power key:

Long pressing to make phone power-on and power-off vice visa.

Volume key:

Pressing to adjust audio volume .

Home key:

Clicking on any interface, the direct return to the standby interface; long press on any interface, the eight most recently used menu.

Menu key:

Clicking to popup the complete menu option .

Return key:

Clicking to return to the higher level menu.

Search key:

In different interface, search related information (In the main menu interface, long pressing this key Web search engines; In the address book interface, long pressing a contact search.)

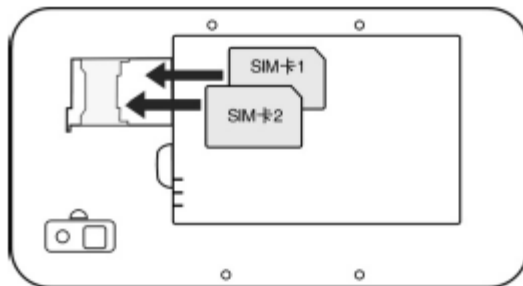
About UIM/SIM card

Important information: Before installing or removing the UIM / SIM card, the phone has been power off. The UIM / SIM card provided by the ISP, it can save some of the basic data, such as contact name and phone number. Note that some of the UIM / SIM card may not match with your phone, please contact the

ISP to replace.

Installation UIM/SIM card:

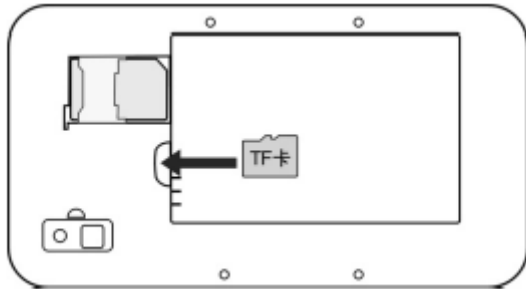
- (1) Please insert your USIM/SIM according to the direction indicated.



About memory card

Important information: Please take out your memory card (Micro SD card) after powering off your phone, otherwise will cause system problem. The Micro SD card can be extended to more storage space. Suggest using standard Micro SD card like SanDisk, Kingston and other popular vendor' s to prevent incompatibility. And be sure to put it far from the children because s the card is one tiny accessory.


- (1) **Installation memory card:** Insert the card with the golden the contact side down according to the direction indicated, and press it down gently till you hear a “KA...” .



- (2) **Remove the memory card:** Press down the MicroSD card, MicroSD card will automatically pop up and then remove the MicroSD card.

For the battery

Use the travel charger to charge the battery:

- (1) The USB data cable and travel charger is connected.
- (2) Connect the Mini USB port to the phone, and connect the Travel Charger to an electric outlet.
- (3) Normal charging, the battery status icon  will be displayed. End-of-charge display full status.
- (4) Remove the Travel charger and USB cable.

If the battery is new, the first fully charging must be more than

10 hours to get the best performance.

Run out of battery, please charging, over-discharge damage to the battery.

Smart phone during charging a slight heat is a normal phenomenon.

This product only supports the use of a dedicated charger, others will not make it fully charged.

If the phone is automatically power off because the power has been used up, it needs some longer charging time to be powered on again, this is normal.

Power-on and power-off

Confirm this phone with the battery and the battery has enough power. Hold down the Power Key for about 3 seconds, can be Power-on or Power-off operation.

Interface:

Unlock the screen and lock screen

You can drag to right to unlock and enter the main interface;drag to left to the camera icon, you can unlock and enter into the function module. To lock the screen in any interface, you simply press the Power Key, the phone can enter into the sleep mode.



