

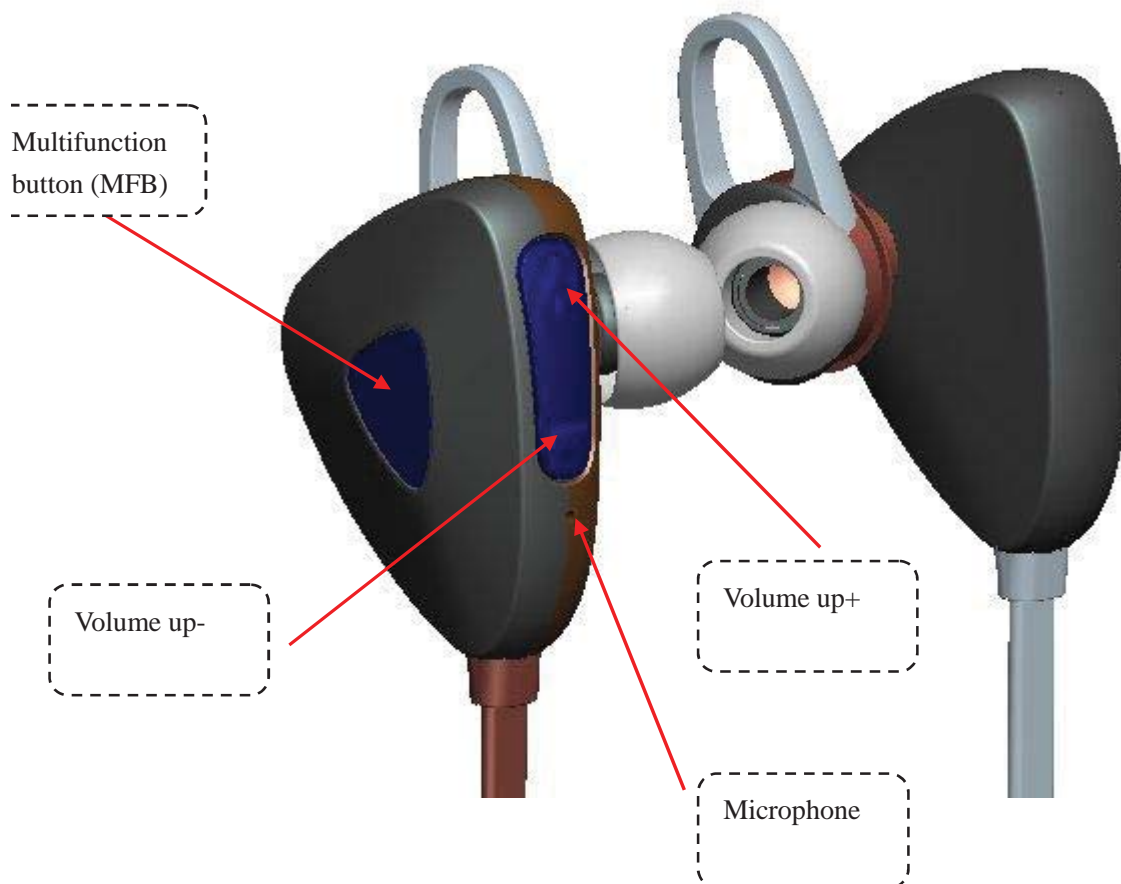

## ● Introduction

The Bluetooth headset Bone SMBT-1018 is a portable hand free communication device with A2DP profile built on Bluetooth wireless technology. This headset is designed and manufactured in accordance with Bluetooth specification VR3.0 which supports adaptive frequency hopping and allows faster connection, the noise immunity within the wireless area network is better than the BT V2.1 Headset



## Product standard

Bluetooth version: V3.0

Talk time: up to 4.5 hours

Standby time: up to 120 hours

Battery standard: Rechargeable lithium polymer battery

Power adapter output: DC5V 80mA

## Charging the headset

Your headset uses a rechargeable battery, you must charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time.

1. Plugging the charging cable in the USB charge port
2. The red indicator lamp remains solid when charging.

3. The fully charging takes 2-3 hours
4. The red indicator lamp goes out and the blue indicator remains solid when charging completed

## Power on/off the headset

- a. To power on: press and hold multifunction button for about 3 seconds until blue light flashes.
- b. To power off: when headset is power on, press and hold multifunction button for about 6 seconds indicator light goes off

## Voice Prompt

- a. When the headset is on, there will be the automatic voice prompt: power on
- b. When the headset is off, there will be the automatic voice prompt: power off
- c. When being connected successfully, there will be voice telling: connected
- d. When the battery is low, there will be voice telling: low battery

## Voice Telling

When a call comes in, the headset will speak up the caller's phone number.

## Pair to your Bluetooth phone

### 1. Pair the Bluetooth headset for the first time

- a. The distance between the Bluetooth headset and your Bluetooth phone would be better within 1 meter when pairing, the closer the better.
- b. Press multifunction button for 6 seconds, the headset into pair status. blinking in blue and red alternatively
- c. Set the phone to search for Bluetooth device.
- d. When phone finds headset, confirm by selecting "SMBT-1018" from list.
- e. Enter pin code "0000" when prompted by phone.
- f. Repeat steps B-E if the pairing was unsuccessful.
- g. If pairing was successful, starts to flash blue.

## 2. Connect to 2 devices at the same time

- a. Press multifunction button for 6 seconds the headset into pair status. Blinking in blue and red alternatively
  - b. Set the phone to search for Bluetooth device.
  - c. When phone finds headset confirm by selecting "SMBT-1018" from list..
  - d. Enter pin code "0000" when prompted by phone.
  - e. Repeat steps B-E if the pairing was unsuccessful
  - f. If pairing was successful, starts to flash blue
- .Note: Bluetooth headset off again, re-open at this time two Bluetooth Devices will connect automatically.

### Answering a call

- a. Press the answer key on your phone.
- b. Press the multifunction button on your headset.

### Ending a call

- a. Press the end key on your phone.
- b. Press the multifunction button on your headset.

### Rejecting a call

- a. Press the end key on your phone.
- b. When ringing, press and hold the button 2 times to reject the call

### Redialing the last called number

Double press the multifunction button 2 seconds when Headset is in standby mode.

### Activating voice dialing

Your phone must support this function, when in standby Mode single press and hold the multifunction button.

### Playing music

When you are listening to the music from PC (Music format Recommended: Windows Media player), you can press play Pause previous Track. Next Track (refer to the buttons Feature) to select your optimal performance. previous track When press the Volume up. Next Track when press the Volume down

## Volume control

Volume keys to adjust the volume: If user press Volume Up or Volume Down to choose the volume, when volume is in maximum or minimum, a tone sound to prompt the user
