Transmitter

- Pull the lid downward and install the battery
- Make sure + and poles of the battery are positioned properly
- Remove the battery from the transmitter after playing

Vehicle

- Use screw driver to open the battery door
- Join the connectors of the NiCd pack and the vehicle
- Replace the battery door and use screw driver to close it
- Remove the battery from the vehicle after playing

HOW TO PLAY

- Turn ON the vehicle
- Operate the vehicle with transmitter

RECHARGING

- Join the connector of the 4.8V charger to the connector of the NiCd rechargeable battery

- When the recharging is over, plug out the charger from the electrical outlet and detach the connectors.