Enter into the main interface

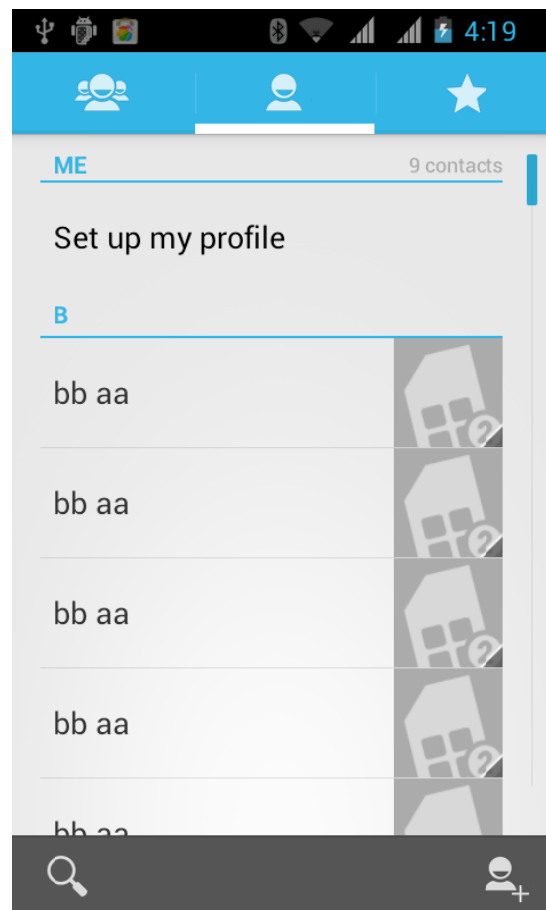

Manage contacts

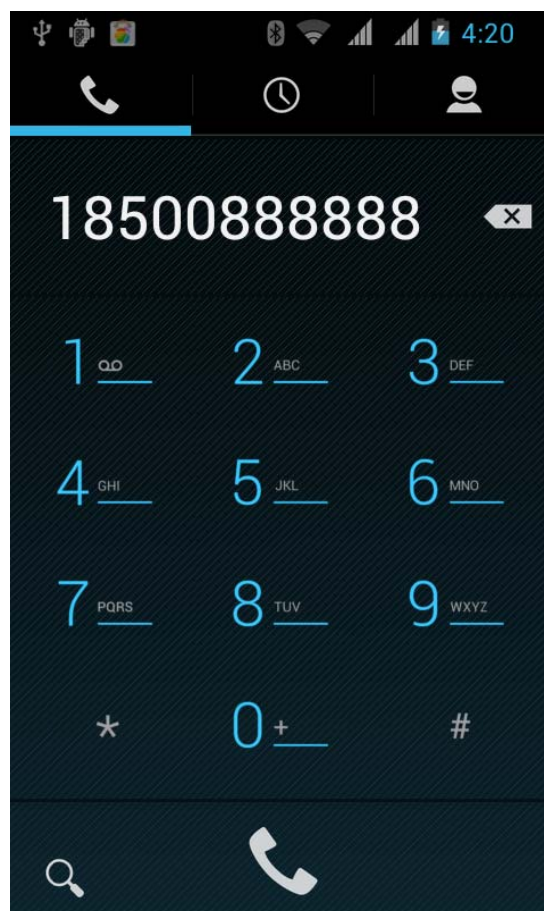
In Contacts, you can save and view the contact name, phone number and e-mail address, etc.

If the first use please choose the way of importing contacts, you can choose to importing contacts from the SIM card or the SD card, you can also directly create a new contact.



