• Plug the keyboard into an available USB port on your computer. Windows automatically finds your keyboard and installs the appropriate driver.


Cleaning your keyboard

►/II	Play/Pause	Press to play or pause music or video. Press again to resume.
	Stop	Press to stop playing music or video.
4 -	Volume down	Press to decrease the volume. Hold down to decrease the volume quickly.
+	Volume up	Press to increase the volume. Hold down to increase the volume quickly.
X	Mute	Press to turn the sound off.
	Calculator	Press to open the calculator.
