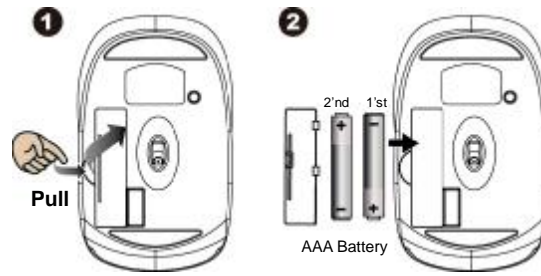


Installing the batteries

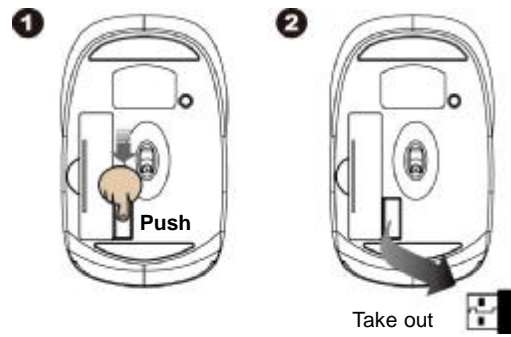
Step 1: Take the battery cover off.

Step 3: Replace the cover.

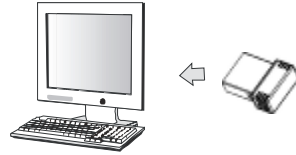


Nano Receiver



Setup the Connection between the Receiver and the Mouse

1. Plug the Nano receiver into the USB port of your computer.

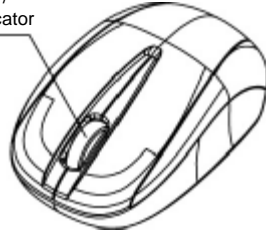






2. Insert the batteries into the mouse, then follow the steps below.
3. If the mouse is not working, please put it into pairing mode.
4. Pairing: Re-plug the Nano receiver into the USB port of your computer.
If the mouse does not work after 10 seconds, then press the connect buttons on the mouse again. (Nano receiver has auto pairing)

- The LED indicator on mouse flashes steadily when it is in pairing mode and stops blinking when it is successfully paired with the receiver. The mouse remains off afterwards.
 - When the battery is low, the Low Power indicator blinking.