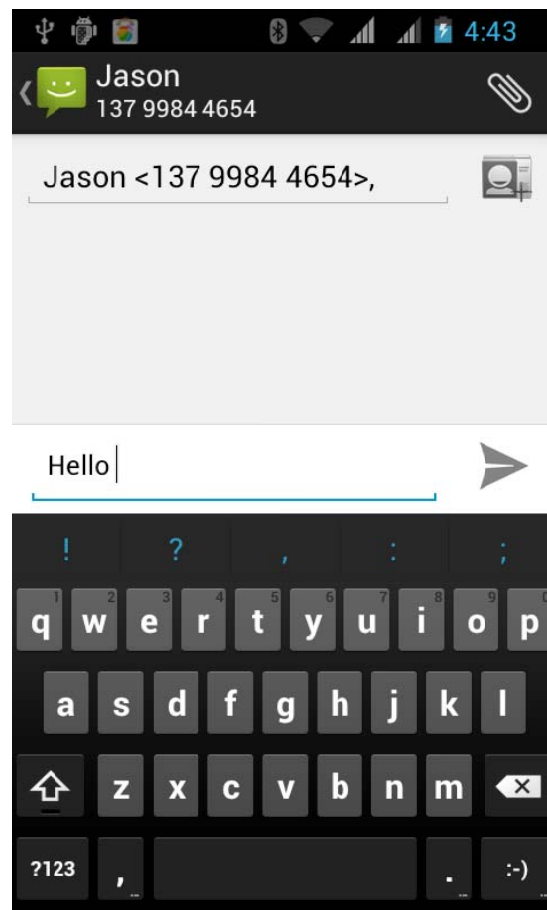
Calling

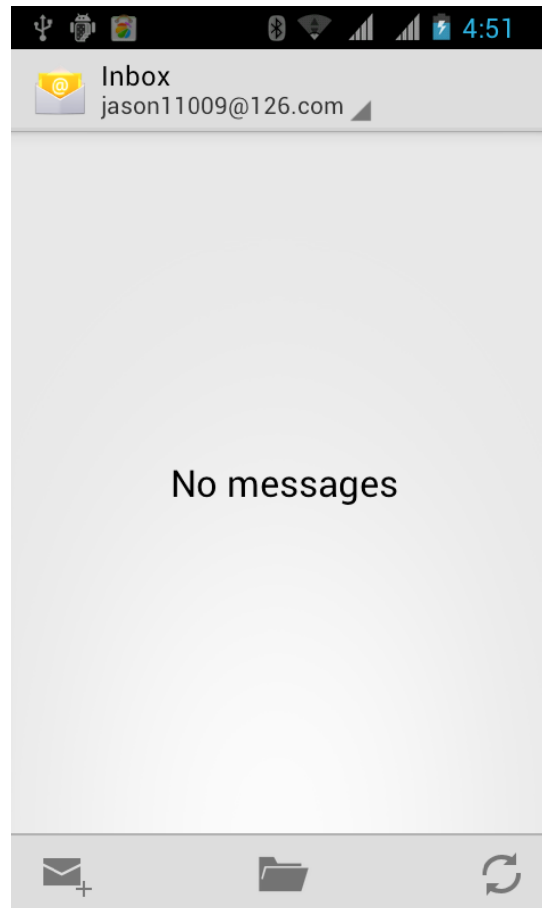
Send message

Write e-mail

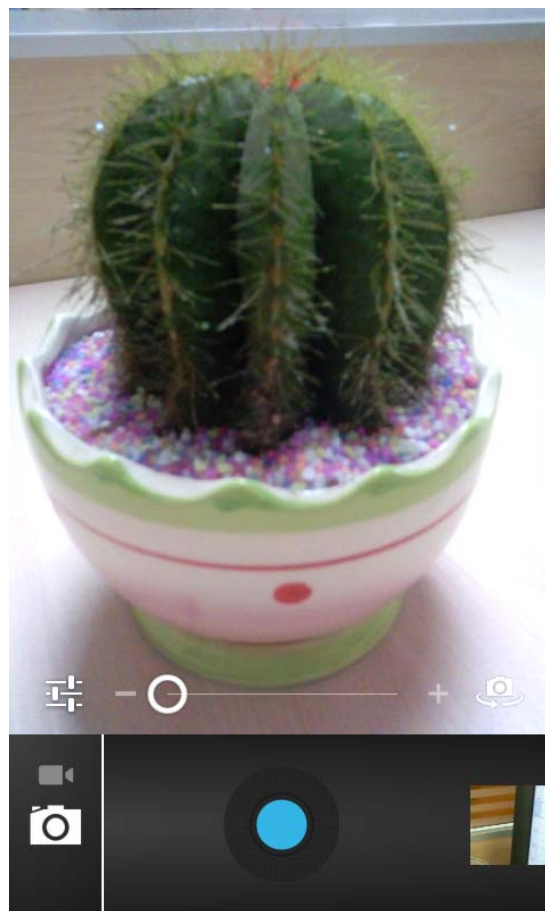
You can set up your e-mail account with the smartphone to send and receive e-mail, new e-mail will receive a reminder.



