2. Install two AAA batteries into the battery compartment following the orientation guide in the battery bay.



3. Replace the battery compartment cover back onto your mouse until it locks securely.

- 2. Pull out the Nano Receiver stowed in the bottom of your mouse.




3. Turn on your computer and plug the Nano Receiver into an available USB port on your computer. (If you are not able to find a USB port on your computer, please refer to the user manual of your computer for more detail.) Your wireless optical mouse is now ready!

In order for the tilt-wheel function to work on your mouse you MUST download the setup software from the Gear Head website.






