLUME] knob on the back of the subwoofer or the [VOL-] / [VOL+] buttons on the remote control can be used to adjust volume.
- Press the [M] button on the remote control to mute/unmute volume. While the system is muted, the LED indicators on the front of the subwoofer will **alternately flash RED and BLUE**.

NOTE: If the system is connected to a video-playing device, such as a DVD player or a smart TV, the controls for this system will **ONLY** affect the audio of playback. Pausing and resuming video, skipping scenes, etc. is still controlled by your video-playing device.

Playing Music

To enjoy music wireless on your system, make sure you are either paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device or the system is properly set up and connected to a media-playing device. Consult the previous sections of this user manual, **Audio Input Panel (AUX/5.1CH)** and **Pairing to the System (Bluetooth)** for more information.

Playing/Pausing Music

- Press the [⏸] button on the remote control to pause audio playback.
- Press the [▶] button again on the remote control to resume audio playback.

Skipping Tracks

- Press the [⏮] button on the remote control to skip to the next track.
- Press the [⏪] button on the remote control to skip to the previous track.