Take pictures or video

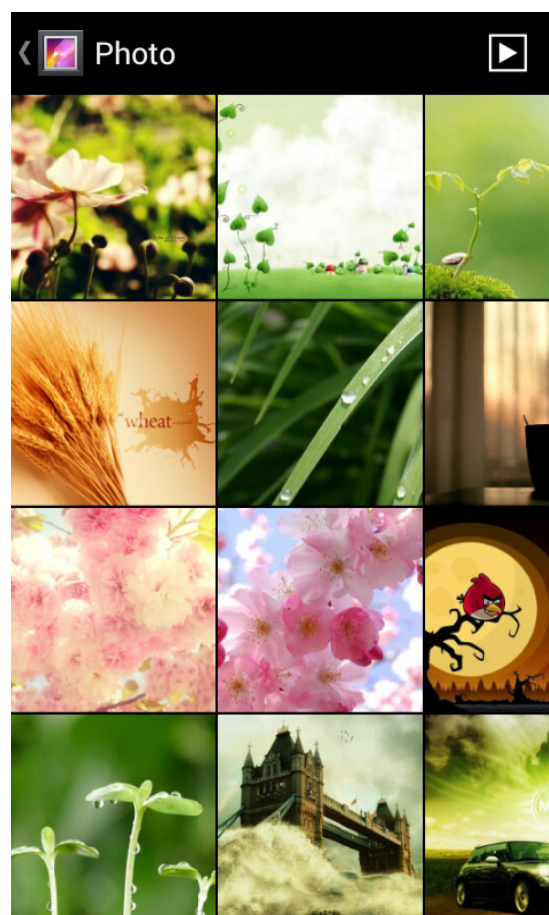
Before using camera, remember to install memory card which will provide space to store your taken pictures.

Picture

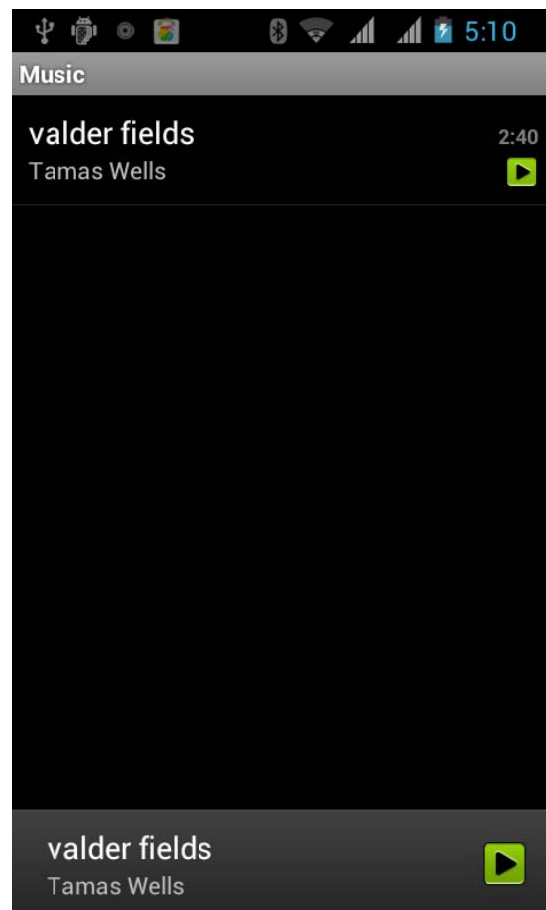

In the music player, press the side Keys to adjust the playback volume.



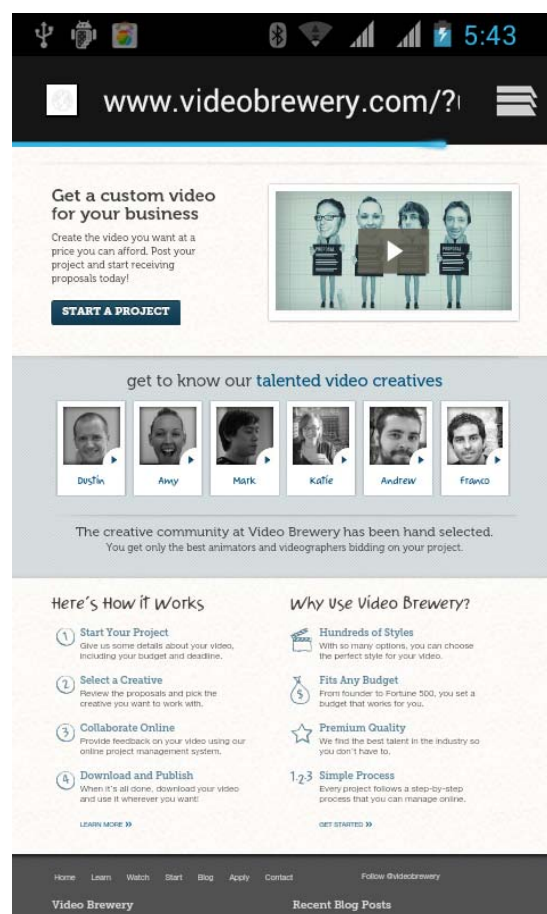
Videos

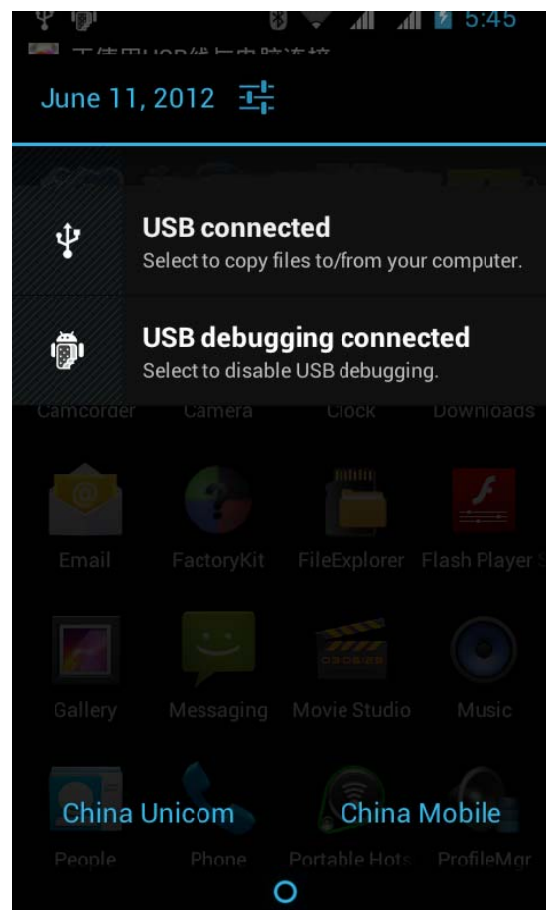
Internet

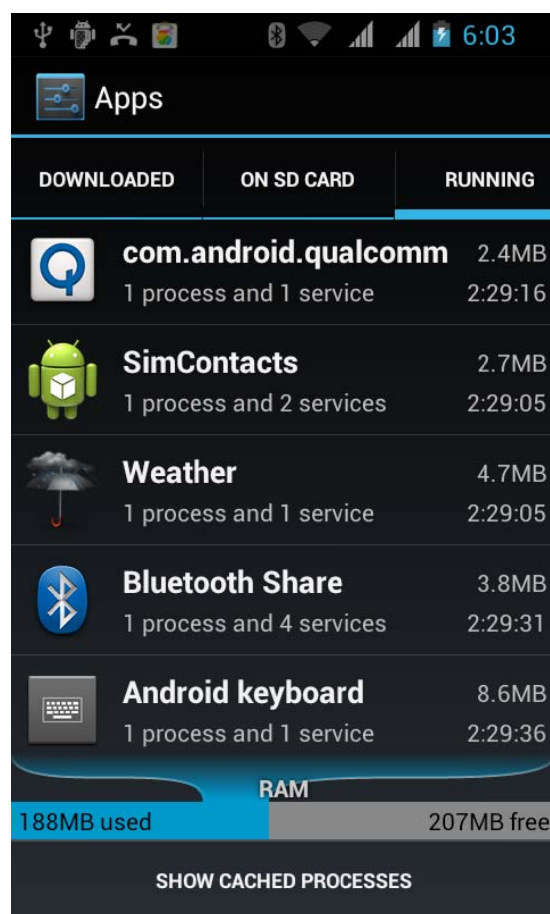
View notice

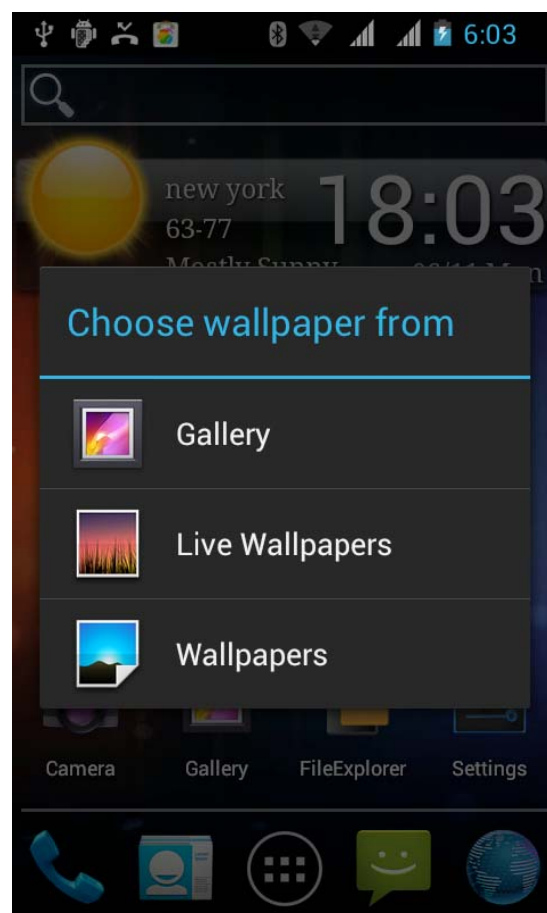
Switch multi-tasking

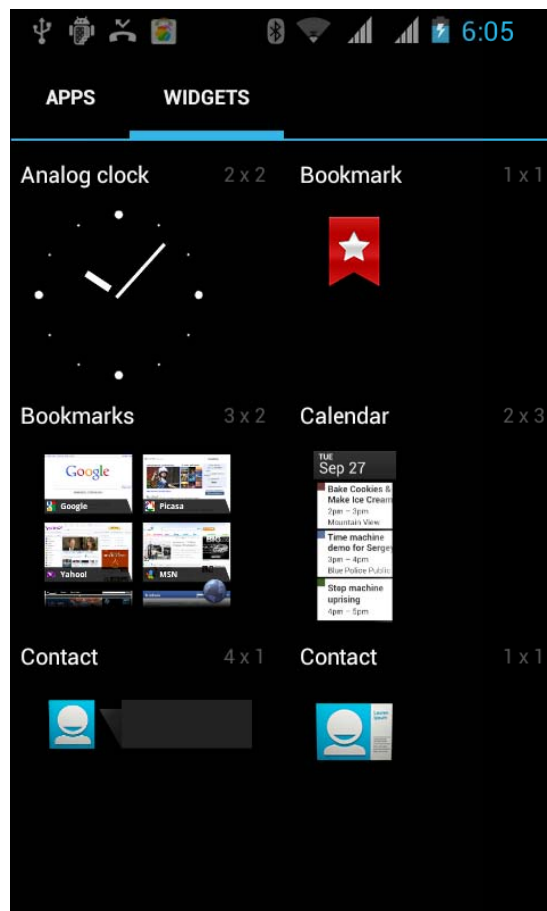
Replacement of wallpaper

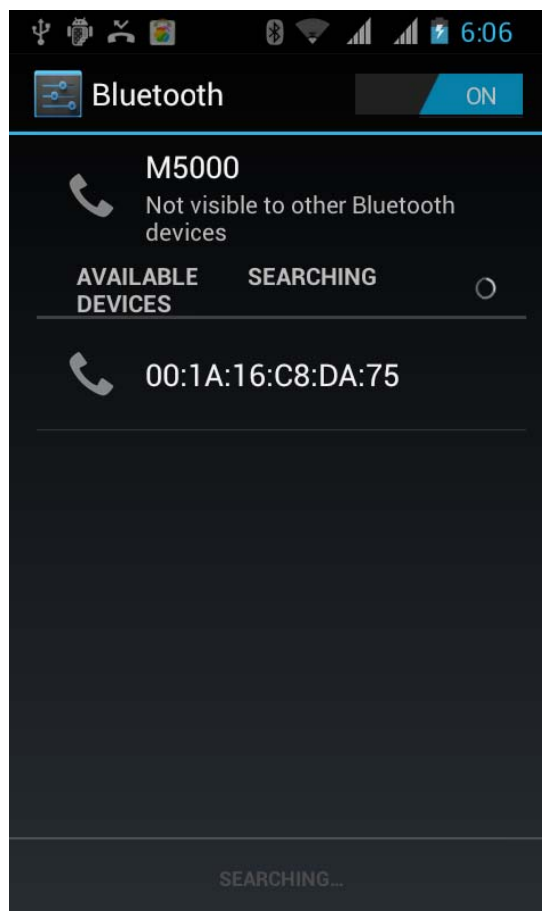
Add Desktop Gadgets

In the main screen interface, click the main menu to open the widget and select the widgets you want to add, save it to the main screen.



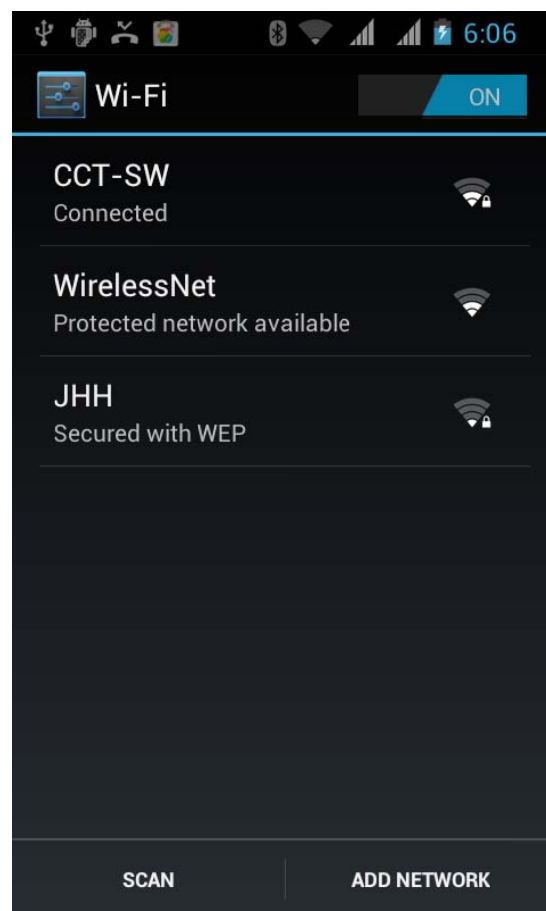
Bluetooth connection

Wi-Fi

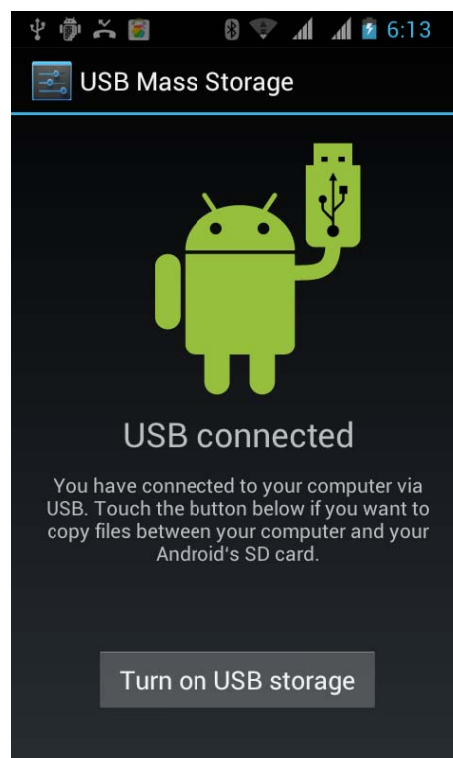

System Tools

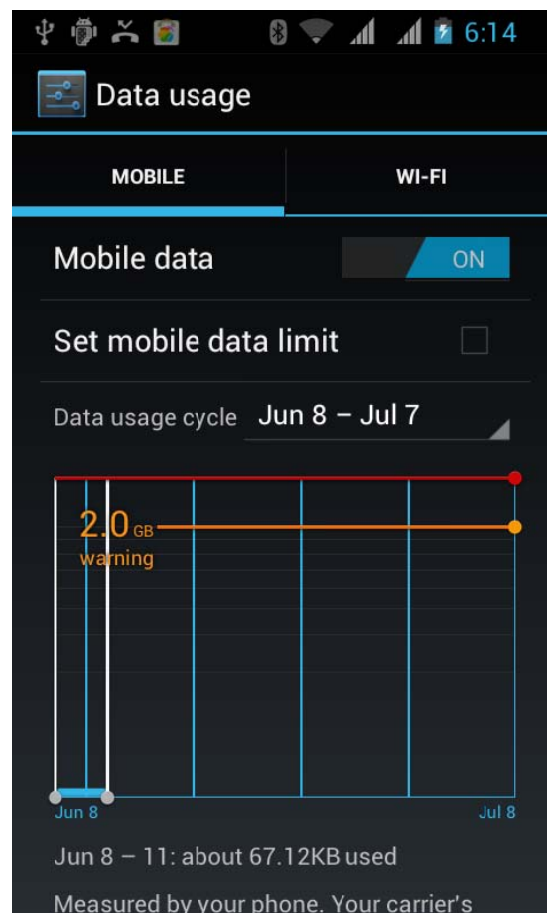
Document management (connected to the computer)

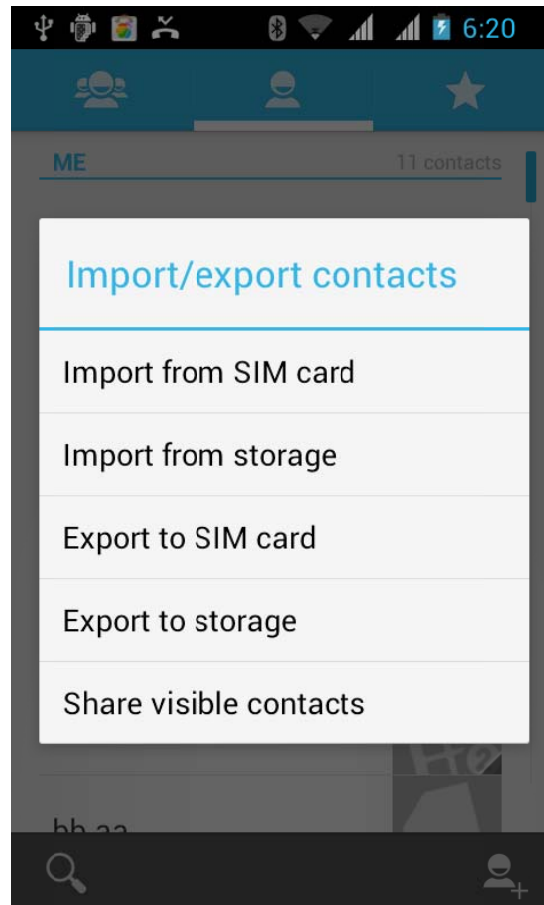
Traffic monitoring

In August 1986 the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) of the United States with its action in Report and order FCC 96-326 adopted an updated safety standard for human exposure to radio frequency (RF) electromagnetic energy emitted by FCC regulated transmitters. Those guidelines are consistent with the safety standard previously set by both U.S. and international standards bodies. The design of this phone complies with the FCC guidelines and these international standards. Use only the supplied or an approved antenna. If a damaged antenna comes into contact with the skin, a minor burn may result. Please contact your local dealer for replacement antenna.

BODY-WORN OPERATION:

This device was tested for typical body-worn operations with the back of the phone kept 1.5cm from the body. To comply with FCC RF exposure requirements, a minimum separation distance of 1.5cm must be maintained between the user's body and the back of the phone, including the antenna, whether extended or retracted. Third-party belt-clips, holsters and similar accessories containing metallic components shall not be used. Body-worn accessories that cannot maintain 1.5cm separation distance between the user's body and the back of the phone, and have not been tested for typical body-worn operations may not comply with FCC RF exposure limits and should be avoided.

Your wireless handheld portable telephone is a low power radio transmitter and receiver. When it is ON, it receives and also sends out radio frequency (RF) signals. In August, 1996, the Federal Communications Commissions (FCC) adopted RF exposure guidelines with safety levels for hand-held wireless phones. Those guidelines are consistent with the safety standards previously set by both U.S. and international standards bodies:

<ANSI C95.1> (1992) / <NCRP Report 86> (1986) / <ICIMIRP> (1996)

Those standards were based on comprehensive and periodic evaluations of the relevant scientific literature. For example, over 120 scientists, engineers, and physicians from universities, government health agencies, and industry reviewed the available body of research to develop the ANSI Standard (C95.1). Nevertheless, we recommend that you use a hands-free kit with your phone (such as an earpiece or headset) to avoid potential exposure to RF energy. The design of your phone complies with the FCC guidelines (and those standards).

Use only the supplied or an approved replacement antenna. Unauthorized antennas, modifications, or attachments could damage the phone and may violate FCC regulations.

NORMAL POSITION:

Hold the phone as you would any other telephone with the antenna pointed up and over your shoulder.

TIPS ON EFFICIENT OPERATION:

For your phone to operate most efficiently:

- Extend your antenna fully.
- Do not touch the antenna unnecessarily when the phone is in use. Contact with the antenna affects call quality and may cause the phone to operate at a higher power level than otherwise needed.

RF Exposure Information:

FCC RF Exposure requirements: The highest SAR value reported under this standard during product certification for use next to the body with the minimum separation distance of 1.5cm is 1.142W/kg, next to the head is 0.999W/kg. This transmitter must not be collocated or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter.

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

- (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and
- (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
